[00:05:45] >> Yeah, another good look. Right underneath the hole. Not much to this. Just got to keep speed up.

[00:05:59] >> So Ernie Els with a birdie. Gets him to 2-under.

[00:06:04] >> Go over to 18. Jacobson just short of the green in that bunker in two, his third.

[00:06:13] >> It's a nice shot from a long ways off.

[00:06:15] >> John, what about this lion stance for Ernie?

[00:06:22] >> Yeah, there's really no issues. He might have to keep it underneath the tree limb though that's right in front of him. Try to drive something up that chute, up the front of the green. He only has 184 yards to the front of the green. Good lie. Ball slightly below his feet.

[00:06:39] >> Looks like he is going. He's looking low.

[00:06:41] >> Yeah. Watch how high he gets his glove hand.

[00:06:44] >> Yeah, no doubt.

[00:06:45] >> Big long backswing still for Ernie Els. And his glove hand gets way up high above his right shoulder, kind of between his ear and his shoulder. That's why he still hits it so far.

[00:07:11] >> Trying to shoot it up the front of the green. Needs to get a little left. Just kicks into the bunker.

[00:07:21] >> Freddie Jacobson now has a chance to post 6-under and the outright lead. And he pours in that birdie putt.

[00:07:32] >> Third for Els at 15.

[00:07:37] >> Yeah, good line. A lot of room. But the slope of the green goes away from him. That's the land that may be just on the green or a little chunk and run.

[00:07:55] >> Justin Leonard for birdie at 18. And Justin in with a 4-under 68.

[00:08:03] >> He wants to win more than Justin Leonard right now.

[00:08:16] >> Got to pay attention to this one a little bit. It does go away from him. Get up and down.

[00:08:39] >>He's still got a lovely action.

[00:08:43] >> Ernie now 226 front, 242 hole. This is that kind of driving 4-iron. It says 4 on the bottom, but the loft does not say 4.

[00:09:02] >> Try the same shot he did at 12. Trying to hit a low runner.

[00:09:09] >> It's going to spill into that bunker.

[00:09:23] >> Much more straightforward shot here, Cookie, I would believe for Ernie.

[00:09:27] >> Yeah, it's just long, his long bunker shot. Give him probably 25-yard bunker shot. So good that one.

[00:09:53] >> Paul Stankowski with yet another birdie. So he's at 5-under and now just a shot off the lead.

Joe Durant on the golf course at 4-under. How about Mario Tiziani? Four-under through his opening nine. Petrovic and Andrade in with 4-under par 68s. Jerry Kelly grinding out that 3-under par 69. Jesper Parnevik, who played in Morocco, he's at 3-under through his opening 10. Couples and Richard Green in at 2-under par. Thomas Bjorn, Brett Quigley playing 18. Hensby heading to 18. They're at 2-under par.

So many wonderful things to do in Naples in the community year in and year out. Roll rolls out the red carpet. Tiburon Golf Club for the fifth year. The Black Course playing host to the 38th playing of the Chubb Classic, the longest running PGA Tour Champions event in the same market, 38 years strong. Justin Leonard getting off to a really fast start in search of that first win on the PGA Tour Champions. Rolls in this birdie putt at 7. That would be his third in a row and get him to 8-under par. Ernie Els, a winner already this year, playing his second into the 8th. Paul Azinger, he had doubled the 7th, so a great bounce back for Ernie.

[00:13:43] >> Talked about the way he follows through on his putts. It's still kind of the same. You know, you don't want to stop at the bottom of that stroke. You want to keep going at the hole. So easy to kind of pop it. But Justin Leonard, he exemplifies the perfect follow through, I think.

[00:14:04] >> Yeah, bump and run specialist as well. A couple little knee knockers left there. I'd give this knee knocker category, wouldn't you?

[00:14:23] >> Mario had a really good year last year, earning a spot on the PGA Tour Champions and having an opportunity to play a lot of events. Shane, go ahead.

You know, he's a bigger hitter, still young. He's only 54 years old. And he just -- He and his caddie spent a lot of time on this shot. The wind is into him now. Even got a little left or right in it. Nice long green. Not a lot of trouble up here.

[00:16:43] >> Straight downwind, 128. Just a nice pitching wedge here for Justin. Hole location right in the front part of the green. Take it in there nice and high. Right at it. Another good looking shot.

[00:16:57] >> Well, Tiziani elected to lay up.

[00:17:04] >> He plays point to point and it pays dividends.

[00:17:08] >> Can Justin Leonard add another one?

[00:17:16] >> Justin Leonard, wow.

[00:17:19] >> Let's go over to 15. Billy Andrade has a putt for eagle. As I mentioned, Charlie Wi, the only eagle today at 15. Can Billy be number 2?

[00:18:04] >> Freddie Jacobson's looking for his first birdie of the day. He's 1-over.

