We'll talk all about what's at stake this week as we take you down to this magnificent slice of golfing terrain, just an hour outside the city of Tokyo, and for all those lucky folk who reside near the capital city of the land of the rising sun.

[00:01:38.790]>>Well, it's quite the complex, Gary. Absolutely, relatively short by today's standards, but it's windy today. North wind about 25 miles an hour. Fairly thick tree lined fairway, so you can't smash it all all over the place, but just redone fairly recently by Coore Crenshaw, it's a terrific test and actually they did the other two holes as well from the other, from the east course, just to make sure they got their full footprint on the whole course. So it's gonna be a magnificent venue this week.

[00:02:06.010]>>Just gone past 10 a.m. local time, some top players making their way around the turn in these awful weather conditions as we speak. So let's just show you exactly how it's looking as we head live to the action. Nicolai Hojgaard, the day is looking to wrap up his tour status.

Max Greyserman, who was pushing the eventual champion Nico Echevarria all the way to the conclusion last year of the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP there at Narashino Golf and Country Club. He is at 4 under playing the 12th.

[00:02:42.889]>>And some local players as well, firing on all cylinders. Well, Adam Scott is way down on the FedExCup points list. He's not worrying about starts though for next season, not with his standing in the game, but he's still keen to have a good showing here this week. That was a stunner into that front pin. And just getting a bit of a flavor for just what we're talking about when we say the conditions are less than favorable. Minwoo Lee meanwhile.

[00:03:09.679]>>Rolling the rock nicely. Already a winner this season on the PGA TOUR from the Houston Open. It's a very different entity to Memorial Park though.

[00:04:54.790]>>Now this is Shogenji, one of the Japan Golf Tour players looking for that first red number of the day. Well, it's such a special week for the homegrown players, and it's just one experience after another. The fans are about as passionate fans as you will find anywhere in the world.

[00:06:40.350]>>Oh, beautifully done mate, look at this, look at this. Oh, he's having a run at the end, isn't he, after a disastrous run through the middle of the golf course, the end of the golf course is gravy for Hojgaard. Look at that of the Nicolai version.

[00:07:05.839]>>That wasn't out so nearly, in the middle.

[00:07:13.470]>>Cadeira for a birdie at the 15th, lackluster day.

[00:07:21.950]>>He's carrying reds crowd around with him as well.

[00:07:27.480]>>Now this is Satoshi Kodaira.

[00:07:32.670]>>You come in, there you go.

[00:07:36.760]>>Always a nice noise, Gwen.

[00:07:39.899]>>A PGA TOUR winner.

[00:07:42.399]>>In front of his home fans, Barry's a beauty, even if it is for a score that will underwhelm even heat.

[00:07:55.690]>>This is to tie things up at the top.

[00:08:00.329]>>Shortest hitter on tour and he's won twice. There's something so admirable about Brian Campbell and look at that finish as well, eagle birdie to play the homeward half in 5 under. Incredible.

[00:08:16.019]>>Get it up and over, but look at it, it's got a little bit of a punch bowl at the back there.

[00:08:23.130]>>This is Nico Echavarria and his well, well, come on now. I I like a punch bowl. Look at that. Well, good on you for calling that there Gary Christian. That's why you're our chief.

[00:08:50.150]>>Hold on. Complete lack of guilt there Echavarria.

[00:08:55.320]>>Hang your head, shake it, shake it.

[00:09:02.080]>>I heard there's a bit of sake getting consumed up there, I would have thought. Hospitality and Yokohama. Well, a good day in the end for Nico.

[00:09:14.400]>>If you're even par, you're not only inside the top 25 as we come towards the end of this opening day's play at the Baycurrent Classic, but you're only all back of that lead, and all these players will harbor ambitions of a big weekend's golf to come.

Excitement abound at Yokohama Country Club, the first day in the books at this wonderful slice of golfing terrain. We hope for better conditions tomorrow. Lots to play for, lots to think about for so many of the golfers pegging it up here in this limited field.

So these players best get their passports ready. And of course this new golf course for this year's tournament in the land of the rising Sun Yokohama Country Club, a composite made up of holes from the two courses at this cracking complex.

[00:11:11.530]>>There's a lot at stake for these guys. If you can stay between 51 and 60, you get signature events next year, at least a couple guaranteed, and maybe even more depending on who plays in front of you. So those spots for those players that have kept their card this year are huge.

[00:11:33.330]>>And The Genesis Invitational or the events that those next 10 players outside of the top 50 that are of course already locked in. And let's just talk about.

