[00:00:40.299]>>Long standing tradition on the PGA TOUR Springtime in Dallas dating back to 1944 and honoring the legacy of the late great Byron Nelson, 52 times a champion on the PGA TOUR, whose name has been aligned with this great event for more than 8 decades. Very receptive golf course which underwent.

[00:01:02.705]>>And a major restoration prior to the competition and some highlights, plenty of them today, including this tee shot from Stephan Jaeger at the 4th. Already with 3 birdies on the opening nine, went out in 32. Today, a guy who has taken it deep before, 1 shot 58 on the Korn Ferry Tour and Jaeger is in the mix.

[00:01:26.120]>>2nd shot into the 2nd hole, he was already 4 under par out of the 1st cut of rough.

[00:01:32.809]>>And with the new greens, there's always a little bit of a learning experience. No problem there forewoo, gets him to 5 under.

[00:01:43.750]>>Emiliano Grillo.

[00:01:46.339]>>Short par 4 14th, 3 500, gets it to 60 with that birdie.

[00:01:54.919]>>Grillo, former winner in Colonial, that's next week's stop on the PGA TOUR, had it going today and would conclude his round with a birdie here at 18 in the house with a 64 today.

[00:02:09.139]>>So a blazing start for the man from Argentina, but they're all looking up at Brooks Koepka right now, picked up an eagle there at the 12th early in the round to get to 3 under par. Yeah, it always helps when it's happy hour, a little 2 for 1 there at 12.

[00:02:29.880]>> Reitan, so not quite as drivable as it was the last couple of seasons. No worries though, from 95 yards, get in the close, 8 under par.

[00:02:38.259]>>Bogey free round for Koepka today, one off his career low opening round of 62 on the PGA TOUR. Blazing scoring on day one as Koepka sets the pace here at THE CJ CUP. Byron Nelson, Scottie Scheffler is your defending champion, always lurking.

[00:03:04.669]>>You know, he's the first pontiff to play the PGA TOUR. I can see that. I, I, I'd have a hard time coming up with another pontiff.

[00:03:58.410]>>Yeah, kind of a Brits style green. There you go.

[00:04:07.500]>>Apparently you can. No, you can't. That's gotta be AI. Can't hold that Putt from that big low area. I wanna see it again.

[00:05:00.029]>>That's Luke List down there at 18. 0, did a nice job getting that one sorted out.

[00:05:13.329]>>Pavon has made the turn, and he's over on the front side.

[00:05:18.739]>>Uncomfortable hole location for Pavon moves everything left to right, back left hole location.

[00:05:25.179]>>Oh, yeah, tasty. It really did bother him just struggling, yes.

[00:05:35.179]>>Taylor Pendrith at 13, got one. See what happens when you get it to the hole, good things happen. Exactly.

[00:05:56.880]>>Beautiful delivery into the 9th. Just 2 over on the day, but a chance for an eagle.

[00:06:11.619]>>Oh, he's got it, he's got it. Oh, indeed, long range, Sungjae. You gave it the early call there, you were comfortable with that? I was.

[00:06:47.329]>>We do bounced a little, yeah, just a fraction radar.

[00:06:55.950]>>3 under par, 3 holes to go. Starting to get in the conversation.

[00:07:06.119]>>Taylor Moore 1 off the lead here at the 6th.

[00:07:11.420]>>Spin left.

[00:07:13.630]>>Nicely done. Below the hole. Good look here for more.

[00:07:18.850]>>Sungjae, setting up for a leaky fade, the correct shot.

[00:07:26.820]>>There it goes, finally starts dying a little right.

[00:07:30.769]>>And that away, quality shot.

[00:07:37.269]>>And this is the putt of Taylor Moore to join Koepka at the top, and we've got 2 at 8 under.

[00:07:53.450]>>Oh, look at that.

[00:07:56.299]>>Perfect pace, catches just enough for the right hand side and actually falls in the back edge.

[00:08:09.640]>>5 birdies on the round for Kensei and an eagle at the 5th as well.

[00:08:15.250]>>Villegas.

[00:08:16.600]>>For birdie at 16.

[00:08:18.730]>>Trying to get to 4 under from off the edge.

[00:08:22.220]>>No, nothing to it.

[00:08:25.329]>>Perfect speed.

[00:08:31.619]>>Really good putting day for Taylor, picking up more than 2.5 shots on the field with his work on the greens for the lead in his career low round on the tour. Oh, great look here, looking about a ball outside right.

[00:08:46.099]>>Oh, pulled it. It's coming back though. He pulled it right in the middle, hey, pulled it right in the middle. That's a man after my own heart right there. How about that glittering scorecard? Birded half the holes out here today.

