[00:00:26] >> The PGA Tour proudly presents the race for the FedExCup. And now, coverage of the 2025 RBC Canadian Open.

[00:00:42] >> In its 114th edition, it's Canada's national championship on the golf course. And it's being played for the first time at TPC Toronto at Osprey Valley. Optimal conditions today. A little bit of rain in the forecast this morning. But this is the 38th different course to host the RBC Canadian Open. Just a few miles outside of downtown Toronto. With PGA Tour veterans Richard Lee and Nick Dougherty. I'm Taylor Zarzour. Wayne Riley Radar is on the course for us. And speaking of this course, Nick, 7,400 yard par 70 layout.

[00:01:31] >> Yeah, it is. A 72 if you come here and play as a guest. But a couple of those par 5s turned into par 4s. Of course, inspired by Winged Foot, big rolling fairways, tricky greens.

[00:01:46] >> Good scoring so far though.

[00:01:48] >> Bentgrass greens and fairways with thick bluegrass rough. Richard, we have 25 Canadians in the field. This is their national championship. Can someone repeat the Nick Taylor, the sensation he had a couple years back? I mean, 25 chances.

[00:02:09] >> You know, 2 years ago, Nick becoming the first Canadian in almost 70 years to win his home country's golf tournament. Twenty-six different countries represented in total, including Scotland.

[00:02:25] >> To 10 and Alex Noren.

[00:02:29] >> Stealing one there on the par 4. Water lurking down the right. Bounces the box, gets it back to level.

[00:02:37] >> Let's head to the 9th. Here's the one that won the playoff on Monday to get into the US Open, Cameron Young. He's been making putts like that all year.

[00:02:51] >> What a putt that was. Very difficult hole location today to get one on hole 9.

[00:03:00] >> At 11 with Hadwin hitting his tee shot at the par 3.

[00:03:14] >> Smart play right down the middle of the green. From Moose Jaw, Canada, in Saskatchewan, which is 1,600 miles away. Let's see if Adam can get his speed right here. Going to have ton of movement to his right. Another Canadian in the field. Yes.

[00:03:45] >> Back to 4. One of the best nicknames in golf, Nick Thunder Bear.

[00:03:50] >> Yeah, the translation of his name. Short par 3. And really a cracking opportunity. A couple of the par 3s today actually. Less so with that 11th hole we've been watching. But 4 and 14. You are thinking give yourself a chance for a two. Thorbjorn has there. Lowry on the tee at 11.

[00:04:19] >> Perfect 5-irons. Perfect for his fade. With the camber of the green gently from left to right.

[00:04:31] >> Oh, my. Watch out. Wow. It's got to be best of the day.

[00:04:52] >> Another flusher in Olesen. This time, trying to make it across this 4th.

[00:04:59] >> And he matches Willett at 6-under.

[00:05:04] >> Chance to get to 6 as well. Cameron Champ.

[00:05:15] >> Chili mate.

[00:05:17] >> Here they all come at 6-under now. We had nine tied to lead at 5-under about 10 minutes ago. Now, four tied to lead at 6-under.

[00:05:24] >> At 12, Rob MacIntyre.

[00:05:30] >> Good spot this in the rough. Doesn't have to worry about the spin, 92.

[00:05:38] >> Exactly that. It couldn't be a better example of the three throwing darts. That's exactly what it looks like.

[00:05:48] >> See if MacIntyre can be the one to make the birdie. Yes.

[00:05:54] >> Nice way to start your title defense. Good solid start.

[00:05:59] >> Champ at the 15th playing his second.

[00:06:09] >> Wow. He made that look easy. Brilliant wedge shot to control the spin and capitalize. Cameron Champ, one of the longest hitters on tour. Nice to see him play well.

[00:06:29] >> Olesen playing his second at the 6th.

[00:06:31] >> Just 64, up the hill, into this little corner.

[00:06:37] >> Definitely thinking three.

[00:06:41] >> Yeah, very good. Three good chances in that group upcoming. Done a lot, very well on this short par four. And he finishes the job off to join Champ at 7.

[00:06:58] >> Del Solar, rookie on tour this year. This back right hole location is a challenging one, where a lot of the players are just trying to hit the middle portion of this green. The green slopes left to right as well. The hole location is located, where if you get too aggressive, I want to say the water is in play, but the bank is definitely in play where it's a difficult up and down.

