[00:00:45.060]>>Absolute delight to welcome you from wherever you are joining us around the globe here at Torrey Pines Golf Course. We're about 12 miles from downtown San Diego and as you can see,

It's hard to believe that, uh, the beauty of this golf course is probably one of the angriest golf courses on the PGA TOUR as well. Overhead, stunning, but when you're on the golf course on the ground out there, it is all you can handle. Matt Adams alongside of that voice you just heard, the 2002 PGA Champion Rich Bean. Daniel Chopra is here with us as well, and that's exactly where we are on the coast of California along these very, very rugged terrain.

[00:01:28.040]>>And Daniel, this is a pretty historic piece of property even before the golf courses were here. It certainly was, uh, it was the site for a military base, uh, Camp Callan, back in 1941 through to 1945. It was an anti-aircraft training ground for the Allied troops.

[00:01:48.569]>>And here are some of the big stories coming into this week's event. Brooks Koepka, of course, making his first non-major PGA TOUR start since 2022. We are using multiple courses here on the property. The North and South Course is used in both the 1st and 2nd rounds. For the third and final round, it will be just the same South Course.

[00:02:08.610]>>Torrey, uh, Torrey Pines has hosted this event since all the way back in 1968. It's also hosted two US Opens in 2008, 2021, both distinctive.

Yeah, they had to add one for Brooks Koepka and subsequently two more players got into the tail end of that. There's 49 pairings out there instead of the 48. They're supposed to be 144 in the field, so because of Brooks, he's adding guys to the field already.

[00:02:58.889]>>With that, he moves to 2 under par.

[00:03:14.029]>>It's on the North Course, straight downhill par 3.

[00:03:18.089]>>Nice birdie there.

[00:03:21.199]>>And that's the start you're looking for on that North Course.

[00:03:29.369]>>How many great Danes are there out there now?

[00:03:48.660]>>Well, that's just it. You can't afford to play this golf course conservatively because the more conservative you get, the harder it's going to be. So you gotta be aggressive, but you gotta be smart about it.

The scenery just kind of enhances everything about it, but don't let the pretty pictures fool you. These things are, uh, they're mean.

[00:15:50.780]>>And normal programming has resumed. Oh my goodness. Is he playing too well to be considered for Ryder Cup captaincy at Adair? Yes, I'd say so.

[00:16:15.140]>>All of a sudden a commanding lead is down to 2.

[00:16:22.369]>>Jason Day has this for birdie at the 17th. Jason Day needs something to go here and does. That gets him with a potential tee time for the weekend at 3 under par with a par 5 to come. That was clutch.

[00:16:43.179]>>Justin Rose ascends to 16 under.

[00:16:52.539]>>Matt Kuchar playing his 2nd at the 3rd from just off the green.

[00:17:02.059]>>Huh, how about that? Kuchar.

[00:17:05.318]>>Knocking it in from off the green with that hybrid. Where is he at? How good's he playing gets him to 2 under. So he has 6 holes left to get to a couple more to be safe. This is for Eagle for Joel. And Joel Dahmen 7 under for the run. That's a round of 63 for the man who just narrowly lost out his PGA TOUR card last year. weight, he's looking good, looking fit.

[00:20:03.280]>>Well this looks good. This looks very good.

[00:20:11.760]>>How many shots have we seen? I was just gonna say, did you say something about seeing a lot of, of balls go into the hole? Well, the hole gets bigger in the afternoon.

[00:20:21.219]>>Tell you what, this guy's got some swag. If he took his golf clothes off and just wore civilian clothing walking down the mall, you'd look at him go, I bet you he's somebody famous.

[00:20:51.430]>>Well, much of North America are dealing with storms rolling across the continent, but here in California it's as if we were playing under a bubble all week. The conditions are absolutely perfect, 73 °F. That's about 23 °C, and this is a greener Torrey Pines than we're used to seeing.

[00:21:15.000]>>Ah, Justin Rose up first, and this is a great number for him, 147 yards. The lie is absolutely perfect, it's completely flat. And with where that flag is in that front right corner, you're just eyeing up 2 yards left of this pin.

[00:21:38.310]>>Oh. Well, no early nerves for Justin Rose today.

[00:21:46.180]>>Yeah.

[00:21:48.400]>>It's uphill. I would go right edge, I wouldn't go outside of the cup here.

[00:22:02.369]>>Wow, I'd have to say it was almost a little bit of an important putt, having missed a great opportunity at the first, but, uh, now all of a sudden, extending that lead to 5.

[00:22:22.550]>>To get to 10 under, that sees him rise to a tie for 7th.

[00:24:24.449]>>He's got 10 yards just shy of this pin to work with. Is this guy on autopilot or what? He gets to 21 under par.

[00:24:42.569]>>Not the first time we've seen a player going with a driver off the deck.

[00:24:49.189]>>Oh my goodness.

[00:24:53.109]>>Have you ever seen a driver off the deck that close to the hole? Yeah, he pulled it.

