[00:00:28] >> The PGA Tour is proud to bring you the season-long race for the FedExCup. Now, coverage of the 2025 WM Phoenix Open.

[00:00:37] >> So many fans look forward to this week every single year, week to week in the PGA Tour. Last week, it was Pebble. This week, TPC Scottsdale. From a cathedral to a coliseum. That setting at 16, 20,000 strong arena atmosphere. And it does get loud. Get ready for that noise. Players, just a different experience right there, unlike any other hole golf. Earlier today, Justin Thomas really got the putter going. This is just one of them. The lengthy putt at the 5th finds it. On his way to a 5-under 66. His work is done for the day.

[00:01:21] >> We go now to World number 1, Scottie Scheffler at the 6th hole.

[00:01:26] >> We're typically just used to seeing Scottie Scheffler make eagles, birdies, and pars at this place, Curt. And so, to see him make some early bogeys, you know, birdies are out there for him. And this is a great opportunity.

[00:01:38] >> Led the tour last season in bounce back, bouncing back from bogey or worse.

[00:01:43] >> He's bringing this a little lower than Max, but right at it.

[00:01:48] >> Really well judged. Took that big first hop. Very nice. And an opportunity to make birdie after making that bogey at 5. Back to Scheffler level with that shot.

[00:02:03] >> And what we've seen here at TPC Scottsdale and also what we watched all last year, the FedEx Summary, the last five seasons, you see the Top 5 finishes there. But then, last year, one of those seven wins, he added a couple of more.

[00:02:27] >> Won a couple of years ago, Valspar. Oh, this is good. Go on.

[00:02:38] >> And now, Scheffler with a very good opportunity to bounce back.

[00:02:44] >> And this is about the range and his pre-shot warm up, Curt. He was drilling on the backstroke. He would stop about right at the top of the stroke, pause to where he was focusing on his stroke and his rhythm. And he made every single putt around the hole. So, one just like it.

[00:04:05] >> Got to feel good to make a birdie there.

[00:04:09] >> So Andrew Putnam in the playing through with the approach, trying to get it to 4-under, his ninth hole of the day.

[00:04:23] >> He's 4-under through nine.

[00:04:30] >> Eight.

[00:04:30] >> Wyndham Clark for birdie. And gets it to go. So, Wyndham Clark, he's a local boy. He's from Denver originally, but he lives here now.

[00:04:48] >> All right, here at the 9th. Min Woo Lee from off the green, his third.

[00:04:58] >> Yes.

[00:05:00] >> Yes, he did.

[00:05:02] >> It's cooking.

[00:05:03] >> Made his first birdie that way. All right, Frank, 42 feet away, Webb Simpson for birdie.

[00:05:18] >> That's a homer. Right in his range. Cheers, everybody.

[00:05:30][ Cheering ] One to remember.

[00:05:38] >> Now, 17.

[00:05:39] >> Lee Hodges. This is his second shot. Drove it to here.

[00:05:44] >> There you go. That's a three. Excuse me, a two. A two for Lee Hodges. How about that? Oh, man, look at that. Eagled the 15th and the 17th.

[00:06:08] >> Spin.

[00:06:13] >> It did.

[00:06:17] >> Seventeen.

[00:06:18] >> Taylor Moore to try to get it to 4-under. No problem. Taylor Moore tied for the best round this afternoon with Putnam and Schenk. All three players at 4-under.

[00:06:35] >> Clark saw the approach. This to get it to 4-under.

[00:06:43] >> That's more the Wyndham we used to, 4-under through 10. It's a bit better. He can go low.

[00:06:47] >> We stay at 10. Scottie from the fairway bunker.

[00:06:55] >> You just got to try to put so much cut spin on this shot to have any chance to get it within 10 feet. I mean, how does he do this?

[00:07:10] >> Go in. Go in.

[00:07:11][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:07:41] >> How many times is he going to do that? How many ways is he going to amaze us?

[00:07:51] >> Take it to 16. And the man about to turn 26 on Saturday, Mac Meissner out of SMU from the bunker.

[00:08:04] >> Is this going to be one of these days, Terry?

[00:08:06][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:08:14] >> Wyndham Clark to grab a share of the lead.

[00:08:23] >> He's got it going.

[00:08:25] >> Seventeen.

[00:08:26] >> The drivable par 4. Daniel Berger from front left corner. What is going on for real here?

[00:08:37] >> Is that part of the replay package or what?

[00:08:41] >> It's unbelievable. Now, we're seeing some action, some energy in that crowd out there this afternoon.

