Didn't plan on that, but great shot in there. Gets him to 4-under par.

Some of that surf coming in to the cliffs in Carmel Bay. An event that's been around since the 1930s. Crosby, Glenn Beck back in the day. And AT&T, the title sponsor for four decades now. Signature event. The second signature event of the season. So 80 of the best from the PGA Tour, they'll all be around for the weekend. Got the amateurs in play the first two days. Two different courses, Spyglass and Pebble. We played Spyglass yesterday. You're over here at Pebble today, just about a mile apart as the crow flies and touching the water here. Ludvig Aberg withdrew because of illness. So 79, not 80 now. And Thursday and Friday, the two different courses with the amateurs tomorrow. Professionals right here on Pebble Beach playing here in the 84th edition of this event. To the 8th. And Jim Gallagher, Jr.

[00:16:11] >> Right here at 14. The man on top at 13-under trying to extend. Never left the hole.

[00:16:26] >> Collin Morikawa now for birdie on the par-4 13th. Eleven feet, putting from the front. And that gets him to 7-under. Fourth birdie of the day. No bogeys so far.

[00:26:26] >> Rasmus going to be committed to the Tour this year. We're going to see a lot of him. I'm telling you, this kid's got some game. He's been having such a fun week being out here for the first time.

[00:26:49] >> Thirty-seven feet for Glover. Miraculous 3. He had 217 yards in for a second. That's nearly a hundred more than the players that teed off earlier in the day.

[00:27:49] >> Across to 16 for the outright lead, McIlroy.

[00:27:54] >> Frank, you speak of harbingers of things to come. That little off speed 9-iron was beautiful. Simple read up the hill here.

[00:28:01] >> Yeah. Putt's going to pay it off. That is huge. He was struggling yesterday. Got to 18, had a mammoth drive, made eagle, and since then, it's been McIlroy of old. But can Tom Kim counter and tie back at 13? Up the hill, slow. He does. This is all changed very, very quickly. Thirteen, par 4, slightly up the hill. Cam Davis to get to 11-under.

So, he could have a little throwback sequence here of taking both the Hope and the Crosby.