[00:18:07] >> Back over at 15, the second for Ernie Els. Number 12, Ernie went with Driver off the deck, playing into the wind.

[00:18:18] >> Plenty of green there to play with. See what kind of lie he's got.

[00:18:23] >> Paul Stankowski for his birdie at 14. Remember, Freddie Jacobson hit it in there tight. And Paul Stankowski gets to 8-under.

[00:18:35] >> Ernie Els from the bunker just short of the green at 15. An Ernie specialty.

[00:18:43] >> Yeah, that's such a fine shot, you know.

[00:18:45] >> Back over at 14. And Freddie Jacobson for birdie.

[00:18:58] >> After a wonderful bunker shot, Ernie Els has this putt for birdie to get to within one of the lead.

[00:19:23] >> Let's go over to 18 from the greenside bunker at the par 5, Heath Slocum. And he's going to have that for birdie. Now, Jacobson, who was over the green in two, has this putt for birdie to get to 7-under. Heath Slocum for birdie. And what a round it's been for Heath as he shoots a 5-under 67. Buddy's right in contention.

[00:20:04] >> Straight down win, 246 front, 253 hole. Pinned on that front left corner. Going a little left. Needs a straight kick.

[00:20:29] >> Get up, he says. Oh, that's the high draw. What a great shot for Paul Stankowski, a chance for eagle.

[00:20:42] >> Well, ball below his feet, but it is on the upslope. Just trying to flip it out and maybe spin it a little bit. Caught it maybe just a little thin, maybe a half of a groove lobe. Not too bad.

Paul Stankowski with that two putt birdie at 18, shoots 71. That gets him into the last group. See Darren Clarke, Freddie Jacobson in that group at 7-under par.

[00:22:36] >> You never know, but I probably -- I think it probably is.

[00:22:47] >> It's live final round coverage of the Chubb Classic. Chubb in its 27th year as title sponsor. Thirty-eight years the PGA Tour Champions has been coming to gorgeous Naples, Florida. Tiburon Golf Club, the 10th venue used now in its fifth year. The Black Course playing host to the third of 28 on the PGA Tour Champions schedule, an event that Bernhard Langer has won a record five times. Stephen Ames, the defending champion. Couples a two time winner here. Jimenez, Stricker, notable champions over the years.

[00:23:27] >> Yeah, this is a real early kind of mid round gut check here at number 9. He's going to go to the back nine with the lead, which is going to be good for Justin Leonard. You know, it's a pretty good leaderboard behind him.

[00:23:39] >> Darren Clarke is right in the mix. He's 3-under on his round today, two off the lead. This is his third at 12, and just a hair aggressive there. Darren had a costly double bogey at 17 in Round 1. Had another double yesterday.

[00:24:13] >> Really high in the air and well to the right. There's a penalty area over there.

[00:24:23] >> Let's see if Darren Clarke can make birdie here at the 12th to get to within one of the lead. And he does.

[00:24:33] >> John, what about this lie here for Justin Leonard? Everything good?

[00:24:39] >> It's OK. It's not great. It's sitting down a little bit. He's such a wonderful picture of the golf ball. It's all about the catch and the contact. I think he's going to have to play it onto the putting surface and let it run out. That was a danger with that lie.

[00:24:58] >> Yeah, you could tell he was uncomfortable. And, you know, he's a Bermuda grass specialist, so when he gets fooled like that, it was just one of those lies. It's one of those tweener lies. You don't know what to do.

[00:25:18] >> Justin Leonard first to play. Now, he's got a wiggle out of some more danger here to stay at 11-under.

[00:25:45] >> 0h, what a smooth swing. Great result.

[00:26:17] >> We know Leonard's given back at least one here. And the door is open for a lot of other players all of a sudden. So Leonard with a bogey at the par-3 10th. Heath Slocum, a four-time winner on the PGA Tour, earned exempt status from the PGA Tour Champions last year. And he can't make that one.

[00:26:46] >> You know, he hit it right where he's looking. I don't know if he misread that putt or not. But that was right where he was aimed.

[00:26:53] >> Darren Clarke over 13, playing his second. And Zinger, I mean, he is right in the mix.

[00:27:00] >> Incredible. He's had all kinds of things happen to him right over the flagstick.

[00:27:05] >> Speaking of Fred Couples, he has this for par at 17.

[00:27:22] >> He's still got some serious game, Old Freddy Couples. He's had a lot of up and downs this tournament.

[00:27:31] >> Now, Justin Leonard to play his third. John, what --

[00:27:34] >> Kind of tugged it right through the wind.

[00:27:36] >> What does Justin have left for his third here?

[00:27:39] >> Yeah, he's 131 yards. Wind is in slightly out of the left. A little loose swing back there off the tee there for Justin. First really loose swing of the day. It's always fascinating on how these players handle a little bit of stress and adversity.

