The 6th of 7 events in the FedExCup Fall and for the 7th consecutive year, the Butterfield Bermuda Championship welcomes the PGA TOUR in the early portions of November with Southampton Parish on the southwest side of Bermuda, where the Atlantic breeze can.

So great to have you with us this week, Mayan Patel, alongside Jay Townsend, Rob Lee, and our entire outstanding crew with you in Bermuda, where this Robert Trent Jones design.

[00:01:28.620]>>In the middle of the Atlantic enclave is our host once again, Port Royal Golf Course, 665 miles off the east coast of the United States.

[00:01:41.010]>>And always poses a big challenge to those who take it on. Jay Townsend our ballpark this week, not long in terms of length on the scorecard, but certainly can get the brain spinning.

[00:01:54.730]>>Kind of like Fenway Park, you know, a little bit small, aged, it's aged well. It's not about the length of the golf course. You can see it's, uh, under 6900 yards long, Bermuda grass. It's about the elevation changes dealing with the wind. It's gonna be a fun challenge to watch the players deal with the conditions. It's gonna be windy all week. Who can handle the wind? It's all about just creating things.

[00:02:17.929]>>Well, it's a good creation earlier today for Ryo Hisatsune, 23-year-old out of Japan, one of the co-leaders early in the action today. 5 birdies to go along with 1 bogey in this par, 71 track, and Ryo Hisatsune came into the week 92 in the FedExCup Fall standings, reflected on his strong opening round.

[00:02:40.220]>>Given your position in the FedExCup Fall, how important is this week and next week for you? Yeah, unfortunately like 9 something like that is close to the standing, so yeah, I'm nervous, yeah, actually a little nervous but more just playing the golf, so like keeping keeping golf. So yeah. Do you feel like you handle the nerves pretty well, yeah, a little bit but it's OK.

[00:03:16.110]>>Rob Lee, great to hear from one of the co-leaders after that opening round. A big smile, perhaps a nervous smile, but he got it done in round one. Yeah, you know what, you probably at 902 are going to be OK for the season, but as a player, you always feel and try to build in worst case scenarios. So to come here and take care of it and maybe if he wins, you know, it changes everything. So that's the big carrot here for the players. Get the W and then your life changes for the better, Jay.

[00:07:37.589]>>Just nice and firm, don't give the hole away.

[00:07:48.209]>>Thornberry on the tee at 3.

[00:08:01.480]>>He'll make Birdie from there.

[00:08:11.640]>>Olsen, level par, that's good.

[00:08:16.250]>>This one trying to find the target and the flag, which it has done comfortably tapping it in all of a sudden.

[00:08:24.549]>>From Japan to Takumi Kanaya, the 12th, birdie putt. This one goes a little bit right to left.

[00:08:30.649]>>Well done, took some of the breakout. Kanaya, a former number one amateur ranked player. Impressive Frankie Capan downhill lie at the 12th, but a very good angle from the left side of the fairway.

[00:09:00.750]>>PGA TOUR rookie just inside the top 100, Isaiah Salinda.

[00:09:14.359]>>Canadian Adam Hadwin leads the pack after round one with a 6 under 65. He's in must win territory to keep his card. The second round is next.

[00:09:34.549]>>For the 7th consecutive year, it is a late season island escape for the PGA TOUR. Southampton, Bermuda, and Port Royal Golf Course welcoming 120 of the world's best in this penultimate event, the 6th of 7 in the.

Adam Hadwin had it going early, 600 to begin the day in early birdie and then backs it up with one of the 4th. Well, he held so many putts of that length yesterday and just continued.

[00:11:16.000]>>So it's only a wedge up the hill, but trying to get it the right distance from here, difficult.

[00:11:24.570]>>Sounded horrible.

[00:11:28.109]>>Played it unbelievably well.

[00:11:31.340]>>It is a guessing game coming out of that rough.

[00:11:34.969]>>Oh I see the satin setting up for the draw, that pins in that back left corner just to the right edge of that bunker you can see over the water.

[00:11:48.559]>>Oh, good shot shape.

[00:11:50.530]>>Really good.

[00:11:53.880]>> Ryo Hisatsune for birdie at 3.

[00:12:00.869]>>He moves to 6 under.

[00:12:06.469]>>Zac Blair is 2nd on the left hand side of the fairway. He's got a good view of the pimp from there.

[00:12:13.989]>>And it's working its way back down to 3 ft. What a beauty.

[00:12:18.859]>>Yeah

[00:12:21.400]>>Smalley 2nd at 12 off a downhill light or a front pin, not a great angle. Oh beautiful shot.

[00:12:32.500]>>Talla at 10 for back-to-back birdies. 5 of his last 6. He is on a roll and he needs it big time.

[00:12:42.010]>>Eric Cole on top of the hill at 13, 226 today. It's a bit of a beast. But the wind is around a quarter. It was dead into the players yesterday.