[00:09:01] >> Putnam with a scoring opportunity at 4. Does he get it there? Yes, he does. That gets him to 5-under and a share.

[00:09:17] >> Matt Wallace from 89 yards away at the par 5.

[00:09:23] >> That was nearly on the top deck, Terry.

[00:09:30] >> Not anymore, Frank. Take that, Scottie Scheffler. What a break. That was almost out of frame. That was out of the picture.

[00:09:45] >> Thirteen. Clark for his birdie. This would be five in the last six holes. So the hottest player on the golf course right now. There it is. Seven threes in a row on that scorecard.

[00:10:04] >> Oh, yeah. Short lived that lead by himself from Wyndham Clark.

[00:10:11] >> Right to the top at 7-under. Look at the run.

[00:10:15] >> Now, Wyndham Clark ahead. Did a pretty good job there, AO. What a shot.

[00:10:30] >> Clark with birdie to move back into the solo lead.

[00:10:35] >> Forty-one feet, 6 inches away for birdie, Akshay Bhatia.

[00:10:42] >> Tee shot was a little poor, Terry.

[00:10:44] >> That ain't.

[00:10:52] >> Wow. He just brought the house down.

[00:10:54][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:11:04] >> Scheffler for eagle at 15.

[00:11:06] >> That's got a lot of break to it.

[00:11:09] >> He read it perfectly. That gets him into red figures. You talked about patience earlier today, Frank, with him. He shows a lot of patience. He had to today. Third career round with multiple eagles.

[00:11:28] >> Scottie Scheffler's up and down day ends with a 2-under 69, trailing Wyndham Clark by five shots heading into Friday. Nicolai Hojgaard playing in his first event with twin brother Rasmus as official Tour members, shooting a 66 and sits two back. The second round is next.

[00:11:52] >> Blue skies, sunshine as usual here in the desert. PGA Tour and the annual stop here at TPC Scottsdale with the arena that is the 16th hole, and 20,000 fans out there. Not allowed to be laid back or passive if you're a fan. And players expect them to bring some of that noise as well. Make their way around here in the back nine. Certainly gettable. Couple of par 5s, and a drivable par 4, and you finish up here at 18. Good scores already today.

[00:12:23] >> To 5. Nick Taylor won it last year. He's at 3-under. So he's turned things around here. This to get it to four.

[00:12:31] >> Did a lot of that last year. Over 450 feet of putt he made during the course of the four rounds.

[00:12:39] >> Back here at the 6th, two time champ, Hideki Matsuyama's third shot.

[00:12:45] >> Brutal here. Really tight lie. Oh, my goodness.

[00:12:53] >> All right. Just seconds ago. Grillo setting up.

[00:13:29] >> No way you can keep that out. Twenty thousand strong helping it stay right there in the hole.

[00:14:45] >> He did. Huge putt. Can't tell those two apart, he and his brother Nicolai.

[00:15:05] >> Two-under.

[00:15:07] >> Defending champ. Let's turn things around here.

[00:15:16] >> Look at this card so far through the seven holes.

[00:15:20] >> Making a move, Frank.

[00:15:25] >> Clanton now for birdie.

[00:15:27] >> No, he had a front row seat to watch J.T.'s shot. He's having fun out here today, Curt.

[00:15:32] >> Well, that helps. He needs more of that coming in.

[00:15:39][ Applause ]

[00:15:45] >> Justin Thomas. What's he going to do, Smylie?

[00:15:47] >> OK, the lie's clean, Curt. He's going to try to play a big slice. I mean, I think he's got a curve that's about 50 yards. I'm just worried about the tree past the bush. If you catch it thin, easily can hit that tree.

[00:15:59] >> Up on top the hill there.

[00:16:01] >> That's right. Oh, that was clean. And it's cutting. Not sure if it's enough, but that's a good shot.

[00:16:16] >> Oh, it's on the green, Smylie. How about that? He's a long way from the hole. What a shot that was.

[00:16:30] >> Wearing really good tee shot here. Got to pay this off. All right.

[00:16:35] >> At least you take that home with you.

[00:16:44] >> Now, he's got some time as well. A long way to go, though.

[00:16:49] >> Long eagle try for J.T. at 13.

[00:16:54] >> I told J.T. that, you know, I thought it was going to be a punch out to the fairways. Like, are you kidding me, dude? You've played enough golf me to know I was going for it.

[00:17:00] >> I mean, this is doable here, Smylie. This is a makeable putt.

