**Scottie Scheffler**

- World No. 1, reigning FedExCup champion and 15-time PGA TOUR winner in search of third victory of the season (THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, PGA Championship)
- 2024 champion became the fourth winner of the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday to go on to win the FedExCup in the same season, including the third in the last four years (Viktor Hovland/2023, Patrick Cantlay/2021, Tiger Woods/2009)
- Making his fifth career tournament appearance (Won/2024, 3<sup>rd</sup>/2023, 3<sup>rd</sup>/2021, T22/2020)
- With a win this week, would join Tiger Woods (1999-2001) as the only players to successfully defend their title at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday
- One of five different players (seven instances) who have won the Memorial Tournament and THE PLAYERS Championship or a major championship in the same season: Raymond Floyd (1982), Curtis Strange (1988), Paul Azinger (1993), Tiger Woods (1999, 2000, 2001), Scottie Scheffler (2024); with a win this week following his 2025 PGA Championship victory, would join Tiger Woods as the only players to achieve this feat in multiple years
- At the age of 28 years, 10 months, 27 days when claiming the 2025 PGA Championship, joined Jack Nicklaus and Tiger Woods as the only players in the modern era to win 15 times, including three major championships, before the age of 29
- Opened with 67 in two of his previous four tournament appearances (2024/Won, 2021/3<sup>rd</sup>)

**Xander Schauffele**

- World No. 3 makes eighth appearance at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday; has finished inside the top-25 in each of his last six appearances (best: T8/2024)
- Nine-time PGA TOUR winner seeks first victory this season; one top-10 in eight starts (T8/Masters Tournament)
- Enters this week on a TOUR-leading streak of 64 consecutive made cuts, with Scottie Scheffler second on the list with 55
- Has five sub-70 scores in 26 career rounds at Muirfield Village Golf Club, with each coming in the first two rounds

**Viktor Hovland**

- 2023 Memorial Tournament champion has made the cut in each of his five appearances at this event
- Seven-time TOUR winner makes his 125<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR start
- Won the Valspar Championship earlier this season, claiming his first title since the 2023 TOUR Championship

**Justin Rose**

- First of 11 TOUR wins came at the 2010 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday; also owns two runner-up results in 15 appearances at Muirfield Village (T2/2008, 2<sup>nd</sup>/2015)

- Two of his three top-10 finishes this season have come in Signature Events (T3/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, T8/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard); finished runner-up to Rory McIlroy at the 2025 Masters Tournament
- A top-10 finish this week would mark his eighth at the Memorial Tournament, one shy of the record nine shared by Tiger Woods and Jay Haas; Matt Kuchar is the only other player in the field with seven career top-10s at the Memorial Tournament

#### Justin Thomas

- World No. 5 currently sits No. 4 in the FedExCup standings after a playoff win at the RBC Heritage and three runner-up finishes this season (2<sup>nd</sup>/The American Express, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Valspar Championship, T2/Truist Championship)
- 16-time PGA TOUR winner and 2017 FedExCup Champion has two top-10s in 10 appearances at the Memorial Tournament (T4/2017, T8/2018)
- Lost a playoff to Collin Morikawa at the 2020 Workday Charity Open, a one-off event held during the COVID-19 pandemic at Muirfield Village the week before the Memorial Tournament
- Joins Scottie Scheffler as the only players with multiple rounds of 62 or better this season: Thomas (61/RBC Heritage, 62/PLAYERS Championship); Scheffler (61/CJ CUP Byron Nelson, 62/Texas Children's Houston Open)
- Only player in the field to have won the Jack Nicklaus Award presented annually to the best golfer in men's college golf (2012) and the Jack Nicklaus Award for PGA TOUR Player of the Year (2017)

#### Max Homa

- Six-time PGA TOUR winner seeks his first top-10 result this year; best: T12/Masters Tournament
- Made four cuts in five appearances at the Memorial Tournament where he owns two top-10s (T6/2021, T5/2022)
- Opened with an under-par score in the first round of all five starts at Muirfield Village
- Low 18-hole score in 18 career rounds at Muirfield Village: 69/four times
- Established the tournament record for fewest number of putts in a tournament (99/2022); matched by Matt Kuchar in 2023