[00:07:45] >> That's a smart play at the fat portion of the green.

[00:07:48] >> Olesen putting for birdie at 7.

[00:07:51] >> Olesen having a great round today. I mean, the way he's been rolling the putt, this has got to be.

[00:07:59] >> This is a putt to get to 8-under par.

[00:08:05] >> Very makeable for him. And center cut. Well done.

[00:08:08] >> Eight-time winner on the DP World Tour, looking for his first PGA Tour victory.

[00:08:19] >> Looks like the sun is starting to shine on Radar and the Rink at the 14th.

[00:08:24] >> Yeah, it's all happening down here. Good spot. Every year, it's fantastic.

[00:08:32] >> All right. What are you going to do with your spin?

[00:08:35] >> How many birdies here today, Nick?

[00:08:41] >> I'm sure if we played, there'd be another 2.

[00:08:43] >> Forty wedge.

[00:08:44] >> Forty, yeah.

[00:08:46] >> Plenty of them.

[00:08:49] >> Cristobal Del Solar. What about this start, Richard?

[00:08:54] >> Great start. I mean, he's been having a tough season as a rookie, but hanging in there. And this helps. Perfect speed.

[00:09:05] >> At 14 with Connors putting for birdie at the par 3.

[00:09:13] >> Beautiful. At 8 with Olesen playing his second.

[00:09:21] >> Our leader.

[00:09:22] >> Beautiful posture. Really good move. Very rotational. See how low the club exits around his body. He could be a threat if he keeps doing that. Ready to make a big splash on the PGA Tour.

[00:09:39] >> Olesen putting for birdie at 8.

[00:09:42] >> Our leader to get to 9-under. Yes.

[00:09:46] >> Wow. Making the game look easy today.

[00:09:51] >> What a round for Olesen with all of those circles on the scorecard. You have seven birdies and an eagle.

[00:10:01] >> At 14 with Del Solar hitting his tee shot at the par 3.

[00:10:06] >> Well, to be at the score he is right now. I fancy him getting this one fairly close as well. It's just a wedge, 120, down the hill, playing slightly less.

[00:10:18] >> It's going to be a good look at it.

[00:10:25] >> For yet another birdie.

[00:10:26] >> And now, matches Olesen at 9-under. Look at that scorecard.

[00:10:35] >> Fifty-nine in play.

[00:10:36] >> Back at 17, Rafa Campos did the hard par. Put himself in the fairway to give himself an opportunity.

[00:10:45] >> Just can't miss right here. Just take dead aim. What a shot. That is the best of the day.

[00:10:53] >> Campos gets the 4-under par.

[00:10:57] >> Cristobal del Solar is on the 16th right now at 9-under par. Olesen in with 61. Champ, 62. Knapp, 63. And there's Lowry with 64.

[00:11:13] >> Round 2 is next.

[00:11:23] >> This is the second oldest nonmajor on the PGA Tour. Been playing it since 1904. And for the first time, they're playing TPC Toronto at Osprey Valley. After some rain came down earlier in the week and yesterday morning, we have beautiful conditions here on this Friday afternoon. And Canadians are showing their colors, packing this golf course to watch the best in the world compete for Canada's national championship. RBC Canadian veteran Richard Lee and Nick Dougherty are with me. Taylor Zarzour, Radar Wayne Riley on the golf course. Great to have three pros with us here in the box this week.

[00:12:11] >> Earlier today, let's see some highlights. First round leader Thorbjorn Olesen for birdie at the 8th.

[00:12:19] >> And doing what he did on the first day, putting the lights out of it. It was the best on the greens across the first round and it would through Day 2.

[00:12:28] >> Sixty-one matching Cristobal del Solar for the first round lead. After a couple of drop shots, here's a birdie at 11.

[00:12:35] >> What a perfect putt from above the hole. Aggressive effort, but gets it in.

[00:12:41] >> Ended up shooting an even par 70. Everyone is chasing the American two-time PGA Tour winner, Cameron Champ.

[00:12:50] >> Sweet roll. Right in the heart. Playing some nice golf right now. Champ shot 62 on Day 1, 66 this morning. He's 12-under. The Kiwi, Ryan Fox, for birdie at 4.

[00:13:04] >> And trying to build on that first PGA Tour win that came his way in recent weeks in Myrtle Beach.

