TPC River Highlands, this has been the stage that this drama has played out since 1980. This golf course that you can see in your upper right-hand corner, Matt Adams along Billy Kratzert, Craig Perks, and Brendon de Jonge on the golf course. The course sits alongside of the Connecticut River. You can see just a little piece of it up there on the right. Where are we in Cromwell, Connecticut? Well, here's a look at exactly where we are located. We're in the part of the United States called New England in the State of Connecticut, and settled almost equally between New York City and Boston, Massachusetts. That is TPC River Highlands from above, this golf course that has roots going all the way back to 1928. There's the river up there in the right that I was telling you about. It does have an impact, Billy Kratzert, on this golf course and the way that it lays out in the natural topography.

[00:01:51] >> Yeah. You look at the length, actually the shortest course the PGA Tours played this year up to this point. And the architect, Pete Dye, 1982. But the renovation, which absolutely outstanding, the job that Bobby Weed did in '89 and brought the river into play. And the lower half that we like to call it, it's just so well done. And 15, 17, 16, pretty exciting.

[00:02:23] >> Yeah. Very distinctive holes indeed. Earlier highlights today. This is Rory McIlroy at the aforementioned 17. This is birdie.

[00:02:37] >> This is at the fourth with World number 1 Scottie Scheffler.

[00:02:41] >> That's a good one. Hole playing downwind today, Matt, but that's always a good birdie.

[00:02:49] >> Our leader, Austin Eckroat. This was at the short par-4 15th. Nearly making a two. He would tap in for there for three and move on to post an 8-under 62 for his opening round.

[00:03:05] >> I had a chance to speak with Austin up there earlier this week, and he told me that he'd been struggling with his game. But very typical of touring professional. He said he felt close. And the close was delivered today with that 8-under 62.

[00:03:20] >> Well, scoring good. Guys taking advantage of a very well-conditioned golf course. The greens are at a speed that, you know, they're kind of right in that 11, maybe 11.5 on the Stimpmeter.

[00:05:15] >> Xander here. You're going to have to play this on the ground at some spot. Land it in the flat, let it release up.

[00:05:42] >> Justin Thomas at 14 with his approach.

[00:05:45] >> Usually really good. Just controlling the distance. Well, there's another example. Well, that had to have hit the cart path down that left-hand side in order to get the ball that far down there.

[00:06:15] >> Good tee shot from Scottie. Stayed just short of those fairway bunkers down the left side. Now, a long iron. Didn't cut in this back right corner. Anything that can you get sort of around the front right portion of this green is ideal. Two-thirty-six straight back into this breeze.

[00:06:31] >> You can nearly take the water left out of play and go a little long too if you wanted. He seems to always hit the right shot at the right time.

[00:06:41] >> This looks to be the right shot right here.

[00:06:44] >> It's just, it's remarkable to watch. Here's a shot from nearly 240 yards. Perfectly hole high. It goes another 2 or 3 yards. It's down into a low area. Nearly impossible to get the ball up and down.

[00:07:08] >> Well, it's been a pretty easy putt to read. We've seen several players make it from this exact spot. Maybe a little bit closer. Moves gently to the right.

[00:07:33] >> Scheffler's got a chance to go to 8-under right here.

[00:07:37] >> And it's not a difficult putt, guys. Just outside of 10 feet.

[00:07:57] >> Well, from outside 20 feet for Xander. And OK.

[00:08:14] >> Crash into the flagstick.

[00:08:23] >> World number 1 sits on top of the leaderboard after Round 1, surrounded by a star studded cast. The second round is next.