#### Collin Morikawa

- World No. 4 owns two runner-up finishes in five appearances at the Memorial Tournament (2021, 2024), including a playoff loss to Patrick Cantlay in 2021
- Won the 2020 Workday Charity Open, a one-off event held during the COVID-19 pandemic at Muirfield Village the week before the Memorial Tournament, defeating Justin Thomas in a playoff
- Six-time PGA TOUR winner seeks seventh title and first since the 2023 Baycurrent Classic
- Two runner-up finishes in 10 starts this season (The Sentry, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard)
- Posted top-20 results in each of his first six starts this season but has just one top-20 finish in his four most recent starts (T17/Truist Championship)

#### the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday notes

- Seventh of eight Signature Events during the 2025 PGA TOUR Season. The field includes:
  - 29 of the top 30 in the FedExCup standings
  - Eight of the top 10 in the Official World Golf Ranking
  - Six past winners of the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday: **Scottie Scheffler**/2024, **Viktor Hovland**/2023, **Patrick Cantlay**/2021, 2019, **Hideki Matsuyama**/2014, **Matt Kuchar**/2013, **Justin Rose**/2010
  - Four Jack Nicklaus Award winners as PGA TOUR Player of the Year: **Scottie Scheffler** (2024, 2023, 2022), **Patrick Cantlay** (2021), **Justin Thomas** (2017), **Jordan Spieth** (2015)
  - Seven players who finished inside the top 10 in last week's Charles Schwab Challenge: **Ben Griffin**/Won, **Matti Schmid**/2<sup>nd</sup>, **Bud Cauley**/3<sup>rd</sup>, **Tommy Fleetwood**/T4, **Scottie Scheffler**/T4, **J.J. Spaun**/T6, **Robert MacIntyre**/T6
  - Four sponsor exemptions restricted to PGA TOUR members: **Rickie Fowler**, **Matt Kuchar**, **Brandt Snedeker**, **Jordan Spieth**
- As one of the three player-hosted invitationals, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday will feature a 36-hole cut to the low 50 players and ties and any player within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead
- Players earning spots in the field via the Aon Next 10 (top FedExCup points earners through the Charles Schwab Challenge): **Ben Griffin**, **Andrew Novak**, **Harris English**, **J.J. Spaun**, **Maverick McNealy**, **Daniel Berger**, **Justin Rose**, **Michael Kim**, **Jacob Bridgeman**, **Nick Taylor**
- Players earning spots in the field via the Aon Swing 5 (top FedExCup points earners from this season's ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic and Charles Schwab Challenge): **Matti Schmid**, **Ryan Fox**, **Bud Cauley**, **Harry Higgs**, **Mackenzie Hughes**
- **Ben Griffin** became the season's fourth multiple winner (Rory McIlroy, Scottie Scheffler, Sepp Straka) after taking the Charles Schwab Challenge for his second TOUR victory and first as an individual (Zurich Classic of New Orleans with Andrew Novak). It was the third consecutive week on TOUR where a player claimed his second title of the season (Sepp Straka/Truist Championship, Scottie Scheffler/PGA Championship).

- **Jordan Spieth** owns three top-10 finishes in 12 appearances at the Memorial Tournament (T3/2015, T7/2019, T5/2023); 65 marks his low round at Muirfield Village Golf Club (R4/2015)
- **Hideki Matsuyama's** 2014 Memorial Tournament victory was his first of 11 PGA TOUR titles; most recently claimed the 2025 season-opening event at The Sentry; Matsuyama is one of two players to have won this tournament in their debut (Roger Maltbie/1976)
- Despite never posting a better opening-round score of 73 in six appearances, Workday ambassador **Matt Fitzpatrick** has recorded three top-10s at this event, including the last two years (T5/2024, T9/2023, 3<sup>rd</sup>/2020)
- A third victory at the Memorial Tournament for **Patrick Cantlay** (2019, 2021) would see him join Kenny Perry (1991, 2003, 2008) with the second-most in tournament history, behind Tiger Woods (1999, 2000, 2001, 2009, 2012)
- **Lucas Glover** makes his 21<sup>st</sup> consecutive appearance at the Memorial Tournament, the longest active streak by any player in the field
- One qualifying spot is available for The Open Championship and will go to the leading player (not otherwise exempt) who makes the cut at the Memorial Tournament
- A playoff has decided the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday in six of the last 11 years (most recent: 2023/Viktor Hovland def. Denny McCarthy)
- Muirfield Village Golf Club has hosted the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday annually since the inaugural event in 1976; also hosted 1992 U.S. Amateur, 1987 Ryder Cup, 1998 Solheim Cup, 1986 U.S. Junior Amateur and 2013 Presidents Cup; only course in the United States to host the Ryder Cup, Solheim Cup and Presidents Cup