Yeah, this is where the players are playing for them, you know, in effect, their livelihoods to have a schedule that they can set. It's very, very difficult when you get in those conditional statuses where you want to be able to plan your year ahead. So 100 is the number right now. Matt Wallace just.

[00:12:04.830]>>Clinging on there just by just over 1 point and if you think over the course of a season, that's, uh, I missed 3 ft here, not maybe giving up a little bit on a hole here somewhere else. It's just incredible just how it all comes out every year to a point or two, but there's some, you know, some, some big names. Obviously Adam Scott there hasn't had a top 10 all year, very unusual. Some really good players though that have something. Rico Hoe, keep an eye on him this week. He's one of those players that,

The last 3 or 4 months it's been very, very good, so playing well this week, uh, just one off the lead. There'll be plenty of talk throughout the rest of this week here in Japan, where we'll be discussing players under the pump and how they're going to respond to some of the pressure. We discussed that a little bit during our round one coverage and sometimes players with their backs against the wall do pull out some of their very best golf.

[00:13:26.570]>>This is Kimo Bojegus flirting with the trees there at 14. 4 under par for the day, that's going to 5 under.

[00:13:40.919]>>Very short, firm fairways.

[00:13:44.760]>>Really good chance for a 3 here.

[00:13:47.909]>>And that's a really good look.

[00:13:52.619]>>Now Max Greyserman, this is an eagle try to not just take the lead, but take a nice cushion at the top.

[00:13:58.210]>>Downhill right to left because it's gonna stay up. Yes it is. What a put.

[00:14:03.820]>>Right in the center there.

[00:14:10.409]>>Max Homa's in the green side trap.

[00:14:13.760]>>Well, you'd have to ask how is he there in 2, but now he's just gonna pick it out for 3. That is a bonus that.

[00:14:33.109]>> Villegas. Oh, that's a bonus putt down there. Puff of the cheeks, because that was motoring.

[00:14:44.190]>>I'm trying to save his par here at 17. 0 well, doesn't need the putter. When you, when you're 150th or worse on the putting stats, there's one way to avoid that.

[00:15:01.030]>>This was a stunner of a tee shot from Xander. He asked it for one to carry 1 more yard, and it did just that, maybe even a couple extra. Not much club left in here.

[00:15:20.830]>>He gets to 7 under.

[00:15:30.250]>>Well, the man who is the favorite at the moment as we approach the halfway stage is this man Max Greyserman. Go on then. Yeah, there you go, 63 blows on day two. That's a statement.

[00:15:45.250]>>Looking to go one better than he did in Japan 12 months ago.

[00:15:57.760]>>Xander's turn. Remember coming off the back of a birdie at 17, 7 under for the round.

[00:16:09.809]>>I'd be shocked if he, it's another good one here.

[00:16:12.960]>>Certainly liking it. Oh yeah.

[00:16:17.669]>>We'll have that for a round of 63, which will be a joint low round on the second day.

[00:16:25.130]>>He's gonna have to hold that for a chance at the last group.

[00:16:31.020]>>Now Xander, who's just been a joy, he's made this look like a walk in the park. The absolute polar opposite from yesterday, where everything was a struggle. So these world class players, the elite of the elite, can just sort of just turn it around overnight.

[00:17:03.539]>>Tight end over end.

[00:17:07.349]>>It's a round of 63 for Xander Schauffele.

[00:17:14.270]>>So we'll do a big trawl down the leaderboard, then you can see Greyserman leads Smalley, Alex Noren by 4 strokes. Garrick Higgo, who had a great week last week at the Sanderson Farms Championship, has traveled with his form from Mississippi to here, and great to see so many Japanese players making hay whilst the sun is shining. Tiger semiar we've seen a little bit of. Hideki Matsuyama brought some better stuff to life today just to get those crowds really going.

[00:17:42.969]>>Treat them Mikumu Horikawa around in 69 as well. Austin Ekroat two wins on the season last year, therefore doesn't need to worry about where he is on the FedExCup points. He's playing just just for the fun of it. I say that with tongue in cheek. And of course Sami Valimaki, another man looking to lock up that card for 2026 but needs something special over the course of the weekend. Gary Christian, Rob Lee, thank you very much and a good afternoon to you. Yes.

[00:20:40.479]>>Some excellent golf, the best of his career so far.

[00:20:46.180]>>Hanging light for Zander, this is gonna hook in the air, gotta start it right at the green and that is as good as it gets from there. Fabulous approach shot.eagle putt to come.