[00:13:11] >> Just last month, Fox is four shots behind.

[00:13:16] >> Richard T. Lee on the tee. Called by Richard H. Lee.

[00:13:20] >> What a great golf shot here. Taking dead aim at this tough hole location.

[00:13:25] >> Making your namesake proud. Richard Lee tied with Olesen for second currently at 9-under par. Champ is out front. Lee is a Canadian citizen, so he'll get a lot of fan support over the weekend. Shane Lowry, 68 this morning, right in position. And look at those Canadian flags next to Nick Taylor and Taylor Pendrith.

[00:13:55] >> To the 9th. And the champion from two years ago.

[00:13:58] >> Nick Taylor coming from middle of the fairway, which is a key. Great shot to this front right hole location. Playing some really nice golf.

[00:14:09] >> Let's go back to the 8th.

[00:14:11] >> And this man is the shining light in this three ball. The Canadians going really well up ahead. Aberg keeping pace though.

[00:14:19] >> Fourth birdie of the day. He's to 6.

[00:14:23] >> At the 9th with Taylor putting for birdie at the par 4.

[00:14:31] >> A little slippery putt, moving left to the right. He's rolling it. Yes. Watch out. When Nick get that putter hot, he's scary.

[00:14:43] >> Tied for second.

[00:14:50] >> To go to 10.

[00:14:52] >> Yeah. That's all ahead for Nick Taylor. He'll have eyes on this at 159. Finds that corner. He's looking really strong and very much building on that form we saw at the Memorial.

[00:15:07] >> Sam Burns. Again, very scary hole. Ideally going to be just a little long and left of this hole location. Try to use a slope of the green. There it is. Like a friendly bounce. What a shot this is.

[00:15:20] >> Incredible.

[00:15:28] >> Great birdie for Taylor. Now, alone in second place at 10-under par.

[00:15:42] >> Brilliant tee shot using the contour. He should make this. One of the best players on tour.

[00:15:51] >> Currently five behind Cameron Champ at 7-under par.

[00:15:56] >> Burns is next to step into the arena.

[00:16:09] >> Good control.

[00:16:12] >> Really good chance for a birdie to come. Putt for Burns at the Rink to get to 7. And he does. He's within five. Definitely moving the right way with his game. Been good in recent weeks.

[00:16:36] >> At the 16th, Mackenzie Hughes playing his second.

[00:16:41] >> Seven-iron from 190. Trying to whip a right to left in there, I would think.

[00:16:47][ Applause ]

[00:16:52] >> Fabulous.

[00:16:55] >> And now, Hughes is ready.

[00:16:57] >> Chance to get to 6-under. It's a lovely approach. Yeah, finishes the job off. There you go, fifth birdie on the 16th hole of the day.

[00:17:11] >> At 13, Perez playing his second.

[00:17:16] >> Another beast of a par 4. Green slopes left to right. No issues there. Right at it.

[00:17:23] >> That would get Victor Perez to 8-under.

[00:17:26] >> At the 15th, Manassero putting for birdie.

[00:17:30] >> Coming from a spot to be aggressive. That was nice.

[00:17:34] >> Matteo to 8-under.

[00:17:36] >> I don't like the 60s. Yeah, I'm with you. What are you trying to -- where do you want it landing?

[00:17:43] >> Is that 86 hole?

[00:17:44] >> Yeah.

[00:17:45] >> Yeah, about 86.

[00:17:46] >> Yeah, I'd be on 86 to 88.

[00:17:48] >> Rory McIlroy is going to miss the cut.

[00:17:51] >> Right at it.

[00:17:51] >> So is Luke Clanton. But this man, Ludvig Aberg is on the mark playing his third shot here.

[00:17:59] >> This is a classic example for tall professional. But the challenge here is hitting the mark but then controlling the spin. The greens pitched at him. It's relatively soft. So there won't be a ton of speed through the ball. Lessens the spin. As much as it will come back, it won't come fizzing back.

[00:18:17] >> At the 18, Aberg putting for birdie at the par 5.

[00:18:37] >> What a way to finish for Aberg. Gets him to 4-under. He was Luke Clanton 2 years ago.

[00:18:47] >> Winning the PGA Tour University rankings and making his professional debut here. Won on the DP World Tour and a couple of wins here on the PGA Tour so far.

