## Message Document: 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship

### Organizational Momentum

- **New player app debuts:** The PGA TOUR this week officially launches its new player app and website – PGA TOUR CENTRAL – which provides members a one-stop-shop to a full analysis of their performance across the league’s four Tours, in addition to more data, features and organizational messaging. The new system – which the TOUR developed in-house – replaces PGA TOUR LINKS, originally built in the late 1990s.
  - Unlike LINKS, PGA TOUR CENTRAL is built to accommodate several stakeholders beyond the membership, as the app and website will now be open to player support teams including families, agents, coaches, caddies, equipment manufacturers and other various roles. This will consolidate several workflows into one singular process, saving valuable time for players to focus on their game.
  - Among the platform’s new features are shot videos loaded just minutes after being hit, complete with ShotLink powered by CDW stroke trails and Trackman radar metrics such as ball speed, clubhead speed and apex. After a player completes their round, a full recap video is automatically created using the same AI technology, with players able to access detailed statistical insights and compare their current performance against previous years.
  - The TOUR conducted a beta program during the 2025 season across all Tours, updating the app every few weeks based on feedback from a variety of users. From 18-year-old PGA TOUR Americas rookies to PGA TOUR Champions veterans, the new system is easy and friendly for all users regardless of their tech familiarity.
- **PGA TOUR Champions returns to North Florida:** PGA TOUR Champions is back this week with the fifth playing of the Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS in Jacksonville, Florida. The event, hosted by Jim and Tabitha Furyk, is one of five player-hosted tournaments on the Champions Tour schedule, alongside the Cologuard Classic (Jerry Kelly), Mitsubishi Electric Classic (Stewart Cink), American Family Insurance Championship (Steve Stricker) and Portugal Invitational (Ernie Els).
  - The 2025 event marks the final Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS at Timuquana Country Club, a successful five-year run that has generated nearly \$5 million for charities across Northeast Florida to date. Beginning in 2026 the event will move to the Ocean Course at Hammock Golf Resort and Spa in Palm Coast.
- **PGA TOUR Americas concludes:** The 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Season concluded last week at the Fortinet Cup Championship, contested at Morgan Creek Golf Course outside Vancouver, British Columbia. The [top 10 players](#) in the final Fortinet Cup Standings earned Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2026 season.
  - Jay Card III claimed his second victory of the season at the event, moving up to No. 2 in the final Fortinet Cup Standings.
  - Michael Brennan, a PGA TOUR University Class of 2025 graduate, finished tied for fourth, cementing his status as the No. 1 player in the season-long race for the Fortinet Cup and moving him to No. 107 in the Official World Golf Ranking.

## **Tournament Focus**

- PGA TOUR competition resumes at the Sanderson Farms Championship, the second of seven events in the FedExCup Fall. The Country Club of Jackson has served as the tournament's permanent home since 2014 and the backdrop for showcasing Mississippi's unique generosity, hospitality and charitable spirit on a national stage.
- While the 2026 FedExCup Fall schedule has not been finalized, Wayne-Sanderson Farms announced that it would not return as title sponsor of the Sanderson Farms Championship following the 2025 event. The following statement will be made available to media upon inquiry: *The PGA TOUR's focus is on delivering another memorable championship at the Country Club of Jackson and positively impacting the people of Mississippi and Century Club Charities, which has directed more than 26 million dollars in charitable contributions all-time to nearly 70 charities statewide. The TOUR will unveil more details about the 2026 FedExCup Fall schedule by the end of the year.*
- The Sanderson Farms Championship has raised more than \$26 million for Children's of Mississippi – the only children's hospital in the state of Mississippi – and 70 other Mississippi charities.
- With "University Day" slated for Saturday, the Sanderson Farms Championship continues its embrace of college football season. In line with that theme, ESPN personalities Marty Smith and Greg McElroy will be on site Wednesday to participate in the Pro-Am.

