Along with PGA Tour veterans Brendon de Jonge and Richard Lee, Colin Swatton on the golf course, I'm Brian Katrek. So where are we? Downtown Atlanta, Georgia. It's right in the middle of the southeastern portion of the United States. An old railroad depot originally named Terminus because of all the railroad crossings that came to a head right here. And we're just a little bit east of the city, hence the name East Lake. About 3 miles from the State Capitol. And it was an out of town downtown -- out of town retreat for the old residents of Atlanta, 3 miles away. Lots of different architects have had their hands and fixed fingerprints on here, including Donald Ross. But it was Andrew Green back last year that came through between '23 and '24, changed a lot and set it back to some of its original designs. We're going to talk about that all week. This is the 18th fairway, where the FedExCup is going to hang in the balance. Already a hot start earlier today from Nick Taylor, college teammates with Richard Lee. And how about this start, Richard, for Nick?

[00:06:52] >> And moving ahead to 16, Russell Henley for the lead alone.

[00:06:57] >> Russ Henley wanted nothing to do with the right side of the screen. Big breaker from left to right. There you go. Continues to add up that yardage of putts made today.

[00:07:34] >> Now, at 18, Justin Thomas for birdie.

Golf course was so ready, and now it is so wet. It's been raining most of the morning also. Still little rain in the area. We got to dodge that for the next couple of hours, and then, things should slow down for the afternoon. [00:39:42] >> Get the ball bouncing up there with a little bit of top spin up there. You just want to make sure you get it beyond the hole.

[00:39:53] >> But also too, Brian, you've played this place before, too. He heard the cheer, the big cheer that went up for Scheffler over there on 9 as well. It's never over until it's over. But it's helps to make these.

[00:41:47] >> Yeah, let's take a good look at this one, Brian. Down the hill, moving from right to left. Watch this stroke. Let's see if there's any hesitation in it.

[00:42:06] >> As I said back on the tee, you just almost sense just a little change.

[00:43:21] >> Here, 125 with the uphill adjusted in. Back into a little bit of breeze from his left.

[00:43:32] >> What a shot. What a shot from Tommy Fleetwood at the right time.

[00:43:43] >> Put some pressure on Fleetwood.

[00:43:48] >> Looks good. Looks really good.

[00:43:55] >> Tommy for his birdie at 12. And right back out to a two shot lead.

[00:44:02] >> We move to 13 fairway with our leader.

[00:44:05] >> Emotional week here at the TOUR Championship. Tommy Fleetwood now here at the 13th.

[00:44:12] >> Yeah, 144 adjusted all in for the uphill. Trying to move something in a little bit from right to left. This looks really good.

[00:44:21] >> It is really good. What a golf shot.

[00:44:23] >> You got to know exactly what you're trying to do.

[00:44:35] >> Oh, boy.

[00:44:36] >> Like Scheffler, Bradley drops two shots at the 15th.

[00:44:45] >> Back at 13. Patrick Cantlay for birdie.

[00:44:49] >> That should be an inside right edge putt here for Cantlay.

[00:45:03] >> Yeah, there shouldn't be too much doing in this one either, BK.

[00:45:08] >> He just keeps answering the bell.

[00:45:11] >> Let's go, Tommy.

[00:45:15] >> Tommy, Tommy. Three clear.

[00:45:20] >> Scheffler had a similar putt and missed it. Here's Scottie now for birdie at 16.

[00:45:26] >> Not too much to this one. Should go a little right to left. And nicely done there.

[00:45:34] >> Here's Russell Henley for his par at 15.

[00:45:39] >> Very slow.

[00:45:42] >> And another one drops back. So now, there's no one at 15-under.

[00:45:53] >> This is by far the longest he's taken to hit a golf shot today. By far.

[00:45:58] >> It's already out of his routine.

[00:46:03] >> I agree with both of you. I think that was an extremely long conversation, which needed to be. What is the front number? What is the pin? Let's split the difference and hit land. That's all that is required here for Fleetwood is to hit land.

[00:46:20] >> To the pin location. Tucked all the way in the back of the green here. What wind is here is into and from the left. And this is a 5-iron for Fleetwood.

[00:46:46] >> It's a good shot. I mean, under the circumstances he is ecstatic.

[00:46:53] >> If he is to put something in close enough to put a little bit more pressure on Tommy Fleetwood. This man is not going to make it easy coming to the home hole. He flights this out very low. This needs to keep going and chase its way back there.

[00:47:22] >> So I think this is a good choice. Still a steep bank. He's got to come up. But once it gets up on top of the green too, BK, it's all running away from him.

[00:47:46] >> Two-man race right now and they know it.

[00:48:03] >> It's a bit tentative effort there from Tommy. But all in all, bogey's not going to kill him.

[00:48:25] >> It's not out of reach. But if you had offered Tommy Fleetwood this situation at the beginning of the week, he would have taken it. That was in Memphis. Two clear with three to play. Made bogey at 17. Rose caught him, passed him.

[00:48:47] >> Right now at the 17, birdie putt here for Russell Henley.

[00:48:50] >> Brilliant second shot to this point. Not a lot of movement to this.

[00:48:58] >> Maybe this will be the last shot for Scottie Scheffler. And it is.

[00:49:11] >> Now, Cameron Young for birdie at the 18th in a round of 66.

[00:49:17] >> This has to go in.

[00:49:23] >> Well, now, he's going to need some help from Fleetwood. That man walks to the 72nd hole with a three shot lead.

[00:49:40] >> And he's hit the fairway the last 2 days. He has been on this tee box. One more good swing, Tommy.

[00:49:54] >> That looks like it was it.

[00:49:58] >> Absolutely. Full release and couldn't have walked it out there any better.

[00:50:08] >> Fleetwood looks like he's got his most -- his longest iron out here, Colin.

[00:50:14] >> Yeah, with only 242 to go. I thought it would have been a little bit of a clip at it, but he's laying it up on the left side, trying to get it down there, create a bit of angle. Did that get in the bunker?

[00:50:32] >> Fleetwood's third shot.

[00:50:35] >> That's just got to release a little bit more for him.

[00:50:40] >>He can taste it now.

[00:50:45] >> Now, it's going to feel good. Now, it's going to feel really good. We may even see a smile out of Tommy Fleetwood now.

[00:50:50] >> He can write down all of those statistics about his finishes, and he can have a little bonfire with him.