[00:19:02] >> We take a look at second round highlights. The Kiwi, Ryan Fox, winner in Myrtle Beach a few weeks ago, pours in this birdie at the 12th. Ryan would shoot 66 today, and included this at 13.

[00:19:19] >> Center cut. What a nice putt.

[00:19:28] >> Another example from the surface. Cracking ball striker Ryan Fox was doing a lot of this work with the putter. He is comfortable now on the PGA Tour, as he has been for a long time on the DP World Tour, one of the big stars there. This is what he does particularly well. One of the place to have a pop at the 6th green. It was on. Risky, but on. A bit of both. How's that for good work?

[00:20:01] >> Incredible shot right there.

[00:20:04] >> Has a rugby body, but has quite the golf background, and he has built quite the CV too.

[00:20:13] >> That would be the genetics from his dad being passed down, I think that one. The great All Blacks, the team that won the inaugural World Cup.

[00:20:22] >> Looking at Ryan Fox and what he's done this year. Winner of the ONEFlight Myrtle Beach Classic, chipping in to win there last month. He's currently tied for six. That's 8-under par. Cameron Champ leads by two over Andrew Putnam, Thorbjorn Olesen, Richard Lee, Nick Taylor, all 9-under par. Nick, I think most people going into the weekend will look at that first name that's tied for sixth.

[00:20:45] >> Yeah, I think so. I think from, you know, a European perspective, there's an excitement around Shane. We know his relationship with Rory, obviously steals the show is from golfers from the island of Ireland, this generation. But Shane is playing so consistently well. Tee to green, only Scheffler's been better statistically this season. And he's had those runner up positions, the near misses, and he is super hungry.

[00:21:19] >> Beautiful Toronto, Ontario, Canada is the site once again. And for the first time, they're playing TPC Toronto at Osprey Valley this week. This beautiful layout, three different courses at Osprey Valley. This is the North Course. And it is yielding birdies and eagles on this moving day under beautiful conditions, 74 degrees. We have not had a lot of wind in the forecast this week. With tour veterans, Richard Lee, Nick Dougherty, and Radar Wayne Riley, I'm Taylor Zarzour proud to be broadcasting Canada's National Championship, the second oldest nonmajor on the PGA Tour.

[00:21:58] >> At the 2nd with Fox putting for birdie at the par 4.

[00:22:10][ Applause ]

[00:22:13] >> Birdie, birdie. He's to 10.

[00:22:16] >> Head to the 3rd after a birdie, birdie start.

[00:22:22] >> Feeling good right now. Probably take dead aim at this hole location. Oh, wow, what a shot.

[00:22:30] >> Fox gets to 11-under par.

[00:22:35] >> McCarty tied for third at 12.

[00:22:42] >> Very well.

[00:22:46] >> Manassero's one back.

[00:22:47] >> Playing it to the fat portion of the green. Right at the TV tower. Very smart play. It's only going to get a little bit better.

[00:22:59] >> It is a nice shot.

[00:23:01] >> Well, he missed the fairway, gouged it out to this point. There's a chance to join the two at the top. And he makes it a trio. Top 10, full Top 20s on his season, including one at the Masters.

[00:23:22] >> Manassero, difficult par-3 11th.

[00:23:24] >> And he finds it.

[00:23:25] >> Wow.

[00:23:25] >> Putt on 10. But what a response on 11.

[00:23:28] >> Fell off the main tour. You're looking at one of the biggest stars in the game at one stage. Great galleries out there for Canada's National Open. Spread out across the course. Manassero.

[00:23:52] >> Great control.

[00:23:53] >> Matteo Manassero to tie for the lead. Yes.

[00:23:56] >> Just enough and some body language.

[00:24:03] >> Let's head to the Rink.

[00:24:04] >> This could get close as a lefty. Come on back. Well done.

[00:24:17] >> Mackenzie Hughes coming in at 18.

[00:24:21] >> He can get one, maybe even two. Create some drama for tomorrow for all the Canadian fans. >> And there's a real chance. That's to tie for the lead.

[00:24:38] >> Great golf shot there by Mackenzie Hughes.

[00:24:43] >> Putnam is even on his round today. Champ won over as those last two on the course are trying to get something going. McCarty to try to match Manassero and Fox.

[00:24:56] >> Yes.

[00:25:01] >> I'm seeing too many read that putt properly.

[00:25:02] >> Matt certainly got.

