Are you kidding me?

Trevor Cone, the Virginia Tech Hokey, he lives outside of Charlotte, not too far from Greer, South Carolina, and this is what the score looks like as Trevor Cone and Doc Redman are playing together. They are on the 8th hole right now. They're tied for the lead at 3 under at the BMW Charity Pro-Am.

Thornblade Club in Greer, South Carolina, playing host to this event since 2008, and the weather, you could not ask for a better Thursday, Friday here. 61 degrees at this time. I mean, that is perfection. It's like San Diego right now in the upstate of South Carolina.

Is, is the blade is the original name for that style putter a blade putter though? No. So I'm pretty sure he uses a combo set with a couple of blades in there.

[00:15:13.419]>>It's a blind shot, but he'll have an idea that that's right. Hey, this is a must birdie, especially if you par 15.

[00:15:37.020]>>At the 16th, Blades Brown playing his 3rd at this par 5.

[00:16:22.570]>>He, he played the old school 3rd shot, by the way, guys, he may have been watching. He played about a 9 iron for the 3rd, and that's a really nice up-and-down for him.

[00:17:18.469]>>A birdie 2 at the night.

[00:17:24.599]>>Will Chandler at the 5th has a putt for eagle. He's trying to bounce back after a tough couple of holes. This would be a nice way to bounce back, and he gets it.

[00:17:36.540]>>Right now, Will Chandler has that one shot lead over Vicente Marzilio, but this tournament, as you just said, I mean, it's up for grabs right now, no one's running away with it. Yeah, and especially the guys yet to tee off, are all playing at the Country Club of Spartanburg. So you said at the first page of the leaderboard, there's no-one that's really playing at Thornblade that can separate and really expand this lead from, from even the cup line that would be about 2 or 3 under par today.

[00:18:48.939]>>The 9th, Hunter Eichhorn, right now 2 back of Ben Kohles at 10 under to the par 3.

[00:19:27.579]>>He's got good hands usually John Pak. He was right in the mix at the Club Car Championship already this season, finished 2nd there.

[00:19:38.719]>>This is one of the fastest putts on this green right here, and he knows he's got to be careful with it because you just can't take any break out of this one.

[00:20:28.709]>>All right, minimizes the damage.

[00:20:31.709]>>A good round for John Pak, 67. He's on to Sunday at 7 under.

[00:20:40.569]>>Virtually no wind right now for Ben.

[00:20:45.150]>>That is starting way right, needs a bounce. Didn't really get it.

[00:20:52.410]>>Although that's, that's not bad, pretty good recovery for that ball once it got on the ground, wow.

[00:20:58.619]>>Well, that's a, that looks like a, that's what you call that one, a, a really good miss and local knowledge and a veteran move.

This is gonna be a similar spot, and there it is. That's one step shorter and didn't go forward at all, so the ground is important here, and that is not normally the case in Greenville. It is very dry and very firm right now.

He wants to clip it, he can get some spin on this. It will bite you back into the grain, or at least it would have bit earlier in the week.

And it's a shot that'll test your nerves with those little finicky shots into the grain, you know, not soft greens, you can't just accelerate, get the back of the ball and get it to stop near the hole, you have to land it in a perfect position and you have to get the contact really close to perfect.

[00:23:14.609]>>Put in some good confidence swings and, and take care of the back nine. Now, this is Coles, great opportunity here, Brian.

[00:25:00.079]>>At the 18th, Carson Young has elected putter here for his 4th, taking the flag stick out.

[00:25:12.729]>>There was, how hard do I hit it to get it through this? I can't be too aggressive. If I'm too aggressive, it's gonna go 8 ft past.

[00:25:24.959]>>Jay Card the 3rd at the 12th, has a putt for birdie. This would get him to 8 under.

[00:25:36.420]>>That would get him to 7 under, I beg your pardon.

[00:25:42.829]>>Carson Young trying to save the bogey at 18.

[00:25:47.959]>>Well done. And that had some speed to it too, so it just goes to show you, as you said before James, put a big X by that bunker, you do not wanna be there.

[00:26:08.140]>>And that was never online.

[00:26:12.439]>>It's not a bad place over the back here at 17th back into the breeze and.

[00:26:37.380]>> Marzilio here, oh, beautiful shot into the screen. Just asked Ben Kohles, what do you think of bouncy? He said, what choice do we have? That is a veteran attitude right there.

[00:26:55.890]>>3 over on the day.

[00:26:58.489]>>This needs to see one go down. There it is, a little fist pump.

[00:27:04.020]>>Played 3 years at the University of North Texas, finished up at Texas Tech.

[00:27:10.010]>>Lock, you know, it's like a 45 shot. Yeah, I think the biggest thing is just your, your line your drive. it. You locked. All right, bud, we're in.

[00:27:20.760]>>The tree allows him to aim it at about the right fringe, so that gives you about a 10 yard draw if you want it. That's about all he needs here.

[00:27:41.770]>>Oh, he pulled it off.

[00:27:44.670]>>What a shot. Watch this get better.

[00:27:48.989]>>He's not going to believe where this winds up.