[00:17:06] >> It is. It's all about figuring out the first 10 feet of this putt. That ridge at the back of the green is going to be pushing this to the right. If you pick the right spot at the top of the hill, you can make it. But definitely want more focus on speed.

[00:17:39] >> If that had gotten there, it had a very good chance of going in.

[00:17:43] >> Pretty good lag putt.

[00:17:45] >> And that's -- Yeah, just going to finish it up. This is some birdie from where he drove it.

[00:17:50] >> Yeah, very lucky. He could have easily had an unplayable lie.

[00:17:53] >> Yeah.

[00:17:53] >> So walk away with a four. That's a win.

[00:17:55] >> Yes, sir.

[00:18:05] >> Now, Spieth.

[00:18:07] >> That's a 5-iron on the way. What a great line.

[00:18:11] >> Get over the mound, and this is going to get great right here. Look at this second shot. He'll have that for eagle.

[00:18:30] >> Ben Griffin at the 9th. He's at 1-under. So that magic number 2 trying to get there. Yeah.

[00:18:38] >> So that's the hard nine over and done with Ben.

[00:18:49] >> Thirteen.

[00:18:50] >> Spieth for eagle. And gets it done. That was just a well-played hole. Perfect drive down the middle, 5-iron to there, and makes it count.

[00:19:08] >> Boy, here's a guy who needs to make a putt, Ben Kohles. This is for eagle at even par. Got it. To 2-under with one hole to play. Huge putt for him.

[00:19:29] >> Michael Kim, who's been playing great. Way up in the air.

[00:19:37] >> One-fifteen has been about the number, isn't it?

[00:19:39] >> And thought we had another one, Frank.

[00:19:47] >> Jordan Spieth at 15.

[00:19:49] >> It's a 5-iron, Curt. Same club he hit to 13. This looks fantastic, if it's enough.

[00:19:59] >> Good line. It slows down. Yeah. Excellent shot for Jordan Spieth. Wow, he's got it in there. Great look for eagle.

[00:20:11] >> Michael Kim with some cleanup at 16. Knocks it in for his third birdie in his last four holes and moves to 8-under.

[00:20:24] >> At 15, Spieth. Great look for eagle here.

[00:20:28] >> Well, he can be a tiny bit aggressive. Not real aggressive.

[00:20:31] >> Yes. And gets it.

[00:20:36] >> To 16.

[00:20:37] >> Last of the three, Justin Thomas.

[00:20:54][ Cheering ]

[00:20:57] >> Great shot.

[00:20:59][ Cheering ]

[00:21:07] >> This for birdie, J.T.

[00:21:08] >> This isn't an easy read either, guys. It feels like the ball is a little bit below your feet, so you feel like it moves right, but the holes tilted the other way.

[00:21:29][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:21:42] >> Michael Kim, fairway at 18.

[00:21:43] >> Got it to 9-under. Chance for more, Frank.

[00:22:00] >> Rasmus Hojgaard 's at 6-under. This to get it to 7.

[00:22:04] >> His first trip here. Is a good one.

[00:22:09] >> An enjoyable one.

[00:22:15] >> Kim to get it to double figures

[00:22:19] >> Man, what a first two days here in Scottsdale he's had. Looking to win for the second time in his career. How about the finish?

[00:22:32] >> And Jordan Spieth to get to 9-under par and three back.

[00:22:41] >> Yeah, good up and down.

[00:22:43][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:22:51] >> And now, Justin Thomas to finish with a birdie.

[00:23:01] >> Great three. Moves him in a tie for sixth heading into the weekend.

[00:23:11] >> Thomas Detry is your leader after firing a second round 64 in the morning session. Amateur Luke Clanton, who needed to make the cut to secure his PGA Tour card, comes up one shot short and will not play the weekend. Michael Kim, whose lone Tour victory came back in 2018, sits just two shots back. The third round is coming up next.

[00:23:38] >> What a gorgeous week it's been here in the valley of the sun, living up to its name for certain. There's nothing like it in this course. It's magnificent. It's just perfect for the setting. The TPC Scottsdale, a living tribute to its great architect, the late Tom Weiskopf, the World Golf Hall of Famer, who knew how to mix in risk and reward holes, especially down the stretch.

[00:24:08] >> Now, 13, first of the two par 5s, Rasmus Hojgaard. His flag protected by the bunker. Oh, that is a shot.

[00:24:23][ Applause ] For the first eagle here today, this very hole. That a way to go. He was second in the race to Dubai, so he earned his membership this year on the PGA Tour.