[00:12:57.450]>>That is truly an excellent golf shot, really good with that shot.

[00:13:09.549]>>Back left pin, left to right, starting the ball left of the flag and cut it right back onto the target. What a shot.

[00:14:14.989]>>Campos for birdie, he is fighting to hang around for the weekend. Needs some of these. Should have a little left to right to this one back into the wind.

[00:14:32.840]>>McGreevy, this is a tough putt. the first half of this putts uphill into the grain, then it's downhill, down grain ever so slightly, but

[00:15:03.599]>>And more perfect. It's been a great day. Defending champs still has a fighting chance. There's not much club in here. 99.

[00:15:13.539]>>Oh, what a shot.

[00:15:17.140]>>Not far off the fall line, maybe just off the left a little bit.

[00:15:23.510]>>Beautiful cut, brilliant 3, big heart. Well done. Love that. Well done.

[00:15:34.229]>>Camposs eagle at 17 wouldn't be enough and he misses the cut in his title defense by 1 shot, but Adam Hadwin maintains a 1 shot lead into round 3.

[00:15:49.409]>>PGA TOUR on island time this week, where the calendar has quickly turned to moving day, the penultimate Saturday of the FedEx Cup Fall from Port Royal Golf Course in Southampton, Bermuda.

[00:16:04.479]>>Where we wind down the race for the top 100 PGA TOUR cards and of course the victory that hangs in the balance this week. The wind is up and so are the scores from the 75 players who made the cut this weekend.

[00:16:24.289]>>There's no telling who's gonna jump out there today and maybe give themselves a little bit of space for tomorrow.

[00:16:30.900]>>At the 9th for Rikuya Hoshino.

[00:16:34.330]>>Birdie Put with the hat on backwards like you were at dinner last night. That's just straight in the middle of the cup.

[00:16:41.710]>>At least it works for one of us, Hoshino now the closest pursuer at 9 under.

[00:16:51.520]>>Only 130 yards due to the windy conditions. It's really a tough hole anyway.

[00:17:02.549]>>Hoshino for back-to-back birdies and a share of the lead. Should come a little bit towards the camera, his right to left.

[00:17:09.688]>>Yeah.

[00:17:14.380]>>As he battles for his PGA TOUR card over the next 2 weeks, 14 now, it's Va.

[00:17:22.750]>>It's so important to just try and stay steady.

[00:17:29.329]>>Oh, get it there, he did.

[00:17:42.650]>>Kanaya at the 11th.

[00:17:45.959]>>He was 8 under par and about to go minus 9. What a shot that is.

[00:17:52.890]>>Hoshino at 11.

[00:17:55.339]>>For 3 in a row in the outright lead.

[00:18:01.040]>>And that one, or even though it caught the edge, was running at the hole once again, that's why he's had that birdie run. He's been fearless with the butter.

[00:18:10.829]>>Down on the steel.

[00:18:13.260]>>There's so much upper body movement there and the shoulders weren't moving on the plane of the stroke. They're moving kind of open.

[00:18:35.680]>>Had one on the way at 10.

[00:18:42.859]>>And how do I need to win and that shot right there is going to help him.

[00:18:59.020]>>But he's playing putting grip roulette at the moment and that was both hands on the grip and he's holding another one. He seems to be doing just fine, doesn't he?

[00:19:16.219]>>Oh, well done, that's it, that's the style.

[00:19:21.589]>>Bit of aggression.

[00:19:26.410]>>To the 12th McGreevy, uh, from right, a poor angle wind.

[00:19:31.520]>>From his right playing this shot.

[00:19:35.829]>>Out of the rough asking it to sit, it does, wow, what a shot.

[00:19:48.890]>>17th very scorable opportunity in the end. This, this is the gift birdie of the whole tournament and that's a gift eagle and it's for the long players driving a wedge.

[00:20:02.329]>>So he's in there tight for eagle. Iron Place felt good today.

[00:20:12.140]>>Oh, that works. Easy eagle takes any putting issues in the wind out of the equation.

[00:20:24.739]>>Phillips 1 to 12.

[00:20:29.500]>>And up the hill, over a ridge.

[00:20:34.449]>>This distance control is difficult.

[00:20:38.969]>>Yeah, well done there. Oh, look at the spin on that one.

[00:20:42.729]>>Phillips is gonna get to 11 under with that tap in coming up.

[00:20:51.520]>>Great 2nd shot. Matthew Riedel trying to make good on it. It'll be a 2nd back nine eagle, which would be amazing, and he'd be 8 under, which he is. What a run that is. Two stellar shots, 2 eagles.

[00:21:09.760]>>All right, birdie putt here, just inside right. Oh, well done for Thornberry. He gets it to 11 and a tie for second.

[00:22:53.410]>>Into a right to left wind to a narrow green.

[00:22:59.770]>>OK.