[00:09:00.000]>>Taylor Moore's 62 gives him a one-shot lead with several internationals close behind. Round two is next.

[00:09:13.849]>>Day two in Big D just outside Dallas, Texas. We welcome you back to TPC Craig Ranch in McKinney, Texas for the second round of the CJ Cup, Byron Nelson being played every springtime on the PGA TOUR since 1944.

[00:09:30.349]>>It's a newly designed layout, and they have absolutely obliterated it through the first day and a half. And some highlights from today's 2nd round, there were plenty of them from Sungjae Im including this birdie at the short par 3 17th to move to -7, and he was just getting things going on this Friday. Well, he's just pouring them in. This is a nice uphill second shot at 1. Can't really see the bottom of the flagstick.

[00:10:00.859]>>And I think I is healthy again. It's been a problem earlier this year.

[00:10:10.250]>>And also had a birdie.

[00:10:13.010]>>The 5th, now onto the 7th, and this is where he gets fun. 224 yards. Thank you very much. Mark me down for 1.

[00:10:26.010]>>Now look at the gentleman in the background. He is so excited about that.

[00:10:33.390]>>I think he might have bet a quarter with his buddy sitting next to him against that. He was not happy for him.

[00:10:41.070]>>Oh, what a good feeling to snatch that one out of the hole. So a 1 at the 7th, and then how about a 3 at the 9th, an eagle to cap the round of 61. 0, that's just awesome, what a great way to finish, a phenomenal round.

[00:11:01.869]>>Sungjae started the day tied for forty-seventh and zoomed up the leaderboard. He's the man in the pole position.

[00:11:14.200]>>Shouldn't be any break to this one, just up the hill.

[00:11:17.159]>>Yeah, nicely converts.

[00:11:19.919]>>He's a guy that knows how to make birdies and 4 in the 1st 6 holes.

[00:11:26.299]>>Ben Silverman.

[00:11:31.500]>>Yeah working this one in from right to left, rolling this one over. Come on, spin back, come on.

[00:11:38.190]>>All right, that'll get him to 6 under, and each player that gets to 6 under is disrupting that cut line, that's for sure.

[00:11:46.000]>>There is Power up at the 18th, he's already had 5 birdies in the opening 8 holes of the day. Yeah. Oh, and he's about to make it 6. You can definitely, uh, count that one, no doubt about it, and Power needs, you know, some good weeks, 95th projected.

[00:12:05.039]>>Si Woo to go first. He needs to take this upstairs because I don't believe he can bump this.

[00:12:17.710]>>Good for a share of the lead, Si Wu out in 30. Very nifty.

[00:12:25.530]>>Kevin, you even par.

[00:12:29.719]>>I mean, it's something magical, starting with his 2nd shot at the 18th, his 9th.

[00:12:36.840]>>Knock that in and then go shoot yourself a little.

[00:12:40.849]>>29 and stick around for the weekend.

[00:12:44.609]>>And trying to be the first to get it to 14 under and nab the lead outright.

[00:12:50.070]>>It won't move an inch, will it? It just has to be firm and straight, and he makes it.

[00:12:55.210]>>No, he's going the other way.

[00:12:59.299]>>Don't doubt that man. Hottest round going on the golf course, birdie number 7, the opening 10.

[00:13:11.690]>>Tall figure of Tony Finau, very low hands at the address position. Go in, go in, oh.

[00:13:20.500]>>Hopped right over the hole, rude, just in between little hops. That definitely was going slow enough, it would have hopped in, it would have stayed in.

[00:13:37.030]>>With an iron up over a big old buried elephant.

[00:13:44.469]>>Oh, nearly hold another one. I, I, I made the early call on the 59. I, I listen right now, now it's getting to that moment in baseball where you just stop talking to the pitcher. Yeah, but you can't mention it. You can't talk about the 59. You've just wrecked it for him. No, I haven't. No.

[00:14:02.340]>>Uh, the 12th, coming off that Zoia comes out low, but all kinds of spin, as Jay Townsend said earlier. Mackenzie Hughes, that eagle, hits him clear of that cut mark by 2.

[00:14:20.989]>>It's quite slow at the start.

[00:14:24.609]>>And then she's downhill a little.

[00:14:28.479]>>Oh, just dialed in, dialed in, thank you very much. Scottie Scheffler in front of everybody.

[00:14:38.409]>>Give us a smile.

[00:14:40.859]>>It's all you're gonna get right there. That and a lot of threes on the scorecard today.

[00:14:52.570]>>Keith Mitchell for a low score of his own here. How about this day he's got going.

