[00:00:43.369]>>It is a warm and humid day in the southern part of the United States. There you see it, 87 °F, it's about 31 °C.

[00:01:00.849]>>I am Matt Adams alongside of 2002 PGA Champion Rich Beem, 2002 PLAYERS Champion Craig Perks.

[00:01:09.190]>>Radar is on the golf course for us and there is so much to keep an eye on this week.

[00:01:16.300]>>He's on fire. He is absolutely on fire.

[00:01:21.129]>>Wedge, no wind, nothing.

[00:01:25.489]>>Oh, yeah, radar, he birdied his 1st 6 holes in a row, bogeyed 7, birdied 8, and a chance to birdie on 8 birdies in 9 holes would be quite remarkable. How about this scoring we've seen so far, Rich? Beau Hossler with a smooth 61. It's just the uh.

[00:01:43.129]>>The modus operandi of this golf course, you come here every year, you know you have to go out there and produce low scores after low scores golf course, usually plays very soft, uh, very easy, but always in great condition. Beau Hossler off to a beautiful start there. That was his birdie at the 3rd.

[00:02:00.900]>>That would be just the start. He would make birdies on 4569, and then this at 15. Yeah, he's a wonderful putter, uh, that got him 7 under through 15.

[00:02:14.429]>>But as I said earlier, it was the iron game, this at 17 going up the hill to a front hole location. He was 122nd in approach. He had 16 of 18 greens, first in proximity, first in strokes gained approach. That's how you put together a 61.

[00:02:37.750]>>And yet another opportunity, Rich, for birdie at the 18th. Yes, par 4 down the hill off the tee shot, 330 yards off the tee, 1:56 left, back straight up the hill. No worries whatsoever inside of 6 ft, easily.

[00:08:25.010]>>To your point, Beem a 352 yard drive, just 135 yards left and.

[00:08:34.750]>>Oh, goodness gracious.

[00:08:39.030]>>Jason Day at 17 with his approach shot.

[00:08:46.020]>>Great angle down there for for Jason, just inside 120 good shot.

[00:08:52.450]>>So just a wedge.

[00:08:57.179]>>And should love it.

[00:09:01.059]>>Well, he waited long enough to get the birdie on this, uh, inward 9, but lovely way to finish. little 62. Germany's Matti Schmid is the lone international on the leaderboard, sitting just 3 shots off of Beau Hossler lead. Round 2 is next.

[00:09:25.679]>>We welcome your company from wherever around the globe. You are joining us today. It's 87 °F. That's just over 30 °C. Typical summer day here, high humidity. Winds are relatively light as you can see southwest at night.

He can't come in this week, 122nd, he has to win the golf tournament. 2nd place right now, projected 72nd, he has to win.

[00:14:34.380]>>That leads to birdie

[00:14:39.219]>>Brooks Koepka. This is hard, slow up the hill and then down. Show me some touch. You'll need it. Wow.

[00:15:37.669]>>Yes, he can off the double bogey at the par 3. A birdie on the next, he gets back to 8 under, only 3 shots back.

[00:15:51.419]>>They drove it a long way down there, just 96 yards left to that uh front flag. Beautiful shot.

[00:17:06.880]>>Uh, he's just coming off a birdie on the 14th hole, one of the hardest par 4s on the golf course, and now you make an eagle at 15.

[00:18:06.099]>>They give the man a lot of credit to shoot 67 today, beginning this round with two bogeys. Give him a lot of confidence to go on the weekend trying to win for the first time.

[00:18:16.109]>>America's Beau Hossler takes a 1 shot lead over Ben James and the Englishman Jordan Smith. Round 3 is next.

[00:18:32.650]>>The venue is historic. This is the Sedgefield Country Club. We're in Greensboro, North Carolina, the stage upon which the drama that lies before us will play itself out. Beau Hossler, for his part, he opened with a 61, not even the best round he's had at this championship, a 67 yesterday stands alone on 12 under.

[00:18:59.260]>>To tie for the lead, he does it.

[00:19:04.739]>>4 under through 8 in the 3rd round and Tom Kim is on the move. Tom.

[00:19:52.979]>>That's more like it. One of the favorite sons of the area, really went to the Englishman went to school about 30 minutes from here in Greensborough, he went up at Wake Forest, up in Winston-Salem.

[00:20:09.589]>>How about an albatross and a birdie has been playing extremely well of late.

[00:21:21.020]>>To stay in 12 under and level par for the day. This is another one.

[00:21:25.560]>>This would be an amazing pa and even the up-and-down on the previous soul.

[00:21:36.969]>>Hopefully that will calm him down and get things back in order.

[00:21:43.400]>>An opportunity coming up for Eagle, and this will just get him one back and nothing to it there for Alex.

[00:22:01.949]>>He's actually 4th on the PGA TOUR in distance control from 50 to 150 yards, electrifying from those distances.