## 2025 the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday Message Document

1. **50<sup>th</sup> playing at Jack's Place:** The 2025 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday marks the 50<sup>th</sup> playing of the event, which was founded in 1976 by Jack Nicklaus two years after he unveiled Muirfield Village Golf Club to the public. Nicklaus made 30 consecutive appearances in the event from 1976-2005 and collected two titles (1977, 1984). The tournament – which ends with a momentous handshake from Nicklaus – has become an iconic stop on the PGA TOUR calendar that continues to challenge the world's best. The Memorial Tournament presented by Workday is the seventh of eight Signature Events during the 2025 PGA TOUR Season and the final of three player-hosted invitationals. As one of the three player-hosted invitationals (The Genesis Invitational, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard), the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday features a 36-hole cut (low 50 and ties and any additional players within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead) and a 20-percent prize allocation to the winner (\$4 million), up from 18 percent.
2. **Workday:** In its fourth year as presenting sponsor and committed through 2031, Workday has become ingrained in the fabric of Jack Nicklaus' annual TOUR stop. In addition to its longtime support of Nationwide Children's Hospital, the tournament benefits Eat. Learn. Play., the Oakland, California-based foundation established by four-time NBA champion and two-time MVP Stephen Curry and Ayesha Curry, an entrepreneur, host and New York Times bestselling author. The organization is designed to ensure an equal road to success for all kids, rooted in three of the most vital pillars of a healthy childhood – nutrition, education and physical activity. Workday ambassadors in the field include Matt Fitzpatrick, Matt Kuchar and Brandt Snedeker.
3. **Play Yellow:** Fans are encouraged to wear yellow on Sunday to celebrate Jack Nicklaus' longtime connection with the color "yellow." His love for yellow began with Craig Smith, the son of wife Barbara's minister and a passionate young fan in Nicklaus' hometown of Columbus, Ohio, who passed away at age 13 in 1971 from a rare bone cancer (Ewing Sarcoma). Nicklaus would call him frequently, and during one conversation following a win, Craig said he predicted victory because he was wearing his lucky yellow shirt. No longer wearing "yellow" in PGA TOUR competition, Nicklaus launched Play Yellow, a Children's Miracle Network Hospitals campaign with the goal to raise funds to help the 10 million kids treated at local children's hospitals each year.
4. **Field:** World No. 1 and reigning Memorial Tournament champion Scottie Scheffler will return to defend his title after becoming the third player in the last four years to win the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday and go on to win the FedExCup that same season (2023/Viktor Hovland, 2021/Patrick Cantlay). Scheffler finished T4 at last week's Charles Schwab Challenge in his first start since claiming his third major championship title at the PGA Championship. Other field notes:
  - **Ben Griffin** became the season's fourth multiple winner after taking the Charles Schwab Challenge for his second victory and first as an individual (Zurich Classic of New Orleans with Andrew Novak). It was the third consecutive week on TOUR where a player claimed his second title of the season (Sepp Straka/Truist Championship, Scottie Scheffler/PGA Championship).
  - **Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5:** With their finishes at the Charles Schwab Challenge, Matti Schmid (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Bud Cauley (3<sup>rd</sup>) qualified for the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday through the Aon Swing 5. It will mark Schmid's first Signature Event of the season and Cauley's second (RBC Heritage).
  - **Sponsor Exemptions:** The four sponsor exemptions restricted to PGA TOUR members were given to Rickie Fowler, Matt Kuchar, Brandt Snedeker and Jordan Spieth.
5. **Barbara Nicklaus:** Often referred to as the "First Lady of Golf," Barbara Nicklaus was named the 2025 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday Honoree and will be celebrated on Wednesday at Muirfield Village Golf Club. Nicklaus has been an influential figure in the game of golf, first and foremost as a guiding force behind her husband Jack Nicklaus throughout his Hall of Fame career. With her involvement in the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday since its inception, Nicklaus has been integral to the more than \$52 million raised for central Ohio charities and beyond. The honorees are selected by the Captains Club, a group of statesmen who act independently of the tournament organization, but who also advise on player invitations and operation of the event.
6. **Open Qualifying Series:** The Memorial Tournament presented by Workday is the next PGA TOUR event that is part of The Open Qualifying Series (OQS) where one spot will be available into the 153<sup>rd</sup> Open at Royal Portrush. The top player, not otherwise exempt, who makes the cut at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday will earn an exemption. In the event of a tie for a qualifying place, the player with the higher ranking in the OWGR at the beginning of the week will earn the spot.