[00:14:58.309]>>Yeah, pitches in for Eagle.

[00:15:03.460]>>Big one here.

[00:15:08.349]>>No doubt about it, Si Woo Kim bangs another one in there. Needs 2 out of the next 4. And the hunt for 59 is real. It is 17 is almost a gimme, it seems like at this moment in time.

[00:15:25.010]>>Tom Kim at 17, just a hint of a left to right slider here inside left edge.

[00:15:32.719]>>Good putt.

[00:15:39.479]>>2 more. That's what he needs to do over the final quartet of holes today.

[00:15:45.580]>>Just outside right.

[00:15:48.880]>>Oh, he's got it. How good is this? 5 stroke lead, yeah, oh man. Come on, Si Woo.

[00:16:00.280]>>For now, we'll go to 18. Overhead look at the 3rd for Hubbard.

[00:16:06.450]>>Tried to put a little air under that one and some sizzle as well. Oh yeah.

[00:16:15.169]>>If you're going to make birdie though, if you need one of them over the last two holes, this is where you want to make it.

[00:16:21.080]>>It's not a hard part.

[00:16:23.780]>>It's a hard punt when you're trying to shoot 59.

[00:16:30.369]>>Here it comes.

[00:16:32.109]>>Down it goes.

[00:16:35.369]>>Had a baby.

[00:16:38.099]>>With great conviction.

[00:16:41.960]>>Part 18 or a birdie for 58, birdie for 58.

[00:16:48.219]>>I thought that ball was gonna try and go left, I held the line, and what a great putt.

[00:16:57.559]>>Here's Koepka, center of the fairway. 79, 182.

[00:17:08.540]>>All over it.

[00:17:15.520]>>Now we'll need to get this one up and in for 4 at the last and 59. He's a perfect 6 of 6 scrambling so far this week.

[00:17:29.800]>>Oh, I didn't miss it by much. That was a great technique.

[00:17:34.180]>>Because sometimes when you're on a downslope like that, that golf club slips underneath the golf ball too quickly.

[00:17:40.310]>>Just don't get the full momentum that you need.

[00:17:45.280]>>Si Woo Kim, the best putter in the field, gonna need to hole one from close to 20 ft, but first, Scheffler will go to work on this one.

[00:18:01.339]>>Hm, looked good for a long time. You know, it's not that you can see Si Woo came in there. It's not the same line, but he's got, he gave a, got a little bit of a read there from Scheffler. A little feel for the pace as well.

[00:18:14.800]>>We've got our fingers crossed for you, mate.

[00:18:19.239]>>Yes, we do, to become the 16th player in PGA TOUR history to break 60.

[00:18:38.380]>>Yeah, we had a good look at it from ground level behind him. I think he misread that. I mean, we were right there behind him and based on the Scottie's putt.

[00:18:49.349]>>Great round, matching his career low round on the tour a decade ago. Matt 60 in Greensboro led to victory.

[00:18:58.530]>>We'll see if this does as well. South Korea's Si Woo Kim will take an impressive 5-shot lead into the weekend. Round 3 is next.

[00:19:15.989]>>We welcome you back to TPC Craig Ranch in McKinney, Texas, just outside of downtown Dallas, newly renovated and restored golf course that has been absolutely under siege this week.

[00:19:31.239]>>Scoring bonanza the last couple of days, 7 rounds of 62 or better, including 6 on Friday. Substantial rain this spring, a lack of wind this week has made this place defenseless, and it has yielded more than 1300 birdies through the opening two rounds. Only 6 holes have played over par.

[00:19:53.150]>>Just a moment ago down at the first Sungjae Im.

[00:19:58.439]>>Oh

[00:20:00.119]>>Hello, a fine way to start your weekend.

[00:20:04.630]>>Who says the flag's gonna hurt it? Good thing it was there.

[00:20:10.670]>>To the 3rd we go.

[00:20:14.589]>>This one's a little out of the right, it's a pretty easy part.

[00:20:18.229]>>Gotta get this show on the road.

[00:20:21.540]>>That looks like the Sibū came on Friday, doesn't it? The man who needed just 20 putts during yesterday's 2nd round, producing 12 birdies. And he's got a 4-shot lead.

[00:20:34.199]>>Oh shoot, trying to climb to 16 under here.

[00:20:41.050]>>OK, he's convinced Beamer. You can only see Beamer in here. He's trying to figure out what he just got two fingers on, on the top of the putter with his left hand.

[00:20:55.589]>>Drips it in. That's 2 of the opening 4 for Sungjae.

[00:21:03.430]>>2nd coming into the 6th here for Scheffler.

