2025 THE PLAYERS Championship Message Document

- The PGA TOUR's Gold Standard:** As the flagship event of the PGA TOUR and the championship the players call their own, players earn the right to compete against the strongest and most merit-based field in search of their defining moment. THE PLAYERS Championship will welcome the game's best back to Northeast Florida to compete for a \$25 million purse, and 750 FedExCup points for the winner – the first of five events this season to do so. THE PLAYERS is the third event in the Florida Swing, which began with the Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches (won by Joe Highsmith) and continued with the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard in Orlando (won by Russell Henley). The TOUR will make its way to Palm Harbor for the Valspar Championship next week, where Peter Malnati will defend his 2024 title.
- THE PLAYERS Stadium Course:** THE PLAYERS Stadium Course has been fine-tuned over the years to ensure the preservation of the vision that Pete Dye put forth over 40 years ago, while continuing to challenge the game's best players. This year, the most noticeable addition is the iconic leaning tree on No. 6 tee, which forces players to flight their tee shots appropriately. The design team, led by Davis Love III, Steve Wenzloff and Stephen Cox, was able to find a similar tree to the one that was removed after the 2014 championship, and replaced it on the tee to bring back one of the hallmarks of Dye's original design. In addition to No. 6, 15 yards were added to the tees on Nos. 2 and 11, with eight yards being added to No. 16, bringing the lengths of the three holes up to modern standards.
- Fan-centric innovations:** THE PLAYERS Championship continues to set the standard for fan engagement and experience, leading the way in introducing new ideas and trends that connect and engage with sports fans worldwide. In 2025, the championship will introduce myriad exciting features designed to elevate the event for fans across the globe. These innovations not only enhance the experience at TPC Sawgrass but also align with the PGA TOUR's Fan Forward initiative—a data-driven, audience-centric approach to delivering what fans want most. Fan-centric innovations taking center stage at THE PLAYERS include the AI Course Setup Tool presented by Morgan Stanley, Game the Green powered by Comcast Business, PGA TOUR World Feed, ESPN BET on PGA TOUR LIVE, TOURCAST Generative AI Commentary, Enhanced Coverage and All Access, Cosm, Roblox and more.
- Competitions Corner:**
 - Scheffler eyes rare three-peat:** Two-time defending PLAYERS Champion and current World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler will return to TPC Sawgrass with an eye on a third consecutive victory, which would be the first on the PGA TOUR since 2011 (Steve Stricker, John Deere Classic, 2009-11). In 2024, Scheffler became the first player in championship history to successfully defend his title, defeating Wyndham Clark, Xander Schauffele and Brian Harman by one stroke with a 20-under 268 total. Scheffler will be making his fifth career start at THE PLAYERS, and looks to join Jack Nicklaus (1974, 1976, 1978) as the event's only three-time champion.
 - The field:** THE PLAYERS field features 48 of the top 50 players in the Official World Golf Ranking (OWGR), representation from 24 countries, and eight past champions: Scottie Scheffler (2023, 2024), Justin Thomas (2021), Rory McIlroy (2019), Si Woo Kim (2017), Jason Day (2016), Rickie Fowler (2015), Matt Kuchar (2012), Adam Scott (2004). All of the top 10 players in the OWGR are competing, hoping to continue a streak of the last

five PLAYERS champions entering the week inside the top 10: 2024/Scheffler/1, 2023/Scheffler/2, 2022/Cam Smith/10, 2021/Thomas/3, 2019/McIlroy/6.

- **PGA TOUR Rookies at THE PLAYERS:** Among the 25 first-timers in the field, there are eight PGA TOUR rookies making their PLAYERS debut: Frankie Capan III, Will Chandler, Rasmus Højgaard, Aldrich Potgieter, Isaiah Salinda, Jackson Suber, Jesper Svensson and Karl Vilips. The PGA TOUR rookie with the highest finish at THE PLAYERS is David Lingmerth (T2/2013); Fulton Allem (T3/1998) and Camilo Villegas (T3/2006) are the only others to finish inside the top five.
- **Last man in:** PGA TOUR rookie Karl Vilips claimed his first career title at the Puerto Rico Open to qualify for his PLAYERS Championship debut. Vilips, the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Rookie of the Year, is the first PGA TOUR rookie to win this season.