## Memorial Tournament Historical Notes

On May 27, 1974, Jack Nicklaus unveiled Muirfield Village Golf Club to the public and media by playing an 18-hole exhibition with fellow Ohioan and Ohio State product Tom Weiskopf. About his new creation, Nicklaus said he turned his attention toward “creating maximum visibility for spectators.” Almost every hole, Nicklaus said, would be able to accommodate large galleries. Exactly two years later, on May 27, 1976, the Memorial’s first round began.

Roger Maltbie and Hale Irwin finished regulation at the inaugural Memorial Tournament, in 1976, at even-par 288. Only one other time has even-par or worse resulted in a win. In 1990, a rain-shortened, 54-hole tournament, Greg Norman finished at even-par to defeat Payne Stewart by one shot.

Between 1976 and 1980, only professionals played in the Memorial Tournament. In 1981, the Captains Club began inviting amateurs to play in the event, with tournament host Jack Nicklaus remembering his 19 career PGA TOUR starts before he turned pro as the impetus. The first amateurs to tee it up at the Memorial were Jim Holtgrieve, Jay Sigel and Bob Tway. Holtgrieve was the only one of the trio to make the cut that year. He tied for 35th. Periodically, amateurs have continued to play in the Memorial.

# SIGNATURE EVENT FACT SHEET (ENTERING THE MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT PRESENTED BY WORKDAY)

## OVERVIEW

Signature Events are limited-field events comprised of the top PGA TOUR players from the previous season's FedExCup as well as trending players from the current season who play their way in via the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5. These eligibility pathways deliver compelling storylines and added consequence at Full-Field Events while impacting the season-long race for the FedExCup.

## AON NEXT 10 and AON SWING 5

The Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 are eligibility pathways for players, not already qualified, to play their way into Signature Events via the FedExCup standings.

- **Aon Next 10:** Top 10 available players, not otherwise exempt, from FedExCup standings. The Aon Next 10 will always fill to 10 players.
- **Aon Swing 5:** Top five available players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points from events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Swing 5 will always fill to five players.

## STORYLINES

The Memorial Tournament presented by Workday is the seventh of eight Signature Events in the 2025 PGA TOUR season. The Aon Next 10 is made up of the top 10 players in the FedExCup standings through the Charles Schwab Challenge that did not finish in the top 50 of the 2024 FedExCup standings, while the Aon Swing 5 is made up of the five players (not already exempt) earning the most combined FedExCup points in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic and Charles Schwab Challenge.

### LAST WEEK ON TOUR: Charles Schwab Challenge

**Ben Griffin** earned his second career PGA TOUR win and first individual victory (2025 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Andrew Novak), joining Scottie Scheffler, Rory McIlroy and Sepp Straka as the only players with multiple wins this season. **Matti Schmid** finished runner-up and earned a start in the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday via the Aon Swing 5.

### PLAYERS TO WATCH: Memorial Tournament presented by Workday

Three players in the field are competing in their first Signature Event of the season through the Aon Swing 5 standings: **Matti Schmid** (No. 1), **Ryan Fox** (No. 2) and **Harry Higgs** (No. 4).

Sponsor exemption **Brandt Snedeker** is making his first start in a Signature Event in 2025. In nine career starts in the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, Snedeker's best finish is T41 (2023).

**Justin Rose**, No. 7 in the Aon Next 10, owns seven top-10 finishes in 15 career starts in the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, highlighted by his first career PGA TOUR title in 2010.

**PGA TOUR announces enhancements to TOUR Championship format and FedExCup race**

*Fan Forward research informed player-led changes, including elimination of Starting Strokes in 2025*

**PONTE VEDRA BEACH, FLORIDA** – As part of its ongoing commitment to accelerate innovation on behalf of fans, the PGA TOUR announced updates to its TOUR Championship format. Beginning this year, Starting Strokes will be eliminated from the season-ending TOUR Championship as the TOUR's top players compete for a chance to win the PGA TOUR's Ultimate Prize, the FedExCup.

With support of its Proud Partners Accenture, Coca-Cola and Southern Company, the TOUR Championship will be played at East Lake Golf Club in Atlanta, August 18-24.

“Our Fan Forward initiative has helped us evaluate each part of the PGA TOUR season and today’s announcement is an important first step in the evolution of our postseason,” said PGA TOUR Commissioner Jay Monahan. “The Player Advisory Council led a thorough process to respond to what our fans are asking for: The most competitive golf in the world, played for the highest stakes, in the most straightforward and engaging format.”