[00:28:00] >> That's a good looking shot right on line.

[00:28:02] >> Let's go over to 13. And Darren Clarke has this putt for birdie to get to 11-under and 5-under on his round today.

[00:28:13] >> Absolutely dead center. What a resilient player Darren Clarke is.

[00:28:18] >> Let's go over to 12. How about the run here for Billy Andrade? He has this for birdie at 12. And this would get Billy to within a shot of the lead.

[00:28:28] >> If you want to sometimes look at a par that could spark your round, this would be it for Justin Leonard after that bogey at the last.

[00:28:48] >> Wow, what a save. And a little fist pump from Justin from somebody's backyard.

[00:29:00] >> This is a shot you got to deal with the water if he hits a poor one. And that's a good shot. Another great shot for Billy Andrade.

[00:30:30] >> Look who caught a break. That ball didn't go all the way down in the water and gives it the big step through swing. See if he likes it.

[00:30:45] >> Sure did. Holy mackerel. Justin now with a chance to make another birdie.

[00:30:51] >> That's one heck of a shot he hit over there in that sand bunker or whatever that was. Looked like a waste bunker almost.

[00:30:57] >> Yeah, that was pretty special.

[00:31:10] >> Bingo.

[00:31:11][Applause] He's made some nice putts as Paul Stankowski. This is a big one. Stay within touch.

[00:31:24] >> There you go.

[00:31:27] >> Stankowski with a birdie. Heath Slocum, who played at Milton Florida High School with Boo Weekley, same high school that Bubba Watson later attended. And I would say that's a little bit of a misread.

[00:31:47] >> Billy Andrade, who was a three-time All America at Wake Forest and Wake Forest Hall of Fame, won the 1986 NCAA Team Championship, 2022 Payne Stewart Award winner, with another good one.

[00:32:02] >> Can Slocum save par? Gets out of there with par.

[00:32:10] >> Back over 13. Justin Leonard to play his second.

[00:32:20] >> He's the best wedge player on the leaderboard.

[00:32:23] >> Andrade for four in a row on the outright lead.

[00:32:28] >> That's crazy. Billy Andrade out of nowhere today.

[00:32:34] >> Justin Leonard now for his birdie to join Andrade to 12-under.

[00:32:50] >> Holing speed.

[00:32:52] >> That is a really good birdie.

[00:32:55] >> Justin Leonard back to back birdies. He's at 12-under.

[00:33:00] >> Over at 17, Richard Green for birdie.

[00:33:10] >> How about that for Richard Green? A rare birdie at 17.

[00:33:17] >> Now, Justin Leonard's second and 14.

[00:33:21] >> Hundred and twenty-six yards. Cute little pin here. Anything past the flag, it can get over the green in a hurry. This is well out to the right.

[00:33:34] >> Billy Andrade ready to play at 16.

[00:33:59] >> See, and that's just a little tuggy. You're kind of on it. You've seen it before.

[00:34:10] >> Justin Leonard has a putt for birdie. This would be his third in a row, and give him the outright lead.

[00:34:21] >> Or walk it in.

[00:34:22] >> Yeah, that's a huge putt there. He's made some good putts on this back nine.

[00:34:32] >> His par putt headed over the back of the green. Could sense the frustration with Ernie today. Just nothing happening. He's kind of a little out of sorts, moving some people around.

[00:35:24] >> He went from starting this final round with a one shot lead to trailing. Now, back up by two, his second for Justin Leonard at 15.

[00:35:32] >> That's a perfect leave though, John. I think he's in great shape. Now, Justin Leonard really in control.

[00:35:44] >> Big par putt for Billy Andrade at 16.

[00:38:33] >> He did. Man, we haven't seen anything like that out of Stankow. And it's just got away from him on the right.

[00:47:26] >> Yeah. John, you went a long period of time, you know, a win on the regular tour, then came out here and bunch of wins on this tour. What do you think emotionally he's feeling?

[00:48:33] >> Clear that bunker. And that's a beauty. Stankow can make a move here. If he makes that putt, that'll get him to, let's see, that'll get him to 10-under and a tie for third. That's a huge putt for him.

[00:48:51] >> I am. He's grinding on this.

[00:48:53] >> Yeah, he is. He wants to make a birdie so bad it.

[00:50:07] >> That would have moved him to 10-under and in a tie for third with Darren Clarke. Two hundred seventy for Paul Stankowski in his 80th start. And we say in Naples, all is perfect in paradise. Today has been perfect for this man, Justin Leonard, as he is going

to win the Chubb Classic and pick up win number one on the PGA Tour Champions. A birdie at 17. And then, caps it off with a birdie at 18. He started the day with a one shot lead. He finishes the day with a four shot victory, shooting a 4-under par 68. And after the bogey at 10, Justin Leonard plays the final eight holes in 5-under par. Justin Leonard is the Chubb Classic champion.
