NOTICE TO PLAYERS

This information supplements the 2026 PGA TOUR Local Rules and Terms of the Competition:

Out of Bounds:

Defined by white stakes and, when tied into by white stakes, white lines or white dots, the following boundary objects:

- course-side edge of paved public roads;
- perimeter concrete wall;
- the water's edge of the non course-side of the ponds on holes #4 / #11 and #13;
- property fencing left of #12 fairway, right of #13 fairway, left of #15 fairway, right of #16 fairway, left of #17 tee;
- driveway curbing right of #16 fairway;
- and a portion of the non course-side edge of the cart path to the right of hole #14 and to the left of hole #16 and hole #17.

Note: The white stakes with black tops on holes #16 and #17 are for visual reference only and do not define the boundary. These stakes are movable obstructions.

Penalty Areas:

A portion of the red penalty area on hole #9 is defined by the course-side edge of the retaining wall where tied into by red lines and identified by red dots. Additionally, a portion of the red penalty area behind #18 green is defined by the non course-side edge of the hospitality decking where tied into by red lines.

Putting Greens Damage:

- Areas of damage on the putting greens including hole plugs, hex plugs, and burnt turf conditions may be repaired without unreasonable delay, or relief is available from seams of cut turf under MLR F-7.
- Additionally, if a ball lies on a spot of burnt turf on the putting green which is not repairable, relief may be available for the lie of the ball only. Consult a referee.

Temporary Immovable Obstructions:

Refer to 2026 PGA TOUR Local Rules - Item 10a.

Either side relief is available as an extra option for line of sight interference with the Temporary Immovable Obstructions located as follows:

- Hole #8: Television tower
- Hole #10: Television tower
- Hole #15: Television tower
- Hole #16: Television tower

Sandy Waste Areas:

Sandy waste and compacted crushed rock areas and/or paths are part of the general area and are not obstructions. These areas are not bunkers. Surface imperfections in these areas (whether those be footprints or tire tracks) are to be expected. Such areas are not considered to be abnormal in nature and are a challenge of playing the course. In circumstances when such conditions are extreme the Committee may grant relief under Rule 16.1

Automotive Transportation:

Is permitted between #9 green and #10 tee.