[00:20:57.170]>>Well, this is how the leaderboard looks then as we join the action during this 3rd round, he knows where the conditions have taken a bit of a turn once again, not too dissimilar to that opening day. Grayson and yet to get off the mark in terms of red numbers. We'll talk more about him in a moment, but it's starting to bunch up a little bit.

If he plays great, he can put enough distance with him that he may be able to coast in tomorrow, but slow start, everyone else starting to make birdies early on, so everything gets tighter. [00:23:26.170]>>There's a complete unforced error, all caused by a terrible choice to get a lob wedge from that wet geer when he didn't have to, just play the percentage easy shot you can, did not have to shobo there.

[00:23:40.280]>>A great looking leaderboard, including this man, the defending champion, looking to get to double digits into the red numbers, and he has easy peasy Echavarria, defending champion on a different course. It's not putting him off.

[00:23:54.439]>>Yeah, maybe a little bit more. OK, yeah, edge of that tree, center of it. You're 180, that's a lot of loft in his hand, that's.

[00:24:04.699]>>You cannot be getting this on the green, it looks like a wedge.

[00:24:08.839]>>If the yardage is right and it's 180, it doesn't look like enough club.

[00:24:27.939]>>Oh, gotta think it wasn't 180 or it wasn't a wedge. Oh, it was, it was lofted. No way that was 180. What a shot, stunning shot, ridiculous, ridiculous shot.

[00:24:38.369]>>Let's take it back to Max Greyserman as well here at number 9, 117 after that pasted tee shot.

[00:24:47.709]>>He's trying to turn this into a positive for himself. He took the chance off the tee.

[00:24:52.680]>>What about the sand wedge?

[00:24:58.359]>>It's good, it's a very good shot.

[00:25:03.199]>>I think this is going to be one of those weeks we're going to see very fluid situations for this whole weekend. It's good keeps everybody on their toes. Yeah, you nearly said everybody awake there, didn't you? Very nearly in some parts of the world, this is in the middle of the night. It is. Well Xander, therefore will have this to take the solo lead.

[00:28:50.459]>>So it was a shame that, 2 good shots from Zander get it on the green.

[00:29:20.459]>>The 17th with Si Woo. He's leaking oil. Si Woo came after a peerless front nine.

[00:29:35.329]>>Let's take you up to number 18 and Si Woo, who's 2 back.

[00:29:40.949]>>It's just oof, the Gary player walk through there.

[00:29:45.760]>>Nice looking thing. I think we'll be trying that. I might be talking with a go at that tomorrow. That, that was unlucky there, need another 2 yards. It would have been very close. Look how far that's come off. Look at that. That's strict, isn't it, off off of a very good looking shot. Yeah, I'm very fortunate to avoid that uh divot there.

[00:30:06.569]>>Will go to the last and Si Woo, this is where that second shot wound up. Oh no, so there's that false front. Look at this thing, collect, oh no, that goes straight back in his divo there straight right there, Si Woo. Oh dear.

[00:30:22.709]>>Yeah well it's not far away. You're kidding me. Stop it. Oh no. Oh, stop it.

[00:30:30.140]>>OK, so,

[00:30:32.250]>>Still looks like he's playing it up in the stance, so a little bit harder this time.

[00:30:37.709]>>There we go. Sometimes you just let it go, don't you?

[00:30:45.339]>>And on that one. So he's got 107 yards. Breeze helping. It's less uphill from here.

[00:30:54.439]>>And I think this is a flat out lob wedge.

[00:31:02.579]>>What we haven't seen this week is, his balls really spinning. It's hardly happened. It's almost like it plugs and stops, so he can be aggressive with this.

[00:31:24.170]>>Beautiful, very, very good.

[00:31:29.150]>>Now up ahead at the last, this is a must make really for a bogey putt.

[00:31:34.359]>>It was an adventure that last hole, wasn't it? It didn't look the most convincing the strokes, did it? It felt like watching him there. He hit about 8 shots on that hole. It's only a one single drop. It's not disastrous.

[00:31:53.640]>>And to tie the lead

[00:32:13.640]>>Never anywhere else was it? Well done Xander Schauffele, tied at the top once again.

But Schauffele is looking to try and get himself back in the winner's circle. The world number 4 hasn't won since his second major victory in July of 2024 for a stop-art 2025 season. This would be the perfect way for Xander Schauffele to cap off a return.
