THIS INFORMATION SUPPLEMENTS THE 2025 PGA TOUR LOCAL RULES & TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Defined by white stakes, white lines and dots, and when tied into by white stakes, white dots, or white lines the following boundary objects: chain link fence, course-side edge of cinder block walls, rock/stone walls, barb-wire fence, course-side edge of vehicular roadway curb, the non-course-side edge of the entry road behind hole #2 tee, the non-course-side edge of the road adjacent to the TV Compound, and the course-side edge of the curbing behind the practice tee.

NOTE: The roads between holes #1 and #2/#6, between holes #2/#6 and #3, and between hole #4 tee and #4 fairway do not define the out of bounds.

NOTE 2: All temporary green meshed fencing is a Temporary Immovable Obstruction.

DROPPING ZONE FOR YELLOW PENALTY AREA:

Refer to 2025 PGA TOUR Local Rules - Item 2a.

Dropping zones for relief from a yellow penalty area during the play of the hole are located as follows:

Hole #3: On a forward tee

DROPPING ZONE FOR RED PENALTY AREA:

Refer to 2025 PGA TOUR Local Rules - Item 2a.

Dropping zones for relief from a red penalty area during the play of the hole are located as follows:

Hole #16: On a forward tee

TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

Refer to 2025 PGA TOUR Local Rules - Item 10a.

Either side relief is available as an extra option for a player taking Line of Sight Interference from the Temporary Immovable Obstructions located as follows:

Hole #11: TV Tower behind green

SPRINKLER HEADS – RELIEF FOR BALL IN PENALTY AREA:

Relief under Model Local Rule F-24 is available for interference from sprinkler heads within one club-length of the edge of the penalty area, but only when the ball touches or lies on the obstruction or the obstruction interferes with the area of intended swing (no relief for stance).

BIRDHOUSES:

All birdhouses are immovable obstructions.

SEPARATE OBSTRUCTIONS:

Protective wooden fencing adjacent to cart paths are considered separate obstructions.
