Myrtle Beach and Dunes Golf and Beach Club are home once again this week as the 19th of 34 regular season events is underway and Mother Nature may be a protagonist, at least in the opening round, dodging some raindrops, but play currently underway, but it should be a sensational week of the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic.

[00:01:09.290]>>Let's get you caught up on the action from earlier today. Martin Laird got off to a great start, teed off the back, and at 15, the par 5, it was a big bird for the Scotsman. The eagle goes down, the start of a great day for him so far, Susie. Yeah, a great place to do it too. Playing one of the easier holes on the golf course, want to take advantage of that for sure. And he really did. He was.

[00:01:30.330]>>5-under on the round after that, 16, Daniel, the iron play really strong. And you see the receptiveness of the greens that Suzy was referring to there, throwing it in there behind the hole, controlling the spin beautifully there. 1 out in 30 for Martin Laird, not done seeing his action quite yet. Aaron Rai, great roller of the rock and a strong start to his week as he picks up a birdie at the 8th. He is in the mix. We just saw Mark Hubbard playing at 18.

[00:01:58.050]>>Here's what he did just a minute ago at 17, Suzy. Yeah, location just tucked on the right-hand side there, a little bit of a false front but carries it beautifully over that bunker, uses the downslope, goes on to make that for birdie.

[00:02:16.149]>>Laird at 18, adds another on the way out. It all adds up to 30 for the 4-time PGA TOUR winner, the veteran from Scotland. He just made bogey at his 11th hole today, the 2nd, so now a couple of co-leaders at 5 under par as we are fully off and running at the 1 flight Myrtle Beach Classic.

[00:03:23.970]>>Yeah, Tom Kim making his 11th start on the season.

[00:04:02.789]>>John VanDerLaan pours in a lengthy birdie.

[00:04:08.699]>>Paul Peterson.

[00:04:13.960]>>Yeah, well done. So that's how he crept up to 5 under par.

[00:04:26.839]>>Uh, Martin Laird, four-time PGA TOUR winner. Oh, well done. Boy, it just has the putter working today.

[00:04:43.579]>>And this aggressive looking tee shot.

[00:05:07.040]>>Because we go to 12, Brooks Koepka for birdie.

[00:05:11.160]>>Now, a couple of really solid iron shots, can he convert? Yes, he can.

[00:05:18.619]>>Mark Hubbard for birdie at the first. Oh, this would be a nice get after coming off the tee poorly to the right.

[00:05:26.709]>>Ah, it doesn't matter.

[00:05:30.760]>>Jump up a couple of 13, Christiaan Bezuidenhout notes 3rd shot of the par 5.

[00:05:37.970]>>Oh locations just back left here, 23 paces on. See how close that is to the left-hand side, Beautifully done. Just a nice little wedge pitch shot.

[00:05:51.480]>>Now the Scot

[00:05:53.279]>>Hits it more like an American than any Scotsman, one of the highest ball flights on the PGA TOUR, and that's why the ball stops just like that, and Martin Laird a chance to get to 7 under here.

[00:06:05.179]>>Saw that lovely pitch shot from Christiaan Bezuidenhout, Suzy. You can creep a little closer, just a formality, yeah, I agree.

[00:06:12.079]>>These are the nice ones.

[00:06:14.140]>>But still paying attention.

[00:06:35.519]>>Smooth, steady, solid. Christiaan Bezuidenhout bogey-free, now 5 under par through 13 holes today.

[00:06:48.119]>>For separation

[00:06:49.940]>>And he does it. A tap in birdie for the 41 year old from Scotland.

[00:06:57.140]>>Aaron Rai for birdie now at 13.

[00:07:02.040]>>Yeah, this would be a nice birdie here. You don't want to leave 13 without birdie in pocket.

[00:07:06.549]>>Certainly would lose strokes to the field. Really playing more like a long par 4 today.

[00:07:22.570]>>Beautifully done. Great read as well.

[00:07:29.709]>>Yeah, the Scotsman, this is going to be up in the stratosphere.

[00:07:52.260]>>At 6, Martin Laird to stretch the lead.

[00:07:57.950]>>There you go, another one. I mean that putting grip does not look comfortable, but I'm gonna go try it because he has made everything today, wow.

[00:08:15.450]>>As well he should be, lands on the downgrade portion, not able to get the ball to stop, but he'll have an opportunity for a closing birdie and posting a round of 68.

[00:08:28.549]>>As we take you to 13, Petr Hruby, a Monday qualifier. Nice birdie for Hruby. Meanwhile, Brooks Koepka is hiring a 22 ft birdie putt. He's got 4 birdies today to go along with a couple of bogeys, really hasn't been able to buy anything of length.

[00:08:50.929]>>You know, on the bright side though, on a day that has shown nothing but frustration, even with a miss here, he's still gonna post around in the 60s.