[00:21:07.109]>>Gotta make birdie here.

[00:21:09.439]>>Have to.

[00:21:14.170]>>Chances are good

[00:21:21.310]>>Up ahead, here's Clark to go 16 deep.

[00:21:26.939]>>Uh-huh. Nicely done. That was far from an easy putt. The first quarter of that putt was kind of uphill, and then it flattened out, 3 in a row.

[00:21:37.530]>>It's a must birdie here for Scheffler. Otherwise he's just kind of letting things get away from him.

[00:21:46.810]>>It was a dead straight in, it came a little left, good putt.

[00:21:50.390]>>3 out of 4, sandwiched around the bogey at the 4th. Steady progression on this Saturday for the defending champion.

[00:22:00.599]>>We'll see what the plan is for Sungjae.

[00:22:04.750]>>Easy to pump it by. Willie used the slope.

[00:22:09.459]>>Come on down.

[00:22:16.760]>>Textbook.

[00:22:21.709]>>Gotta be from left to right, surely, but not a heap.

[00:22:30.180]>>Hm, there it is. That's the man we saw dominating this golf course yesterday, 2nd birdie of the round.

[00:22:39.439]>>Sungjae trying to get it to 160 and keep pace here.

[00:22:44.160]>>You used to hunt him down, like he's the fugitive.

[00:22:50.650]>>There's another one for Sungjae on the hunt.

[00:22:54.380]>>Radar has given me images of Tommy Lee Jones and Marshalls.

[00:23:00.380]>>Learnt a lot, but over the.

[00:23:03.660]>>A couple of big old warts, gently from right to left, and then it creeps back a little left to right.

[00:23:11.939]>>Kind of like that.

[00:23:14.109]>>That's the first one from the other side of the, the green, kind of the left side of that spine that we've seen even close to the hole, and then he goes ahead and knocks it in. What a great putt. That's just that little extra bonus sometimes you need to get kicked into gear.

[00:23:29.800]>>2nd birdie of the round for Hirata.

[00:23:34.010]>>Doesn't want to move a whole heap this.

[00:23:38.900]>>The hole's moving out here.

[00:23:42.959]>>Two short misses here at the eighth for Im and Kim after Hirata poured in a 50 footer for birdie. That's the first stub of the toe today for the leader, and that lead has shrunk to 2.

[00:23:57.689]>>Nice over ahead and look here at the 9th.

[00:24:07.020]>>My windmill.

[00:24:10.699]>>Clark looking to climb within one.

[00:24:17.469]>>And currently Scheffler is 4 off the lead, pending the outcome of a birdie putt at the 9th.

[00:24:23.819]>>And this for Eagle here for Wyndham Clark, and we Si Woo Kim bunkered off the tee. This could be a big swing, and it most certainly is. Wyndham Clark just running the tables on the front nine putting wise.

[00:24:39.219]>>A Little left to right slider here and downhill for Scottie.

[00:24:43.319]>>Might have to give the hole away based on speed.

[00:24:46.400]>>That's a great 2 putt.

[00:24:48.310]>>Great 2 putt.

[00:24:53.859]>>OK, so what's the, it's 118, so it's gonna be a zipper.

[00:25:01.579]>>I'm interested to know the full, full.

[00:25:05.380]>>It, it, that's it.

[00:25:08.359]>>Yeah, right? They're speaking their own language. Si Woo Kim and Manny Villegas. It's almost as if Manny plays the round and Si Woo just hits the shots.

[00:25:18.550]>>So this is quick coming over that brow, you gotta have the.

[00:25:22.670]>>The touch and the imagination.

[00:25:26.180]>>Just to get it trickling over it, right here.

[00:25:32.689]>>Beautiful.

[00:25:34.099]>>Oh, how about that one? back-to-back bombs on 8 and 9.

[00:25:41.390]>>Don't you just love this game? Those are 2 putts back-to-back you just don't make. I mean, everyone's just trying to get this within 3 or 4 ft of the hole.

[00:25:57.130]>>Birdie the hard way for the overnight leader back to 20 under par and a two-shot lead. Just what he needed after that bogey.

[00:26:06.439]>>Scottie up on the green, trying to get to 17, get there.

[00:26:11.510]>>It did.

[00:26:13.160]>>Look out.

[00:26:15.449]>>Best player in the world is making birdies.

[00:26:18.979]>>4 out of the last 6.

[00:26:25.239]>>But three years since the last victory for Si Woo Kim came early in the 2023 season out in Honolulu when he won the Sony Open.

[00:26:35.109]>>For his 4th victory.