[00:25:06] >> At 18, Lee Hodges playing with Mackenzie Hughes.

[00:25:12] >> He too is 11-under par. And he'll have an even better look at eagle. To 18, Lee Hodges to match the leaders.

[00:25:39] >> What a way to finish. Signs off in style. Sixty-three, and he'll have a shot tomorrow. Whether or not he'll still be there at the top means to be seen, but brilliant way to thrust yourself back in there.

[00:25:56] >> Mackenzie Hughes, obviously one of the Canadians, making a run.

[00:25:58] >> Needed another roll. He'll have a chance tomorrow, 64.

[00:26:08] >> Wouldn't they love that as well? Wouldn't they love that on the property there? The storyline Canada once.

[00:26:15] >> How about those two? Sixty-three for Hodges, 64 for Hughes.

[00:26:25] >> Fox now at 12.

[00:26:27] >> One skip, put the brakes on.

[00:26:29][ Applause ]

[00:26:35] >> At the 12th, Fox putting for birdie at the par 4. Ties for the lead at 13-under par.

[00:26:48] >> Now, Matteo.

[00:26:50] >> First cut. So does not have to worry about backspin as much to this whole location.

[00:26:55] >> Brilliant. Manassero with the arm lock claw. It's working out great. Takes the solo lead.

[00:27:10] >> At 14, Jake Knapp hitting his tee shot of the par 3.

[00:27:28] >> Another one. Takes the pace out of it. Won't come back enough.

[00:27:36] >> Seen Vince repeat of that all day, Richard, isn't it?

[00:27:38] >> It has been perplexed.

[00:27:47] >> On the 14th, Jake Knapp trying to match the others at 12-under.

[00:27:53] >> He's going to work a little left to right down there. Trying to get within a couple. Manassero is flying right now.

[00:28:17] >> Yes, sir.

[00:28:19][ Cheering and Applause ]

[00:28:40] >> Kevin Yu trying to finish the last of this mile in high style. Has that for 13 under.

[00:28:58] >> Yeah, that is a fearful prospect. Number 3 at Quail Hollow. Toughies on 16, 17, but a chance to finish here on the last.

[00:29:07][ Applause ]

[00:29:14] >> Sixty-three today for Yu.

[00:29:18] >> Co-leader Matteo Manassero, third shot at the home hole.

[00:29:25] >> Follow through, driving in low. And a stunning shot to the last.

[00:29:32] >> And there's your answer on whether we would see someone get to 14 or not.

[00:29:47] >> Missed the fairway off the tee. Had to lay it up. Did this damage with the wedge. Just a tap in to lead on his own.

[00:30:05][ Applause ]

[00:30:10] >> Sixty-four for the Italian and the outright lead.

[00:30:18] >> Perfect tee shot. Super solid. Into the heart with the second.

[00:30:33] >> Fox for the outright lead.

[00:30:35] >> I thought that was going to keep turning.

[00:30:40] >> It's so weird that has got left right there, and yet moving around from similar sort of directions, almost going the other way. Tricky little hole location on the last. It's a four though.

[00:30:54] >> Well, unless Cameron Champ does something extraordinary in the last three holes, it's going to be Manassero and Fox in the last pairing tomorrow.

[00:31:06] >> I mean, do you feel like it is?

[00:31:12] >> I mean, obviously.

[00:31:13] >> Yeah.

[00:31:15] >> Out with a baffy. Some kind of little spoon. Less than a 3-wood. If it is a 3-wood, it's back bunker.

[00:31:29] >> Two-six-two. Trying to hit a floater in there.

[00:31:33] >> I can confirm that says 3-wood. And that 3-wood is about 15 years old.

[00:31:40] >> I'll tell you something right now, that goes the right distance because that is a fluff. Gorgeous shot.

[00:31:46] >> Full high.

[00:31:47] >> Highly makeable as well.

[00:31:50] >> At 18 with Champ playing his third from the fairway at the par 5.

[00:32:00] >> One-two-seven. This is a hard shot for him. The yardage is gorgeous, but there's a little fall off to the front of it. If he gets too much action on this thing, this could be wet. And we know he likes to send them deep into the green. So he's relying on some action on this thing. Flirting with the back edge maybe. Total bailout. That's just a wide, isn't it? I mean, really, let's face it. Through the fringe. Very holeable. Right to left.

