Good scoring, very receptive golf course here in the opening round. Players were sent off in groups of threes, off split tees earlier this morning in anticipation of some weather activity on the radar. Looks like we've got clear sailing for the rest of the day. And a little bit more of a concern for tomorrow's forecast. And we'll see if this century old A. W. Tillinghast gem stands up to the modern day player. From outside 50 feet, Adam Scott, birdie but on the way at 18. Great.
