[00:01:28.760]>>To Phoenix for the Charles Schwab Cup Championship. I mean, how about the green complexes? Put them in my veins, so, so good here at the James River course and some highlights from earlier today, Shane Bacon alongside Paul Azinger and Zing, Justin Leonard, starting to get the putter heated up as we see so often. Yeah, look at Doug Barron running after that like he's seen a few too many go in.

[00:01:52.430]>>I got him to 3 under par. He was not done. Ernie Els here at the par 5 6. Ernie Els flew all the way from South Africa to play at Haalalai in Hawaii and won the golf tournament, jet lag, unbelievable, and I thought it'd be a monster year, but just one win for him, just one win for Goosen this year also, but it was a big win about 3 or 4 weeks ago, Shane, using the prayer grip now pretty regularly.

[00:02:20.380]>>Goosen getting that victory, as you mentioned Zing just a month ago that at the Sanford International, and you mentioned Ernie Els with that victory out of the gate, the lone victory for Ernie this season. He's a couple off the lead. You see Justin Leonard at 4 under par now and as we talked about the putter, as it typically does, gets very, very hot when Leonard can go low and 4 under the mark through 10 holes.

[00:03:22.770]>>So far, at least 3 over par. Yeah, I made a bogey at the 3rd, double at the par 3 4, no birdie on the card to this point for Alker. Back to the 6th, Dicky Pride.

[00:03:36.080]>>He's 3 under par. This is his 2nd 9 today. Well, he's kind of sitting on the, the bubble. He's sitting at 38th rank for the year. What a good shot.

[00:04:30.119]>>Justin Leonard there atop this leaderboard 4 under the mark golf course, excellent condition, greens, just about perfect as you'd expect as we kick off the playoffs here from Richmond, Virginia.

well, now, see, that's just such a delicate little shot, you know, he, a lot of guys would have tried to pitch that higher in the air. You saw he hit that nice little perfect little no trick shot technique, knew it would just carry on. Beautiful, stealing one at 10, go back to 9.

[00:06:29.750]>>Yeah, that's why you gas the wedge if you know you can make a comeback or Ernie to 4 under, quickly.

[00:06:51.059]>>Yeah, early bogey in the round, then he buried the par 5 6th.

[00:06:55.179]>>Had a good look at 7 now, just to get into the red numbers.

[00:07:05.329]>>Good 4 there as well. A couple of wins this season for Thomas Bjørn, once in the team format alongside Darren Clark, then picked up his first individual title.

[00:07:22.089]>>And another easy birdie for him.

[00:07:26.570]>>I say another. It's his first one of the day, but just in general.

[00:07:39.519]>>It's gotta go. It's gotta go. Yeah, yeah, of course, you know, he, he's a guy when you say, hey, how you stroking it? He says, I don't stroke putts. I hit them.

[00:07:58.470]>>Greg Chalmers at 18 to tie that group at 4 under par. 1st 68 we've seen today. Nice round for Chalmers, came to the week 26 on the points list.

[00:08:23.989]>>Couple of good shots for Stewart Cink. Yeah, he's on a bit of a run.

He, he putts kind of with the heel up and the ball out on the toeside of center, and I think he's figured out Thomas Bjørn has had to eliminate a pull. We got a couple now at 5 under Leonard.

[00:11:05.429]>>Turned out to be one heck of a player. My goodness, can he get it done.

[00:11:11.530]>>That one wouldn't go if Y.E. Yang can pour one in at 17. That's what we saw from Caron. Early walking in. Y.E. Yang.

[00:15:04.010]>>He's made a whole lot of putts on 18th greens this year that mattered and another one curls in right side. So not his best today.

[00:15:19.760]>>I was expecting a little dance there some form, but not even. You got to shoot 300 a dance.

[00:15:26.070]>>Chichi would have given a little something something.

[00:15:29.119]>>Oh, that was Chichi, you know, you know, that was an error too when Chichi played. Oh my goodness.

[00:15:35.960]>>As charismatic as they come. Yeah, we all got a dose of that, you know, our generation that showed up in the 80s all got to see that, that, that older generation. Sam Snead would still play once in a while.

[00:15:54.859]>>There it is, dead center. Finishing off in style, good two-putt birdie to close.