[00:26:40.660]>>That was a bad miss right there. Another lost shot for.

[00:26:45.310]>>Si Woo, now we've got co-leaders.

[00:26:48.609]>>5 shot lead has evaporated through 11.

[00:26:54.109]>>This one is very awkward for Wyndham Clark.

[00:27:00.790]>>Come on back. Come on, here you go. Oh, that was outstanding, Jay. Great imagination right there. Love that.

[00:27:13.880]>>Scottie is not in a bad position here. He's a little bit of an upslope, great line, not a lot of green to work with, but he can zip this.

[00:27:24.849]>>Hm.

[00:27:26.849]>>Both things were accurate. He zipped it and it did scare the hole.

[00:27:33.099]>>Here's Clark for birdie, and we may have a new leader here in a moment.

[00:27:37.300]>>It was a phenomenal bunker shot.

[00:27:40.319]>>Wyndham Clark, the 19 under, a fist pump to follow.

[00:27:44.979]>>What a day, what a sensational up and in from that stance he had in the bunker earlier.

[00:27:53.079]>>Scottie, just to formalize the birdie.

[00:27:56.709]>>Kind of a little Muhammad Ali and the uh rumble in the jungle against George Foreman, it's just kind of just wore George down.

[00:28:11.400]>>All right, in the heart.

[00:28:13.640]>>John is his first birdie in quite some time, as you can see there. 50 after the 1st 6, finally gets his next one at the 14th.

[00:28:22.290]>>It's a nab a birdie here if you can take care of this one.

[00:28:25.599]>>Firm and straight.

[00:28:27.930]>>Grabs a share, 19 under.

[00:28:34.050]>>Jaeger, having just bogeyed the 16th earlier, is 3 back.

[00:28:39.989]>>Right.

[00:28:48.199]>>Mm, flag hunting.

[00:28:51.079]>>About to reclaim that lost shot back at the 16.

[00:28:57.699]>>Just looking at the shade of the grass between Scottie and the hole. It looks like this one wants to fall a little bit towards us, from his left to right.

[00:29:12.439]>>Well, in fact, it goes just a little the other way. Nice birdie at a tough hole location.

[00:29:19.810]>>7th of the round for Scheffler on the march 5 to play here.

[00:29:29.920]>>Tom Hoge, nice up-and-down.

[00:29:32.930]>>At the hole ahead at the short par 4 14th.

[00:29:36.329]>>Back to Si Woo Kim.

[00:29:41.839]>>Flushed that one, didn't he? That was a much-needed birdie right there. He gets the lead on his own again at 20.

[00:29:50.770]>>Now Wyndham Clark with this putt to reach 20 under.

[00:30:02.790]>>Mm, straightened just enough.

[00:30:05.979]>>What a birdie for Clark here at 15, and he joins Kim on that 20-under mark. You know, I gotta say I'm watching this and I'm astonished at times, and Jay's just looking at it like, yeah, I could do that.

[00:30:21.390]>>Si Woo trying to be the first player to hit 21 under par.

[00:30:30.209]>>Oh, look at that, look at that dead weight right in the heart.

[00:30:35.430]>>Had a nice little comeback here since the 12th for Kim, the leader once again.

[00:30:41.449]>>And then the return putt of Wyndham Clark on the way here in a moment to try and keep the scorecard clean and stay within one.

[00:30:54.890]>>Like we said earlier, the straight putts are the hardest ones. And why is it the hardest putt? Well, number 1, you're aiming in the middle of the hole, your margin of error is cut down in half.

[00:31:05.099]>>Ahead to the 18th green where Si Woo Kim is playing his 3rd.

[00:31:16.640]>>It's hard

[00:31:19.569]>>I mean, I just love the way he plays, it just takes no time, doesn't go up to the green and look around and, you know, an unnecessary amount. He knows what the lie's gonna give him, he knows exactly how to play it.

[00:31:29.099]>>It's in there, sticks the club behind and pulls the trigger.

[00:31:32.660]>>Yeah, why not go ahead and polish this one off.

[00:31:38.060]>>Brilliant round of 60 yesterday when he flirted with the magic number of 59. Things did not come as easily today, but it was admirable work along the way, and he'll sign for 68.

[00:31:50.219]>>Si Woo Kim has eyes on his 5th PGA TOUR victory, entering Sunday with a 2-shot lead. The final round is next.

[00:32:01.400]>>We are here and we are playing for history and we're playing for the players that came before us.

[00:32:07.209]>>I've worked since I was 2 or 3 years old to have a chance to play professional golf for a living. The, the guys that win the most, they're in contention so much, they're up there all the time. That's where I want to be.