So here is the leaderboard right now, a long way from finish in the opening round of this one-flight Myrtle Beach Classic, but Martin Laird, setting the pace at 7-under. He turned back the clock a little bit today.

[00:09:59.190]>>Today it's live 2nd round coverage of the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic.

[00:10:05.460]>>The Grand Strand of South Carolina on the Atlantic coast, a confluence of shopping, entertainment, food, and yes, of course, golf, one of the golf capitals of the world, where the Dunes Golf and Beach Club hosts the PGA TOUR for a 3rd consecutive season and a beautiful Friday in Myrtle Beach.

[00:10:48.299]>>Cross-handed, conventional, what's gonna happen here?

[00:10:54.559]>>Becoming very popular, of course, the most famous cross-handed chipper right now, Matt Fitzpatrick.

[00:11:22.640]>>Makes a birdie. He's quickly becoming a, a fan favorite around the globe for his eclectic personality.

[00:11:39.919]>>Mac Meissner has made a move today. He is just one shot off the lead.

[00:11:46.849]>>And this could leapfrog him all the way to the top, 1 ahead now, the eagle pitch goes 8 on a par for Mac Meissner.

[00:12:00.030]>>Norlander at 16.

[00:12:08.700]>>Yeah, and the Swede, just about hole high there, just off the green, but uh very makeable opportunity for birdie.

[00:12:17.190]>> Keita Nakajima turned to the 1st and is disinterested. Yeah, just 7 off the right-hand side here and.

[00:12:25.549]>>It's a great kick

[00:12:27.799]>>So that's better than he expected.

[00:12:32.739]>>Norlander, 16.

[00:12:38.969]>>There you go. Now he's on the move. He needs more of those though.

[00:13:19.539]>>To 18, Ryan Ruffles for birdie. Down the hill, you see that audio transmitter tucked into the back of his belt.

[00:13:33.590]>>Certainly does. It gets him to 5 under par, 3 birdies in the last 4 holes now.

[00:14:05.219]>>I'm just trying to get a feel for that wind direction on the 13th here.

[00:14:14.590]>>This lands at the whole location. It found about.

[00:14:19.619]>>10 ft past as we've seen earlier today.

[00:14:23.340]>>Go down slope.

[00:14:29.650]>>Smart play.

[00:14:33.190]>>Brown for birdie

[00:14:35.890]>>That's a good role.

[00:14:39.330]>>By the way, that gives him a little bit of cushion.

[00:14:43.630]>>He says, yes, good for me.

[00:14:52.570]>>Big putt goes down for Sam Ryder at the 8th, just pours in that birdie effort, so Ryder.

[00:15:00.890]>>Makes the move to 5 under par.

[00:15:05.309]>>Hadwin at the 15th hole from the fairway.

[00:15:15.010]>>And he's on in 2.

[00:15:18.309]>>Adam Hadwin, an eagle effort.

[00:15:26.479]>>Oh, lovely putt.

[00:15:33.590]>>Easy birdie for Adam.

[00:15:37.489]>>Creeps a little closer, 4 under par. Let's get some.

[00:15:42.270]>>Just outside the top 10 now, tied for 11.

[00:15:47.840]>>Par 3 17th, Rasmus Højgaard for birdie.

[00:15:54.469]>>And we have one Højgaard in this field and one in the Truist Championship this week.

[00:16:01.479]>>Yeah, twin brothers separated by just a couple 100 miles. Yes, that's well done.

[00:16:11.359]>>To 9, Meisner for a birdie finish.

[00:16:16.869]>>Yeah, it doesn't look like he's playing a whole lot of turn in this. Well done.

[00:16:21.500]>>That was a bit of a yo yo finish there for Meisner.

[00:16:26.609]>>Oh, great 2nd day here at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, and a golf course, Suzy, that's really held its own in round two. Yeah, it continues to hold up in perfect conditions. I mean, wind is under 10 miles an hour, greens are receptive and soft, expecting to have very low numbers. We haven't seen a lot of that this morning.

Grand Strand. It certainly is, and one of the storylines out there, Petr Hruby, you see there right there at 3 under par, looking to become the first player from Czechia to make a cut on the PGA TOUR.

Yeah, coming off a hat trick of birdies with that eagle, he would go ahead and make a birdie there as well. So at that point he was 700 through his 1st 7 holes on the back nine. Yeah, part of a back 9, 29, and a third round 64 for Koepka. Beau Hossler is filling it up today. 31-year-old American making his 24.

Yeah, it certainly is, uh, as straight as he hits it, and he's a great iron player as well, and it's not overly long. He's been playing comfortably under 7200 yards all three days, and he's chasing Beau Hossler right now, the most recent birdie of his, Suzy, at the 10th, that drivable par 4. Yeah, his 7th birdie on the day, just through the 10th hole.

