Extended forecast – Wednesday, partly cloudy to mostly sunny and largely dry weather. A brief trade shower cannot be ruled out but accumulations will be light. Thursday, a slight increase in moisture will lead to a slight increase in passing shower chances. No thunderstorms are expected. Friday through Sunday, expect largely dry weather with partly cloudy to at times mostly sunny skies, with a slight chance of a brief passing shower each day, highest chances in the morning. Winds will be consistent through the period, generally east to slightly east-northeast, with gusts in the 20-25 mph range each day, strongest right along the ocean. Temperatures will top out near 88F (31C) each afternoon, warmest across interior parts of the course.

2026 Corales Puntacana Championship Message Document

Tournament Focus

- **Dominican Destination:** The ninth edition of the Corales Puntacana Championship is set to take place this week as the event will once again crown its winner as the “King of Corales.” Showcasing the region through the tournament has continued to elevate the Punta Cana as one of the world’s leading tourism destinations.
- **New July date:** The tournament’s move from April to July creates a stronger late-season competitive narrative, with players competing for FedExCup points, position and status as the season enters an important stretch.

Competition Storylines

- **Late-season positioning:** The move to July places the Corales Puntacana Championship at an important point in the PGA TOUR season, where a strong week could be pivotal for players seeking to improve their FedExCup standing.
- **Winner’s rewards:** The winner of the Corales Puntacana Championship receives a two-year exemption on the PGA TOUR (one year if a non-member), 300 FedExCup points and an exemption into THE PLAYERS Championship in 2027.
- **DP World Tour:** As part of the Strategic Alliance between the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour, the Corales Puntacana Championship features a field of 144 players, including 50 players from the DP World Tour, with the winner receiving benefits on each Tour.
 - o **Note:** The Corales Puntacana Championship is **not** co-sanctioned with the DP World Tour, rather a PGA TOUR event that offers access to DP World Tour players.
- **SENSITIVE TOPIC - Corales Course conditions:** 10 of the 18 greens at the Corales Course inadvertently sustained varying levels of damage from a herbicide application that was intended to remove nuisance weeds from the putting surfaces. Significant repair efforts are in progress with the agronomy team working around the clock. Outside of the impacted putting surfaces, the golf course is in excellent condition.

Player Priorities

- **Garrick Higgo** – Defending champion. Secured his 2nd PGA TOUR win and became the youngest winner of the Corales Puntacana Championship. Currently ranked 157th in FedExCup Standings and could use good week in his pursuit of qualifying for the FedExCup Playoffs.
- **Jorge Peña** – Local inspirational storyline and meaningful content opportunity tied to his cancer-survivor journey.
- **Dominican/Caribbean-connected players** – Prioritize any local or regionally connected players in the field for community and tournament-growth angles.
- **DP World Tour players** – Consider international-player storylines connected to the event's DP World Tour relationship and one-year PGA TOUR exemption opportunity.
- **Late-season movers** – Highlight players competing for FedExCup position, TOUR status and momentum entering the final stretch of the season.

Broadcast Messaging - Corales Golf Course Conditions

- During final tournament preparations, a herbicide application intended to address nuisance weeds ended up impacting 10 of the greens on the Corales Course with varying degrees of damage. Greens impacted: Nos. 2, 3, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15
- The staff here at Corales have been working around the clock to get the golf course ready for tournament play, and by all accounts they've made significant progress over the last two weeks. Their hard work is evident throughout the property.
- It's important to note that nearly half of the greens were unaffected, and outside of the impacted putting surfaces, the golf course is in excellent condition.
- The Dominican Republic has also been dealing with drought conditions, which has put added pressure on the course's reclaimed water supply, making the progress and recovery efforts even more impressive.
- No one wanted to see this happen, but the agronomy team deserves a tremendous amount of credit for the progress they've made in a relatively short period of time.
- There's certainly nothing to critique about this setting. The Corales Course and Punta Cana never disappoint with the idyllic views they provide.