The PGA TOUR is announcing three meaningful changes to the TOUR Championship:

- **Elimination of Starting Strokes** - The TOUR Championship will be played as a 72-hole stroke-play event, with all players starting the tournament at even par. The best performer over the course of four rounds at the TOUR Championship will win the FedExCup.
- **Adjustments to Course Setup** - In response to data indicating fans want to see winning scores closer to par, the PGA TOUR Rules Committee will adjust its course setup approach to encourage more risk/reward moments throughout each round, further heightening the drama and competition to determine the FedExCup Champion.
- **Toughest Tournament to Qualify for** - Already the most elite field in golf, the TOUR Championship field size will remain at 30 players in 2025. The Player Advisory Council is studying the qualification system of future years to raise the stakes on the entire FedExCup season and reinforce the TOUR Championship as the hardest tournament to qualify for.

As the PGA TOUR continues to evolve and respond to feedback from fans and players, additional enhancements to the TOUR Championship are being evaluated and will be announced in the coming months.

“We want the TOUR Championship to be the hardest tournament to qualify for and the FedExCup trophy the most difficult to win,” said reigning FedExCup champion and PAC member Scottie Scheffler. “Shifting the TOUR Championship to a more straight-up format with a tougher course

setup makes it easier for fans to follow and provides a more challenging test for players – which brings out the best competition.”

Scheffler, who has entered the TOUR Championship as the No. 1 player in the FedExCup the last three seasons, captured his first FedExCup in 2024 following a historic seven-win season. Players to have won the FedExCup include Jordan Spieth (2015), Justin Thomas (2017), Patrick Cantlay (2021), Viktor Hovland (2023) and multiple winners Tiger Woods (2007, 2009) and Rory McIlroy (2016, 2019, 2022).

“FedEx has proudly supported the PGA TOUR for more than three decades and we embrace the TOUR’s commitment to innovate and deliver the most compelling competition that inspires fans and creates a lasting legacy for players,” said FedEx President & CEO, Raj Subramaniam. “The FedExCup was created in 2007 to recognize season-long performance across the PGA TOUR season and now a generation of players have grown up watching the TOUR Championship with dreams of hoisting the Ultimate Prize.”

NBC, CBS Sports and GOLF Channel have worked closely with the PGA TOUR to review the Fan Forward research and identify opportunities to enhance the postseason. As the TOUR Championship rotates network coverage each year, NBC will present the 2025 event, with coverage on CBS in 2026.

“We applaud the PGA TOUR and their Player Advisory Council for listening to fans and are excited to collaborate on one of the premier events in golf,” said NBC Sports President Rick Cordella. “NBC is proud to be the home of the TOUR Championship in 2025 and showcase compelling competition with the PGA TOUR’s top performers vying to become the FedExCup Champion.”

NBC will carry the final two rounds of the TOUR Championship live in 2025, with early round and weekend lead-in coverage on GOLF Channel. Coverage is also available on PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+, Sirius XM and distributed internationally via the World Feed.

“GOLF Channel is honored to be home to around-the-clock coverage of the PGA TOUR and the TOUR Championship,” said Tom Knapp, Executive Vice President GOLF Channel. “As GOLF Channel celebrates its 30th anniversary in 2025, we’re proud to partner and evolve together with the PGA TOUR. I am particularly thrilled that we will be part of bringing their new fan viewing enhancements to life for spectators at home.”

First implemented in 2019, Starting Strokes was a staggered start format with the FedExCup leader beginning the TOUR Championship at 10-under par. With the elimination of Starting Strokes, the FedExCup bonus distributions for the top 30 positions through the TOUR Championship will be balanced for 2025 to account for the increased volatility, reward season-long performance and recognize the significance of the FedExCup.



The TOUR Championship features the top 30 players from the FedExCup standings who have advanced through the FedEx St. Jude Championship at TPC Southwind (top 70) in Memphis, Tennessee, and the BMW Championship (top 50) at Caves Valley Golf Club in Owings Mills, Maryland. Players who finish in the top 70 will be exempt for all Full-Field Events and THE PLAYERS Championship in 2026, with the top 50 finishers earning Signature Event starts in 2026. The FedExCup Fall, beginning with the Procore Championship (Sept. 11-14) will finalize eligibility for the 2026 season with the top 100 players earning fully exempt status.