[00:19:06.989]>>Yeah, 15th playing quite easy today, reachable in 2 for the majority of the field.

[00:19:34.390]>>A lengthy bunker shot. Not sure if he can see the surface off the green. He can see the flagstick for sure.

[00:19:50.199]>>At the 10th, Snedeker.

[00:19:57.569]>>Down the hill, just to get to 11 and a tie for 2nd.

[00:20:12.739]>>The locations back left today, 25 paces on and 6 off that left-hand side. Long left is the only real error here.

[00:20:22.640]>>Below the hole, best place to putt for your, birdie.

[00:20:28.290]>>Well, it's fine.

[00:20:30.709]>>Aaron Rai for a share of the lead.

[00:20:36.670]>>Uh, there's a stack of golfers now a shot off the lead.

[00:20:44.959]>>That was a good looking stroke.

[00:20:51.140]>>Mark Hubbard, 1 back, he's at 11.

[00:20:56.390]>>Yeah, this is a really nice look at that whole location. He can go right at it.

[00:21:04.800]>>Good shot.

[00:21:07.109]>>It's Kevin Roy chips at 11. That leans a little left, lets that ball run right into the cup. Those are the ones we like, aren't they, Daniel? Unbelievable.

[00:21:17.569]>>Now Hubbard for birdie at 11.

[00:21:22.229]>>And he has a share of the league.

[00:21:26.469]>>Yeah, that's lovely for him coming off 3 straight missed cuts. This is a big week for Mark.

[00:21:38.030]>>Boy, I love his golf swing. It is such a beautiful move, beautiful setup, beautiful golf shot.

[00:21:49.839]>>Yeah, certainly has been hitting his approach irons beautifully this week.

[00:21:56.500]>>Yeah, I tried to spin that but difficult on that downslope beyond that whole location. Tricky to get close to this one today.

[00:22:06.239]>> Keita Nakajima for 11 under.

[00:22:12.260]>>Yeah, beautifully done.

[00:22:17.140]>> Aaron Rai, this is the place to hit it, Suzy, at 11?

[00:22:21.040]>>I mean, certainly, I, I like it a little short of this hole location, but only because of this slope here. So he has to navigate this little slope in the beginning. You can see into the grain there and then it's gonna flatten out on him. So it's a little tricky to get your speed right.

[00:22:34.260]>>It's a little easier putt from short of this hole location, but he might prove me wrong, which he will.

[00:22:40.989]>>Good for him.

[00:22:43.089]>>Our leader Rai now at the 12th tee.

[00:22:50.400]>>Now, Aaron Rai, this is the strength of his game.

[00:22:54.369]>>His mid irons, very few are better.

[00:23:04.010]>>Yeah, beautiful shot right in the heart of the green, with that hole location on the left-hand side, making sure you don't shortside yourself.

[00:23:11.449]>>Particularly on the longer par threes.

[00:23:16.540]>>Aaron Rai

[00:23:18.270]>>I want a 12.

[00:23:21.339]>>A lengthy plot here.

[00:23:23.540]>>Not a lot of breaking it. Should go a little bit from his right to left, but it's fairly flat as well. So it's one from just outside of 50 ft, you'd expect to get this down in 2.

[00:23:33.670]>>9.5 times out of 10.

[00:23:37.839]>>I mean, come on, that putter is just hot right now.

[00:23:45.670]>>Worth a wry smile. What a roll from Aaron Rai, 3 in a row and 14 under.

[00:23:54.640]>>Matt Meisner at the 15th.

[00:23:59.229]>>Yeah, pulled a pretty good lie over there, so had no issue with that and.

[00:24:05.390]>>Used it beautifully.

[00:24:08.780]>> Beau Hossler, looking for the proper weight.

[00:24:16.339]>>Yeah, that was really well done from that lie.

[00:24:21.579]>>Now Meissner for birdie at 15. Well done, well read.

[00:24:27.050]>>Just

[00:24:29.560]>>Back to the greenside action here at 13 with Roy and Hubbard.

[00:24:43.589]>>Right in the back.

[00:24:46.609]>>Yeah, I played with uh Seve a couple of times, I was fortunate enough to get to play with him, and I'll never forget the first time I played with Seve.

[00:24:54.319]>>I was like a pro-am partner. I just felt like I had to say something.

[00:24:59.030]>>And uh it was well documented that he wasn't in the US Open coming up. I was playing him in the French Open in the final round, and I just felt like, so why aren't you playing in the US Open?

[00:25:12.949]>>Like I knew that you were like, thank you for the conversation.

[00:25:18.109]>>Oh, it's gotta be quiet now. Yeah, that was the end of that.