[00:32:33] >> Maybe not his best stuff today, Richard. But that's a tap in for 68.

[00:32:37] >> Yeah, nothing special, but still right in it. I mean, he didn't have his best stuff, but that could also boast some confidence, right? You know you didn't have your best stuff, but you got another shot at it tomorrow. You're only two shots back.

[00:32:54] >> And the last man on the course is Champ.

[00:32:57] >> He was deep in thought for a long time by himself. Squatted down and he was just -- The visor was down over his eyes for a bit. It was like -- He looks so very disappointed. But things can brighten up if you roll something like this in, even though that's going to be a tough gig. Out of his left and it's really quick up there, or down there, hole side.

[00:33:21] >> Come on, Champ. Knock one in.

[00:33:31] >> Well, he's just used that club too many times today.

[00:33:37] >> This will be his 32nd stroke on the greens.

[00:33:44] >> One bogey at 2. Seventeen pars to go with that one bogey. And he'll start the day three behind. Manassero and Fox will be last to play tomorrow. Hodges and Yu right before them. McCarty and Hughes in the third to last pairing.

[00:34:27] >> Who will claim Canada's national championship on Sunday afternoon.

[00:34:34] >> We have 28 players that are five or closer to the lead.

[00:34:40] >> Lowry for me.

[00:34:42] >> Fox.

[00:34:43] >> Why not -- How about another Canadian winning the RBC Canadian Open? I'll go with Mackenzie Hughes. Can't wait to find out.

[00:34:54] >> The final round coming right up.

[00:35:37] >> Played at TPC Toronto at Osprey Valley for the first time in this tournament's 114 years. Good conditions today with temperatures not even 70 degrees. And the Canadians are packing the course. And there are low scores to be had on this championship Sunday trying to win that trophy. With veterans, Richard Lee, Nick Dougherty, and Radar Wayne Riley, I'm Taylor Zarzour, proud to be broadcasting this national championship from all over the world. This man is from Canada, trying to win it 2 years after his friend Nick Taylor did it. Matt McCarty, a winner in Utah last year on the PGA Tour. And the New Zealander, Ryan Fox, won last month on the PGA Tour.

[00:36:37] >> The Italian Matteo Manassero has had a resurgence in his 30s. Looking to become the third Italian ever to win here in North America on the PGA Tour. But none of them have the lead. Shane Lowry has gone off on fire here early on Sunday.

[00:37:03] >> What a shot on the first hole. One of two eagles today. This sets him up. What a beauty.

[00:37:10] >> Tap in eagle for the Irishman. Birdies at 2, at 3, and then, at 4.

[00:37:18] >> Can't stop making him.

[00:37:20] >> He needed a quick start to force his way in starting four back. He has exactly that.

[00:37:27] >> So Lowry is 15-under and leads. Emiliano Grillo is the hottest man on the course. This at the Rink at 14.

[00:37:37][ Applause ]

[00:37:44] >> Grillo 8-under as he plays the par-4 16th, and now is 14-under, one behind Lowry.

[00:37:52] >> Three birdies for a 59, but also probably three required to post a number that might be relevant. There's good numbers out there today, Taylor.

[00:37:59] >> We have a 61. Had a couple of them, in fact, on Thursday, a 62 on Friday, some 63 yesterday.

[00:38:10] >> Here's a chaser at the 1st.

[00:38:12] >> Can't be more than a 9-iron for Cam Young. Playing straight downwind.

[00:38:16] >> Wow. This is a par 5, folks.

[00:38:20] >> Young gets to 13-under.

[00:38:23] >> Kevin Yu looks like he has almost a wedge in his hand, look for the looks of it. Wow. That helps when you have that much power. Coming in with a wedge on a par 5.

[00:38:34] >> Second shot for Kevin Yu. Spin. In you go.

[00:38:45][ Cheering and Applause ] You too.

[00:38:51] >> Well played, my friend. You too, indeed. How about that birdie, eagle, and now the leader by one?

[00:39:07] >> Let's not forget about this man.

[00:43:09] >> Won the Sanderson Farms Championship in Jackson, Mississippi last fall for his lone PGA Tour victory. Just one Top 10 this year.

[00:43:17] >>> Loft in his hand here. He's trying to take out some of the shoulder. If he played along the ground, he'd have to give such a big break. Ball doesn't turn when it's in the air. Still didn't have a nice banking from right to left though.