[00:23:05.670]>>A lot of work left for Kanaya. Yeah, you know, very disappointing shot choice for his 3rd at his par 5 17th. He defensive, yeah.

[00:23:17.530]>>That was not a defensive position.

[00:23:21.140]>>And now he's got heavily downwind. There's a great view of it, doesn't do much.

[00:23:28.650]>>And he turns it into, thankfully for him, a birdie 4.

[00:23:36.619]>>Hoshino had a share of the lead early, lurking 2 back. A big tee shot here.

[00:23:42.890]>>Trying to play a cover draw against the left to right hurting wind. Oh, wonderful shot.

[00:23:54.530]>>Schenk

[00:23:58.770]>>That's just a 9 iron.

[00:24:01.300]>>At the par 5 17th.

[00:24:03.739]>>And he's done really well with that. That's very makeable for an eagle. Schenk writing his own check right now.

[00:24:11.500]>>So McGreevy looks like it's playable. He's not in the water.

[00:24:16.699]>>You can still make birdie here.

[00:24:19.670]>>be a massive result.

[00:24:22.739]>>Well, he just might do that. What a fantastic shot from there. Couldn't see the pin, blind.

[00:24:31.469]>>To post double digits.

[00:24:34.359]>>Huge putt here for Hoshino, slowing up the hill. Oh, well done.

[00:24:41.510]>>And a pretty darn good finish after that double bogey at 15.

[00:24:49.760]>>And Adam Schenk.

[00:24:52.000]>>Putting for eagle and the outright lead.

[00:25:02.260]>>Well, he hit that where his body suggested it was going to go. I know it's all cockeyed when you watch him do everything, the feet and the shoulders and.

[00:25:13.560]>>To the 18th now, McGreevy.

[00:25:16.650]>>Appeal into the left to right wind.

[00:25:19.449]>>Cut down the front bowl it's only 12 yards wide from fringe to fringe.

[00:25:30.829]>>Fly or lie, anything around the green will be good.

[00:25:37.150]>>Sounded like great contact.

[00:25:40.729]>>Unbelievable. Are you kidding me? I mean, that's just beyond good.

[00:25:54.670]>>That's to stay bogey free on the day. Schenk with a good look up coming at 18. Thornberry could join him momentarily at 12 under. It swings from the right. It makes its way to the hole. Get in there. That's how you do it. Oh my goodness me, I'm leading.

[00:26:13.359]>>Oh.

[00:26:15.900]>>Yeah.

[00:26:26.810]>>Uh, there is a look up at 18, the narrow little portion.

[00:26:32.459]>>Of this front green.

[00:26:35.680]>>Only 12 yards wide, McGreevy didn't need much of it, took it right over the top of the flagstick.

[00:26:45.910]>>Down grain

[00:26:50.229]>>This would be

[00:26:52.180]>>Much needed birdie for McGreevy, currently ninety-sixth in the rankings. I got it done, right?

[00:27:00.760]>>Oh, payoff putt, great birdie at the last.

[00:27:21.020]>>Can he make the putt? Can he get to 13 under? He's down 100% gonna be down on the shaft with the right hand with the finger down the shaft here.

[00:27:31.119]>>He's going low

[00:27:34.699]>>I think just right, center, firm, into the grain.

[00:27:39.750]>>Here we go, get the finger down there.

[00:27:45.839]>>To us has been fighting the polls. That was, that was a weak effort, but a bogey free round.

[00:27:59.469]>>Schenk battles the tough conditions to join a tie at the top. He's looking for his first victory on the PGA TOUR. The final round is next.

[00:28:49.060]>>The 6th of 7 events in the FedExCup Fall. It's the final round of the Butterfield Bermuda Championship from the shores of Southampton, where the wind is up once again and will certainly be a big factor as we wind our way towards the end of the calendar year on the PGA TOUR.

Strongest winds of the week, slightly different wind direction by about 40, 50 degrees.

[00:30:18.770]>>Schenk this ball kind of settled down in a little bird's nest. Tough lie.

[00:30:28.119]>>He he had a stab at it, and that's an excellent shot.

[00:30:32.949]>>Uh

[00:30:39.660]>>Every spot on the leaderboard certainly matters when it comes to the points at the end of the day. You guys have mentioned the breeze, Jay, a difference in the green speeds here this week. That's because of that wind. 2.5 shots or 2.5 ft slower on the stent meter than what the average tour event is, and it's because of the winding.

[00:30:56.244]>>Conditions. If they had even greens at 10.5 or 11, we would not be playing right now. The ball would be blowing on the green. So great job setting a golf course up, knowing what the conditions are here. I think tour staff has done well all week with tea and hole locations. Now boogie putt here for Kanaya.

[00:31:22.189]>>We go to the 10th Rikuya Hoshino for birdie got fire on this stretch yesterday.

[00:31:30.030]>>Uh, grand. Well done, poor Hoshino.

[00:31:47.479]>>3rd shot at 12 for Alex Smalley.