[00:25:21.540]>>Oh, this is like a shot you'd hit when you were a kid. See him land on that back foot, sky high.

[00:25:31.439]>>This is an important make for Beau after that miss on 13.

[00:25:36.800]>>Well done. About the same length.

[00:25:41.130]>>Check in with Takumi Kanaya.

[00:25:48.739]>>And Kanaya.

[00:25:51.000]>>Yeah, it's to 8 under

[00:25:55.339]>>Well, here's Kevin Roy.

[00:26:01.920]>>Hang in. OK, what a good read.

[00:26:06.959]>>Aaron Rai is off to a great start. Aaron hit this much farther down here than I expected him to, so he's left himself a beautiful angle to this whole location. It's back right.

[00:26:18.510]>>It's just a standard little pitch shot for him. Looks like he's using very little loft there, Susie. Yeah, low trajectory, I think he's gonna run it back there.

[00:26:26.579]>>Almost looks like a pitching wedge.

[00:26:30.280]>>That's exactly what he did.

[00:26:34.829]>>It's almost the entire green surface. I love that. I wish every junior would put that on tape.

[00:26:41.689]>>What a run for Aaron Rai for 4 in a row to start the back. Yeah, I mean, we have to go with it, right? We have to say this is gonna be another, just that butter has been so hot.

[00:26:51.770]>>Continues to be just that.

[00:26:57.229]>>Yeah, this pan is gonna be hard to beat, uh, with this golf course, the way it plays.

[00:27:02.560]>>This literally plays into all of his strengths.

[00:27:09.680]>>14 Fairway now.

[00:27:16.500]>>He's posing.

[00:27:18.890]>>Yeah, a really good swing, but.

[00:27:20.969]>>Sometimes the best shots are the ones that are not at the flagstick.

[00:27:25.900]>>Full study from Mark Hubbard.

[00:27:32.109]>>You see that darker color of grain right around about the hole, that means that that it's fairly flat, and then right as it approaches the hole, it may just drift slightly to his left.

[00:27:44.489]>>Uh, with that kind of speed.

[00:27:46.900]>>There's no drifting at all, and Hubbard will move into a tie for 2nd.

[00:27:53.150]>> Brandt Snedeker chop pop lumber into 14.

[00:28:01.199]>>Oh boy. Full flaps.

[00:28:04.189]>>Yeah, he must have had an awkward lie to have to go in, but it was off that first cut, so I don't know what the issue was.

[00:28:14.400]>> Snedeker came rumbling through the green at 14.

[00:28:18.349]>>Actually, not the worst place for him to miss it. Plenty of green to work with.

[00:28:23.189]>>But that was, uh, not one of his best.

[00:28:27.790]>>Roy at the 15th from the rough.

[00:28:38.260]>>Well, not what he was looking for, but not difficult from there.

[00:28:41.719]>>Par putt here for Brandt Snedeker.

[00:28:53.770]>>So it will be his 3rd bogey of the day at best.

[00:28:58.699]>>This is for bogey for Brandt Snedeker.

[00:29:10.219]>>So Snedeker back to -11.

[00:29:16.410]>>We'll go to 18, the fairway Mac Meissner.

[00:29:21.790]>>Oh, and as he pulled it.

[00:29:24.589]>>Body English suggests that he may have just a little, but gets the favorable kick off the cushion, and that's gonna be a kick in birdie there from Mac Meissner, that should get him to 13 under.

[00:29:36.920]>>Mark Hubbard.

[00:29:40.000]>>Way left. It really worked out OK for him though on this par 5, that whole location where it is today. He still has a good opportunity for his birdie.

[00:29:49.829]>>Greenside with Roy.

[00:29:52.260]>>Yeah, this is just a simple little pitch shot, but hopefully it'll get up that slope for him.

[00:29:58.920]>>I did

[00:30:00.780]>>Here's Hubbard.

[00:30:07.489]>>He got it

[00:30:11.069]>>Now Roy for birdie

[00:30:18.609]>>And he gets to 13 under.

[00:30:21.489]>>Really nice.

[00:30:25.680]>>Up at 18 Mac Meissner for birdie.

[00:30:29.660]>>And he's in with a round of 64.

[00:30:39.849]>>Back at 15 Snedeker in the fairway.

[00:30:58.329]>>Right to left, beautifully done. That will get better, that'll get better.

[00:31:05.660]>>Eagle effort for Brandt Snedeker here. He could bounce back in a big way.

[00:31:09.969]>>Yeah, this ball is definitely gonna work over this first darker part of this grass from left to right, and when it gets about to the top of the darker part of that grass, it will stop turning, so he really has to play this, you can see where he's aimed right there.

[00:31:27.000]>>Little straighter than you expect. Oh my goodness, yeah, I, it's just like, I would love that putting stroke, just for the day.