[00:27:56.800]>>Now Blades Brown for his bogey at 18.

[00:28:01.750]>>3 over on his round today.

[00:28:07.150]>>Man, if Ben Kohles can make this, he will be stealing a shot.

[00:28:36.140]>>Now this for a birdie too, for Ben Carr again. Incredible shot to get it to here, can he pay it off?

[00:28:55.280]>>Although a birdie attempt right now for coals inside of 5 ft.

[00:29:03.540]>>He's in his own little world right now too, and Joel Stock, his caddie, is really helping with that. They are, they are currently zoned in.

[00:29:13.160]>>He's walking that one in.

[00:29:17.900]>>To 18, Austin Duncan off the green for his 3rd. This is where we've seen birdies made.

[00:29:25.930]>>And we see another one. wow, that birdie was about as spectacular as that shirt that he's wearing.

[00:29:35.530]>>Back 1 to 17, par saving attempt for Kohles.

[00:29:40.329]>>I don't think it's a lot.

[00:29:58.449]>>Almost.

[00:30:00.900]>>It was a good stroke at that speed, you'd think it might have toppled in, but it's gonna be a bogey for Ben Kohles.

[00:30:09.520]>>At the 18th.

[00:30:11.329]>>Will Chandler

[00:30:13.250]>>Putt for bogey.

[00:30:25.849]>>Chandler, he, if you remember, in his 2nd round he had it to 10 under at one point and scoring average quarter of a shot over par at Thornblade.

[00:30:36.239]>>We'll see what happens with Coles here with the approach.

[00:30:44.050]>>202 and the runway is in between the two front bunkers up the left hand side of this green.

[00:30:50.959]>>And he has just gone right at it. I guess you can do that too.

[00:30:57.170]>>That is phenomenal given these conditions. That might be the best shot we've seen in here to 18.

[00:31:06.069]>>Incredible.

[00:31:13.689]>>About 172 playing 165, they're playing 7 yards of release on a 9 iron.

[00:31:20.699]>>They have been through it today.

[00:31:24.339]>>Yeah.

[00:31:26.729]>>And they got more than that.

[00:31:31.699]>>Yeah, he came up and out of that one just a little too there. That was another good shot for Vicente. He's a good ball striker, a rookie on the Korn Ferry Tour out of Argentina. He's a teeter Green, he's, he's quite solid.

[00:31:47.400]>> Marzilio a chance to get to 7 under. 7 under would tie for 5th heading into the final round.

[00:32:05.739]>>He was the 18 and 36 hole leader, and that helps. Nicely done. Way to finish.

[00:32:12.420]>> Vicente Marzilio.

[00:32:16.099]>>A 72. He read that putt with his ears.

[00:32:23.989]>>Now Cole from just off the green for a birdie to get it back to 15 under.

[00:32:44.910]>>Ben Kohles, the day continues. How about that? The leader goes 7 under. He was tied for the lead at 8 under through 36.

[00:33:00.020]>>Ben Kohles, a 6 shot lead heading into Sunday, the largest 54 hole lead in this 34th playing of the BMW Charity Pro-Am. 64 on Saturday in a day where the course is playing a shot and a half over par, the most difficult we have.

[00:33:16.185]>>Seen it in a long, long time. That is incredible stuff from Ben Kohles. Can he get it done on Sunday with that large lead? A large lead indeed for Ben Kohles, looking for his 5th Korn Ferry Tour win in his career, first since 2023.

[00:33:39.349]>>Sunday afternoon in Greer, South Carolina for the final round of the BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX at Thornblade Club.

[00:33:51.189]>>When we began this day, it was a 6 shot lead for Ben Kohles. The lead is down to 3. The weather has been fantastic the 1st 3 days of this event, and here on this Sunday, Ben Kohles looking for his 5th career Korn Ferry Tour victory.

[00:34:11.550]>>And poles did not get off the start James Nitties that he was hoping for. Well, usually it's the putter that is the weakness of his game, but it hasn't been all week long, it's just at this point head spinning.

[00:35:16.520]>>Finally, someone makes one for us, takes the lid off.

[00:35:34.149]>>Drops one

[00:35:36.760]>>At the 10th, back to 9 under.

[00:35:41.679]>>Matt NeSmith, who was closing the gap earlier in the day at the 13th trying to get back to double digits.

[00:35:54.800]>>Back to 10 under

[00:36:00.790]>>Hunter Eichhorn, really good shot, 2 good tee shots at this 11th hole with these two guys, and this looked for birdie.

[00:36:10.520]>>He's got a read off McAllister, you have to take advantage of it, and he does. That puts him to double digits at 10 under.

[00:36:20.360]>>Taylor Dickson, he's got it to 10 under on the tee at the 17th playing 221 yards.

[00:36:32.250]>>And that's not going to hold the green.

[00:36:36.719]>>Back to the 12th out of the rough, here's Summerhays, grass all around it, but it's not down at the bottom.

[00:36:50.189]>>That's so good.

[00:36:51.929]>>I was judged so well out of the rough.

[00:36:55.739]>>Hunter Eichhorn, 2nd at 13, within 3.

[00:37:04.780]>>That's it.