## **Competitions Storylines**

- The FedExCup Fall offers players the opportunity to secure or improve their status for the following season. The 2026 season will feature several eligibility changes, most notably that the top 100 in the standings through the FedExCup Fall (The RSM Classic) will secure exempt status for the following season, with Nos. 101-150 having conditional status. With fewer cards available, the drama will be heightened thanks to stronger fields and more competitive friction as players vie for playing status ahead of 2026.
- Three players who are not exempt beyond 2025 moved inside the top 100 following the Procore Championship: Lanto Griffin (No. 142 to No. 100), Isaiah Salinda (No. 104 to No. 97) and Rico Hoey (No. 106 to No. 91).
- Since 2014, seven players have earned their first PGA TOUR title at the Sanderson Farms Championship and The Country Club of Jackson (Nick Taylor/2014, Peter Malnati/2015, Cody Gribble/2016, Ryan Armour/2017, Cameron Champ/2018, Sebastian Munoz/2019, Kevin Yu/2024).
- The field includes three winners during the 2025 PGA TOUR Season: Min Woo Lee/Texas Children's Houston Open, Garrick Higgo/Corales Puntacana Championship, William Mouw/ISCO Championship.

### **Player Priorities**

- **Rasmus Højgaard:** One week after competing for the victorious Team Europe in the 2025 Ryder Cup, begins his FedExCup Fall at No. 87 in the standings and seeks to maintain exempt status for the 2026 season. Making his tournament debut.
- **Davis Riley:** Hattiesburg, Mississippi native is No. 63 in the FedExCup Fall standings following three top-10s during the regular season, including a T2 at the PGA Championship. Making his seventh career tournament appearance (best finish: T19/2022).
- **Michael La Sasso:** Reigning NCAA Individual Champion and Ole Miss senior Michael La Sasso will make his tournament debut as a sponsor exemption. It will mark his sixth start on the PGA TOUR this season, having made his first cut in his most recent start at the 3M Open (T44) where he carded a third-round 63.
- **Max Homa:** Six-time PGA TOUR winner will make his fourth career tournament appearance and first since 2018. Finished T19 in his most recent start on TOUR at the Procore Championship, one of three top-20 finishes during the 2025 season.
- **Min Woo Lee:** One of four winners during the 2025 season (Texas Children's Houston Open), making his first start on TOUR since the FedEx St. Jude Championship. Collected top-15 finishes in his two most recent starts on the DP World Tour: BMW PGA Championship (T11), FedEx Open de France (T5).

# PGA TOUR COMPETITIONS OVERVIEW OF CHANGES FOR 2026

**EXEMPT STATUS** Exempt status for 2026 changes from top 125 to top 100 on the prior season's FedExCup Points List.

Players finishing between Nos. 101-150 will have conditional status and be broken into three different categories on the Priority Ranking: 101-110, 111-125 and 126-150. These three categories will have varying levels of access to Full-Field Events.

**FIELD SIZES** Beginning in 2026, the maximum number of players in a Full-Field Event will be 144 players\*, down from 156. Due to circumstances such as limited daylight, some events will have field sizes of 120 or 132.

\*The American Express, played on three courses, and the Genesis Scottish Open, co-sanctioned with the DP World Tour, maintain a field size of 156.

THE PLAYERS Championship field size will be 120 beginning in 2026.

These reductions in field sizes will have a positive impact on Speed of Play through a better flow of play on the golf course.

**SPONSOR EXEMPTIONS** Sponsor exemptions restricted to players in the DP World Tour/Korn Ferry Tour/Q-School category as well as those restricted to PGA TOUR members have been removed and reallocated to the next eligible members on the Priority Ranking.

**NOTE:** There are no changes to unrestricted sponsor exemptions, which are typically a standard of four.

**OPEN QUALIFYING** Open Qualifying spots have been eliminated for Full-Field Events with fields of 120 and reduced to two for fields of 132. Fields of 144, which make up the majority of Full-Field Events, maintain four Open Qualifying spots. There are no changes to Open Qualifying for Opposite Events and the FedExCup Fall, which maintain four spots.

## FedExCup Fall Storylines

The 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship is the second event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season.

The top 50 players in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions while No. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points over.

**Aon Next 10** (players 51-60) through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational.

Winners of events during the FedExCup Fall receive a two-year PGA TOUR exemption, OWGR points and spots in The Sentry, THE PLAYERS Championship and PGA Championship in 2026

### What's at Stake in the FedExCup Fall:

- **Aon Next 10:** Players in the Aon Next 10 through the RSM Classic will be eligible for the two west coast Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational)
- **The Top 100:** Will be fully-exempt for the 2026 PGA TOUR season
- **101-150:** Earn conditional status on PGA TOUR next season

- 50%** In each of the last two season 10 of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs the following season
- 25%** In each of the last two seasons, five of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 finished inside the top 50 of the FedExCup Standings the following season and five of players qualified for the TOUR Championship the following season