[00:24:45] >> At 11, a long birdie attempt for the South African, Christiaan Bezuidenhout. He moves to double digits under par with that.

[00:25:02] >> Just the second birdie of the day for Christiaan Bezuidenhout at the 11th.

[00:25:11] >> For the up and down. Strokes it in. Beautifully done. MacIntyre, 7-under through 17 holes, heading to the last.

[00:25:25] >> Speed has been tremendous all day.

[00:25:28] >> And again.

[00:25:30] >> Here, we were saying how tough it is at 11. We've seen three birdies, so not so bad.

[00:25:38] >> All right, looks like a downhill. Maybe a left to right break here, about 20 feet. Quick going down the hill. Looks good.

[00:25:48] >> There we go.

[00:25:50] >> You know what? I think cold nose is out. And Jim Fish, you're hired.

[00:26:01] >> Outside chance for birdie for Scottie. Get to 9-under par. Can he finish in style? Yes, he can. Two time champ. Can he make it three? His favored at the start of the day, plus 4-under.

[00:26:21] >> Oh, yeah.

[00:26:32] >> Bezuidenhout at the 12th.

[00:26:36] >> OK. So the putter warming up for Christiaan.

[00:26:52] >> After taking a drop tee ball finding the water. Oh, my.

[00:26:57] >> I don't recall ever seeing that.

[00:27:06] >> MacIntyre at the 18th. Came up short with his second.

[00:27:13] >> Played that like it was plugged.

[00:27:17] >> At 15. This is the fifth shot. Two balls in the water here for Rasmus.

[00:27:23] >> This is no gimme wedge shot to the little plateau either. Oh, my goodness.

[00:27:29] >> Gosh, he came here second alone.

[00:27:33] >> Sixteen.

[00:27:35] >> Akshay Bhatia, the lefty.

[00:27:37] >> Pretty much on the exact same line as Camilo. Trev, you said it about Maverick McNealy, but I expect a massive year from this guy right here. He is really finding his way out here on the PGA Tour.

[00:27:48] >> Yeah, agreed. Confidence is built up.

[00:27:51] >> That is three in a row. And Akshay says, let me hear it. Get louder, 16. They certainly will.

[00:28:08] >> What Rasmus would give for bogey to hole this.

[00:28:21] >> Sixteen.

[00:28:22] >> Min Woo Lee, another guy we expect a lot from. Right, Colt?

[00:28:25] >> Oh, yeah. And that's three twos on 16 from that group right there. And speaking of let him cook, how about the executive director of the Thunderbirds, Chance Cozby? We should let him cook.

[00:28:34] >> Doing an unbelievable job. Frank Nobile and I have been covering Min Woo Lee since his amateur days at the Asia Pacific Amateur Championship. We've known this swagger, haven't we, Frank?

[00:28:45] >> We certainly have.

[00:28:47][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:28:53] >> That is beautiful. That's what it's all about here at the WM Phoenix Open.

[00:28:57] >> To 15.

[00:28:57] >> We have had one eight this week. This is to avoid it. In the hole with a seven. Came here in second, drops back to a tie for fourth.

[00:29:18] >> Fourteen.

[00:29:18] >> From the right side of the fairway.

[00:29:20] >> Difficult lie for Tom Kim.

[00:29:22] >> Real launching pad. Easy to get this going left quickly.

[00:29:27] >> Comfortable, not iron for him.

[00:29:28] >> It's out to the right with 6-iron turning.

[00:29:31] >> You'd have to turn in off that lie. Oh, and turn in, it did. Will it turn in? Just to tap in for the birdie after a couple of bogeys at 10 and 11.

[00:29:41] >> Let's go to 17.

[00:29:45] >> Scheffler now. Try and bounce it just into that top bank. One bounce and spin.

[00:29:59] >> To 14.

[00:30:03] >> Way down there. Putt for birdie for the Belgian.

[00:30:08] >> Be the first since the eighth hole, I believe.

[00:30:12] >> There you go. Five-under on his round, 17-under.

[00:30:28] >> At 15, Daniel Berger, his second, 7-up iron.

[00:30:34] >> Three hundred and forty-five-yard drive. Just a 7-iron in.

[00:30:40] >> Was it a beauty? Great look at eagle.

[00:30:47] >> Seventeen.

[00:30:49] >> Can we see a birdie?

[00:30:54] >> There you go for Scheffler. Maybe another one up the last, one of his favorite holes out here. Here he's in the mix.

[00:31:04] >> Meanwhile, 15, Berger for eagle.