Creator Classic at TPC Sawgrass presented by YouTube: On the eve of THE PLAYERS Championship, 10 top golf creators will compete in the inaugural Creator Classic at TPC Sawgrass presented by YouTube. Open to Wednesday ticketholders, this nine-hole event will be broadcast on the PGA TOUR's YouTube channel, as well as GOLF Channel, ESPN+, the PGA TOUR channel on Pluto TV, Roku, Samsung TV Plus, Prime Video, Fire TV, Tubi, Xumo Play and LG Channels. Participants include Bryan Bros, Fat Perez (Bob Does Sports), Gabby Golf Girl, Roger Steele, Grant Horvat, Kyle Berkshire, Tisha Alyn, Soly (No Laying Up), and a Barstool personality chosen via qualifier. The event begins on the par-4 10th hole and ends on the iconic 17th, with the top three advancing to a playoff on 17. Pairings and tee times will be announced on Tuesday at 5 p.m.

Honoring the Military at THE PLAYERS: A full slate of military initiatives is set for 2025, highlighted by Military Appreciation Day on Tuesday, March 11. The annual flyover during the Military Appreciation Ceremony will continue with the 169th Fighter Wing at 4:30 p.m. Beginning at 5 p.m., award-winning, multi-Platinum singer-songwriter Jordan Davis will perform at the tournament's concert on the 17th hole. Prior to tournament week, the tournament hosted a Military Job Fair on Saturday, March 8, and Operation Shower on Sunday, March 9. As in year's past, all active duty, retired, reserve and National Guard members will have access to complimentary and discounted tickets.

Justin Thomas

- 2021 PLAYERS Champion finished with 64-68 (132) en route to his title, tied for the lowest final 36-hole total in tournament history
- Coming off his first missed cut (2024) in nine career appearances at THE PLAYERS; of his 18 scores in the first two rounds at TPC Sawgrass, has only broken 70 twice (68/R2/2016, 69/R2/2022)
- Seeks his first TOUR victory since the 2022 PGA Championship (55 starts)
- Three top-10s in six starts entering the week, including a runner-up at The American Express