[00:08:41] >> As we say, hello and welcome from wherever around the world you are joining us here at TPC River Highlands. We're in Cromwell, Connecticut, just about equidistance between New York City and Boston. The weather conditions today, temperature wise are beautiful. Eighty-two degrees Fahrenheit, rounded up to 28 degrees Celsius. Matt Adams, alongside of Billy Kratzert, who won this event back in the day. Craig Perks, Players Champion. Brendon de Jonge is working the fairways for us. And Perksy, today's a little bit of a different day than what we had yesterday. Scottie Scheffler went out and shot an 8-under 62 in the opening round of the afternoon, seeking to become the first defending champion since 2002. Rory McIlroy had an excellent opening round as well, a 6-

under 64 Round 1. We're going to be seeing a lot of Rory today. And so far, it is a very different day. That's what I was just alluding to with Craig, which we'll get to in just a second. But first, let's show you what's going on with Scottie Scheffler at 14 when that stroke is working.

[00:10:00] >> You can see a clean line, the bunker, Matt, and great angle. That wind is cranking out there.

[00:10:32] >> Only bogey yesterday was the 17th hole. So for two rounds, he's played the 17th hole 3-over par.

[00:11:42] >>How about that for an eagle?

[00:16:44] >> Six-under currently, is tied for sixth. He's at 27 Top 5s on the PGA Tour without a victory.

[00:17:07] >> Yeah, 125. I mean, you can stuff it in there pretty close.

[00:17:23] >> This is Tommy Fleetwood at the 15th with his second.

[00:18:20] >> At 16, Tommy Fleetwood for birdie.

[00:18:24] >> This easy putt to read. It's one you can put some speed behind it as well.

[00:18:29] >> He ties the lead with that one. Look at that scorecard.

[00:18:45] >> Scheffler stays at the top, but Tommy Fleetwood joins him after a marvelous 65. The third round is next.

[00:19:03] >> Hello and welcome from wherever around the globe you are joining us. We're here at TPC River Highlands in Cromwell, Connecticut. Absolutely beautiful, traditional New England style golf course. It's a beautiful day for golf. Eighty-four degrees Fahrenheit, about 28 degrees Celsius. Matt Adams, Billy Kratzert, Craig Perks, Brendon de Jonge out on the golf course. And it's a golf course that is more giving today, I would say in general. Some very good scores are being posted. Let me show you exactly where we are. We're in the northeast part of the United States. It's a part called New England and encompasses six states. This is a State of Connecticut. And Cromwell is about equidistance between New York City and Boston, Massachusetts. So, gents, this golf course is a unique one. And Billy, you've had the chance to play and had success at this event. Won it in 1977, was at Wethersfield. You also played and did very well on this venue. What do you make of this modern version of the course?

But the renovation done by Bobby Weed, bringing in the Connecticut River, enhancing the back nine, the fairways, bluegrass, Poa annua. Then of course, you have that mixture of bluegrass and fescue for the rough. But greens are in great shape. They're running about 12.5 on the Stimpmeter. So all good. Looking for a great weekend.

[00:20:47] >> We got the World's number 1 who just turned 29 today. Happy birthday, Scottie Scheffler. Trying to defend his championship. First guy to do it since Phil Mickelson back in '01 and '02.

[00:21:16] >> He'll move to 5-under.

[00:21:19][Applause]

[00:29:12] >> To move to 17-under.

[00:29:31] >> Scheffler struggles, and Fleetwood capitalizes. A 63 for Tommy. Gives him a three shot lead as he tries to put away his first PGA Tour victory after a 63 on Saturday.

[00:30:32] >> It is indeed a delight to welcome you from wherever around the globe you're joining us today here at TPC River Highlands. We are in Cromwell, Connecticut. Temperature about the same as it's been all week, about 83 degrees Fahrenheit. That's about 27, 28 degrees Celsius. Matt Adams alongside a four-time PGA Tour winner and winner of this event, 1977, Billy Kratzert. Craig Perks, former Players Champion. And out on the course, of course, will be Brendon de Jonge. You're looking down on the golf course that is bright and sunny now. Was a little wet earlier today. Here, gentlemen, are some of the storylines. It starts with Tommy Fleetwood on 16-under par after rounds of 66, 65, and 63, seeking his first PGA Tour win.

[00:35:56] >> Talk about an unpredictable lie. On the downslope, bumped it into the hill. All in all, that is excellent.