[00:25:11.689]>>Oh, beauty

[00:25:14.329]>>Well, this is gonna get better too.

[00:25:17.219]>>This is gonna get better. It's gonna be at least half as close as it was at the apex of the hill.

[00:25:35.290]>>Quite a fast putt.

[00:25:38.260]>>You're almost putting across that backstop that we talked about, so it's gotta have a little bit of influence left to right. But he's almost at the base of that bit of slope.

[00:25:57.630]>>That will see him ascend into 2nd alone on 14 under.

[00:26:04.979]>>133 away at 10.

[00:26:16.640]>>I mean, unbelievable. Again, missing it on the fat side of the green, perfectly hole high. I mean this is video game golf that he's playing right now. That reminds me of somebody else who's pretty good at golf right about now, maybe number one in the world, Scottie Scheffler.

[00:26:33.930]>>I think it's Dahmen to go first.

[00:26:39.939]>>Oh yeah, wow.

[00:26:47.199]>>That is Joel Dahmen, picking his ball up out of the hole, just made it from downtown San Diego.

[00:26:56.829]>>I've seen you on Netflix.

[00:26:59.530]>>And it clears the stage once again for Justin Rose, who was just inside of 6 ft for yet another birdie.

[00:27:13.079]>>As if there was ever any doubt, Justin Rose reaches 22 under par, and nobody in the history of this event has been deeper under par than that number. See W Kim 2nd at 14.

[00:27:39.670]>>Lovely.

[00:27:45.219]>>This is an interesting scenario now for Justin Rose, knowing full well his new two closest pursuers are now struggling to make par. Let me put a little pep in his step here for this 3rd shot across the green.

[00:30:00.599]>>He's looking pretty good to get in that final grouping tomorrow. Yeah.

[00:30:08.420]>>This is up at the green here at 18. 3rd shot for Si Woo.

[00:30:13.229]>>Remember the chipp he hit at the 6th hole today?

[00:30:16.479]>>From the front of the green

[00:30:18.530]>>To about 2 ft.

[00:30:20.709]>>Those are, those are world class pitching runs right there. That's Scottie Scheffler-esque.

[00:30:39.209]>>Joel Dahmen from 83 yards. Look how far down the grip he's gripping this one.

[00:30:45.969]>>Almost down to the steal.

[00:30:48.369]>>Brilliant

[00:30:49.680]>>That was the advantage of laying it up that close to the water.

[00:30:56.380]>>Now from 82.

[00:30:59.939]>>Just looking to cruise this one in as well, like you said, without too much spin, a controlled flight.

[00:31:08.500]>>Spectacular, right below the hole once again.

[00:31:17.569]>>This hopefully for the last part, breaking a little bit off his right. This is more than 4 ft, it might feel like it's 8.

[00:31:30.709]>>Brilliant work, excellent camera work there to give us that perspective, and now we turn our sights to Justin Rose. He'll have 3 ft 4 inches to navigate.

[00:31:49.550]>>Justin Rose finishing with the flourish that he has shown us throughout the course of the 1st 3 rounds of this Farmers Insurance Open.

[00:32:00.000]>>2019 champion has reached the number that he had at the finish of the last time, 21 under when he won.

[00:32:08.520]>>Justin Rose extends his lead to 6 with 18 holes left to play. The final round is next.

Championship, Rich Beam out on the golf course for us today. Inci Mehmet and Gary Christian will be handling the call. That call will be centering around Justin Rose.

[00:33:49.560]>>Rose is enjoying a 6-shot lead on the rest of the field, defined by Joel Dahmen, who stands those 6 shots behind him. Can he catch him?

[00:34:02.050]>>My only hope is if he doesn't set his alarm or he somehow somehow starts hitting in the rough on the back nine, maybe, I don't know the way he's playing and what he's doing, I, I would be pleased with second place. It is the largest 54 hole lead.

[00:34:21.878]>>At the Farmers Insurance Open since 1983. Beamer, can he be caught? Is it possible? Yes. Is it probable? No. There's a large number on a lot of the holes out there, but right now, Justin Rose is in total control of what he's doing. And the winningest Englishman in the history of the PGA TOUR. It's remarkable. He's looking to extend that distinction. The next would be Sir Nick Faldo at 9. If victory is in his grasp today, it would be his 13th.

[00:35:00.000]>>2nd from Adam Scott at the 18th.

[00:35:06.030]>>Didn't look like he was going with much more than a midiron there, that would be a massive drive and what a shot right below the hole.

[00:35:16.350]>>At the 4th, that's Maverick McNeely, his 2nd.

[00:35:22.780]>>A location all the way in the back corner, a pear-shaped green and in a very narrow portion. Very aggressive shot there by Maverick right below the hole. That'll be a nice uphill right to left for his birdie.

[00:35:36.399]>>At 13, the par 5, Brooks Koepka for birdie.