[00:31:09] >> Working his way back.

[00:31:11] >> There you go. First eagle at 15 today.

[00:31:23] >> Hojgaard at 18. Saw his momentum stalled with a seven at 15. Over a nice finish. Birdie three.

[00:31:33] >> Impressive bounce back there, isn't it?

[00:31:37] >> Really. Very much so.

[00:31:39] >> We go to 16 with Daniel Berger on the tee.

[00:31:44] >> Still got a lot of good golf in there, though. He's young and fiery.

[00:31:49] >> Sure does. Only bogey of the day yesterday for him. Came right here on 16.

[00:31:58] >> And unlike Frank Nobile, he's never across the line.

[00:32:07] >> Man, they're booing. To 18.

[00:32:13] >> And Brian Harman. Just even par for the day.

[00:32:19] >> Just four paces over the bunker.

[00:32:21] >> Oh, look at this.

[00:32:24] >> Oh, yeah, that is awesome.

[00:32:29] >> From just about 40 feet.

[00:32:31] >> We've seen most guys miss this putt to the right today. Daniel Berger. That is a tasty burger. What a birdie.

[00:32:42] >> Eagle birdie. And all of a sudden, Berger puts himself tied for third at 12-under par.

[00:32:50] >> At 18, Scheffler.

[00:32:54] >> For birdie to finish birdie, birdie.

[00:33:00] >> To finish birdie, birdie.

[00:33:05][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:33:16] >> Over to Jordan.

[00:33:17] >> Needs this for birdie at 15. To tie Hojgaard for second.

[00:33:26] >> Great two putt there, Mark Immelman.

[00:33:28][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:33:40] >> Michael Kim now at 17 trying to keep pace with the leaders.

[00:33:49] >> Was this finish is as exciting as it gets on Tour.

[00:33:53] >> Fifteen, 16, of course, the cauldron.

[00:33:57] >> One player to get in. And the only question is, how large will the lead be for the 32-year-old father of two?

[00:34:27] >> For his par. Oh, my goodness. No wonder he played the third shot over there.

[00:34:37] >> It was all part of the plan.

[00:34:40] >> Yes. That's one off the 54-hole tournament record of a six shot lead.

[00:34:48] >> Thomas Detry shoots a 65 and will go into Sunday with a five shot lead. Plenty of firepower, though, behind him, as Jordan Spieth, Rasmus, Hojgaard and plenty of others try to make up the difference. The final round is next.

[00:35:42] >> Tens of thousands have come out to support their tournament. The People's Open they call it. It's a tournament that goes back to 1932 here in the Arizona desert. It's truly one of the great success stories in all of sport. The outpouring of love, the passion in the community, the number of people who populate this event every year. And then, of course, in the end, the millions of dollars that come right back to those in need here in the Phoenix and Scottsdale area.

[00:36:14] >> The Waste Management Phoenix Open Final Round is underway. And a couple of giants in the game are making a charge. That is Scottie Scheffler into the sixth hole. That led to birdie, his fourth of the day. And then, there's the story of Jordan Spieth, just his second tournament since surgery in August. Pouring in birdies. And he finds himself right now four off the lead and second alone. The lead continues to belong to this man, Thomas Detry with his elegant game. Pouring in putts.

[00:36:49] >> Take a look at some of the headlines. Detry, he's not only trying to get his first win on the PGA Tour. He's trying to become the first player from Belgium to win on the Tour. And here's Spieth in the mix suddenly. We did have the hole-in-one that, of course, drew so much attention on Friday out at 16.

[00:37:16] >> He's caught fire here. Look at that. Birdies at 7 and 9.

[00:37:29] >> Got to have this one. Can't afford to drop shots if he wants to win this. That's a bad bogey with just a 9-iron, Trevor.

[00:37:36] >> Yeah. Always low. He's let a few opportunities slip. He had a 4-footer for birdie at the 9th that he missed to the right. And now, the bogey at 12.

[00:37:48] >> To 11. Jordan Spieth in a predicament, using the putter to get out of trouble.

[00:37:58] >> He read the break correctly.

[00:38:05] >> Min Woo Lee over the back of 13. Not much green to work with. Oh, yes, he is cooking. Min Woo, fan favorite now.

[00:38:23] >> Come on, Jordan.

[00:38:30] >> How about that shot? How about that from Spieth?

[00:38:43] >> Robert MacIntyre is a 14-under par. Coming off 65 on Saturday, 3-under today. Oh, what a lovely shot that is.