Garrick Higgo

- Defending champion seeks to become the first player with multiple wins in the event since its inaugural playing in 2018
- 27-year-old South African won the 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship with rounds of 64-68-70-72 (274/-14), earning a one-stroke margin of victory over five players tied at 13-under
- Became the youngest winner of the Corales Puntacana Championship with his 2025 title (25 years, 11 months, 8 days)
- One of three international winners of the event: Matt Wallace (2023/England), Graeme McDowell (2019/Northern Ireland)
- Making his third consecutive start at the Corales Puntacana Championship (MC/2024, Won/2025)
- In 17 starts this season, owns seven made cuts and one top-25 finish (T19/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- Enters the week No. 157 in the 2026 FedExCup standings
- PGA TOUR wins (2): 2021 Palmetto Championship at Congaree, 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship

Joel Dahmen

- Making his eighth tournament appearance at the Corales Puntacana Championship, where he owns two top-10 finishes including his lone PGA TOUR title in 2021 and a runner-up finish in 2025
- Opened the 2025 Corales Puntacana Championship with a first-round 62, breaking the tournament's 18-hole scoring record; went on to set the 36-hole scoring record of 128 and tied the 54-hole record of 199 (Adam Long/2020, Wesley Bryan/2024)
- Solo leader after each of the first three rounds in 2025 before a final-round 4-over 76 to finish T2, one back of Higgo
- In his 255th career start, seeks to become the first player with multiple wins in the Corales Puntacana Championship
- One of four players who earned their first PGA TOUR victory at the event (others: 2018/Brice Garnett, 2022 Chad Ramey, 2023/Matt Wallace)
- Owns two top-10 finishes in 16 starts this season (T7/Farmers Insurance Open, T9/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)

Taylor Pendrith

- Coming off a runner-up finish at last week's ISCO Championship after losing to Steven Fisk on the third playoff hole; marked his second runner-up finish on TOUR (2022 Rocket Classic)
- Set to make fourth Corales Puntacana Championship start (T34/2021, T70/2023, T11/2024)
- Has two top-10s on TOUR this season in 20 starts (T6/Sony Open in Hawaii, P2/ISCO Championship)
- Canadian seeks his second PGA TOUR title in his 131st career start (2024 CJ CUP Bryon Nelson)
- Enters the week at No. 79 in the 2026 FedExCup standings

Brice Garnett

- 2018 Corales Puntacana Championship winner making his seventh tournament appearance
- Owns three top-10 finishes in six prior starts in the event (Won/2018, T9/2021, T8/2023)

Chad Ramey

Corales Puntacana Championship notes

- The 2026 Corales Puntacana Championship marks the ninth playing of the PGA TOUR's first and only tournament in the Dominican Republic
- The Corales Puntacana Championship has been co-sanctioned by the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour since 2022 as part of the Strategic Alliance between both Tours
- The winner will receive 300 FedExCup points and a two-year exemption on the PGA TOUR, if not already exempt
- The Corales Puntacana Championship is the 31st event of the FedExCup Regular Season, with only four weeks remaining until the start of the FedExCup Playoffs. Among the notable players in the field on the top 70 bubble include **Stephan Jaeger** (No. 73), **Taylor Pendrith** (No. 76) and **Brandt Snedeker** (No. 78)
- The 144-player field includes:
 - o Four past champions: **Brice Garnett** (2018), **Joel Dahmen** (2021), **Chad Ramey** (2022), **Garrick Higgo** (2025)
 - o Eight of the top 100 players in the 2026 FedExCup standings, highlighted by **Stephan Jaeger** (No. 73)
 - o Seven players finished inside the top 10 at the ISCO Championship last week: **Taylor Pendrith** (P2), **Ben Silverman** (T3), **Aaron Wise** (T3), **Davis Chatfield** (T5), **Kristoffer Ventura** (T5), **Manuel Elvira** (T8), **Thomas Rosenmueller** (T10)

 - o **Willy Pumarol** (T53/2025) owns the best finish by a player from the Dominican Republic
- No playoffs in the eight-year history of the Corales Puntacana Championship

PGA TOUR season notes

- There have been nine international winners on TOUR this season (11 wins); the Corales Puntacana Championship has had three international winners including the defending champion **Garrick Higgo** (South Africa)
- There have been five first-time winners in the first 29 events on TOUR this season: Jacob Bridgeman (The Genesis Invitational), Ricky Castillo (Puerto Rico Open), Alex Fitzpatrick (Zurich Classic of New Orleans), Kristoffer Reitan (Truist Championship), Bud Cauley (RBC Canadian Open); the Corales Puntacana Championship has not had a first-time winner the past two years
- The 54-hole leader/co-leader has gone on to win 10 of 28 individual stroke-play events on TOUR this season; the last time the 54-hole leader/co-leader at the Corales Puntacana Championship has gone on to win was **Joel Dahmen** in 2021

- » **No FedExCup points** (any non-member FedExCup points earned in previous events this season would be converted to the FedExCup points list)
- » **No Official Money** (receives winner's share in unofficial money)

If a non-member finishes in the top 10 at the Corales Puntacana Championship, he would not earn a spot in the 3M Open.