Collin Morikawa

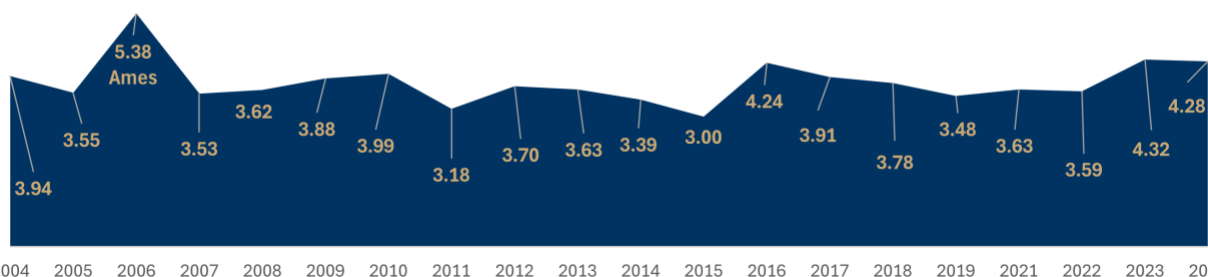

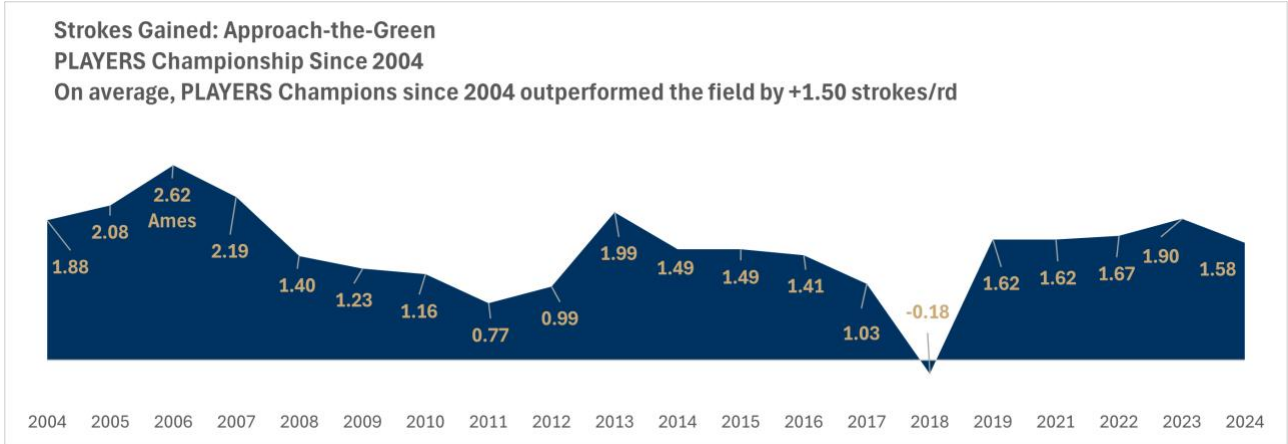

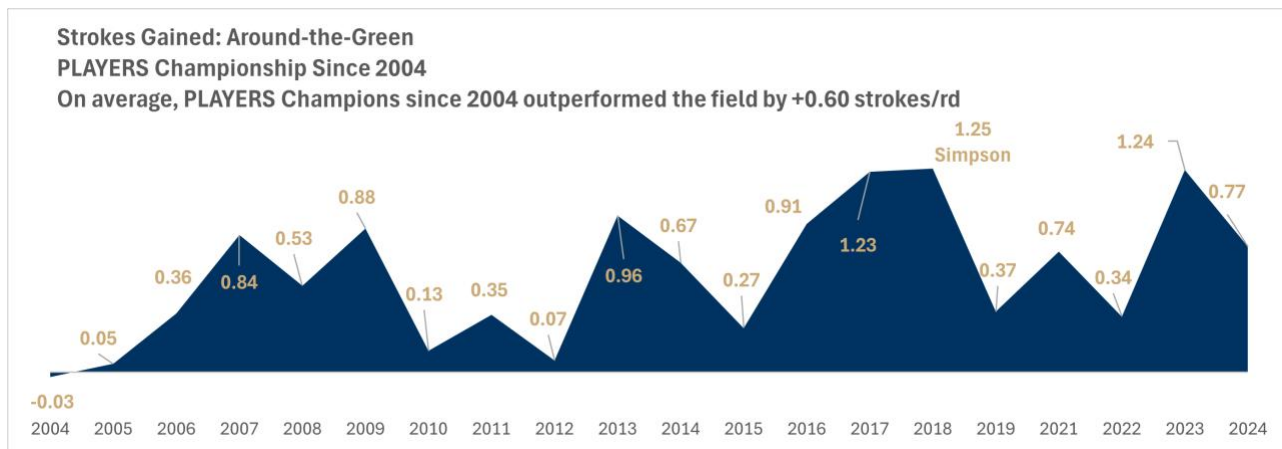

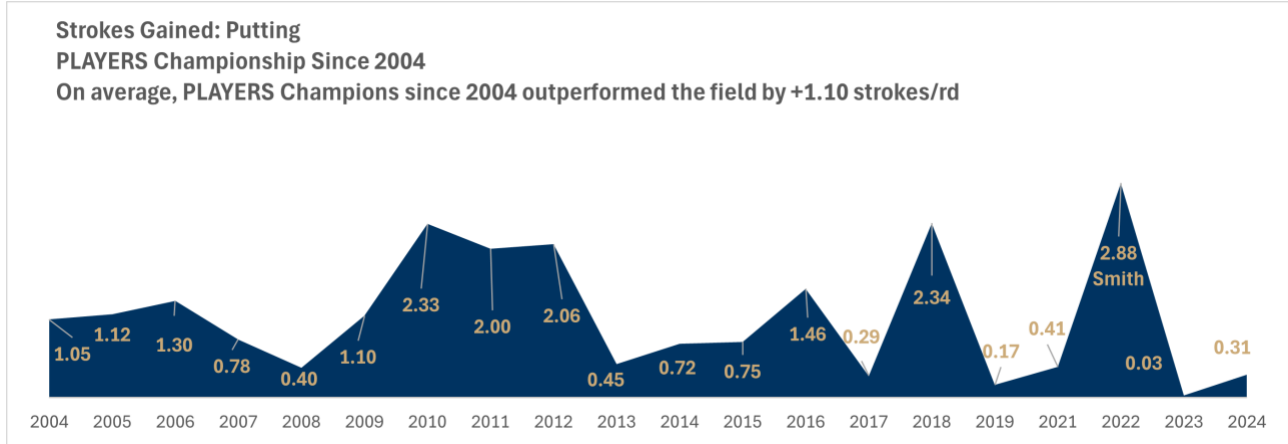

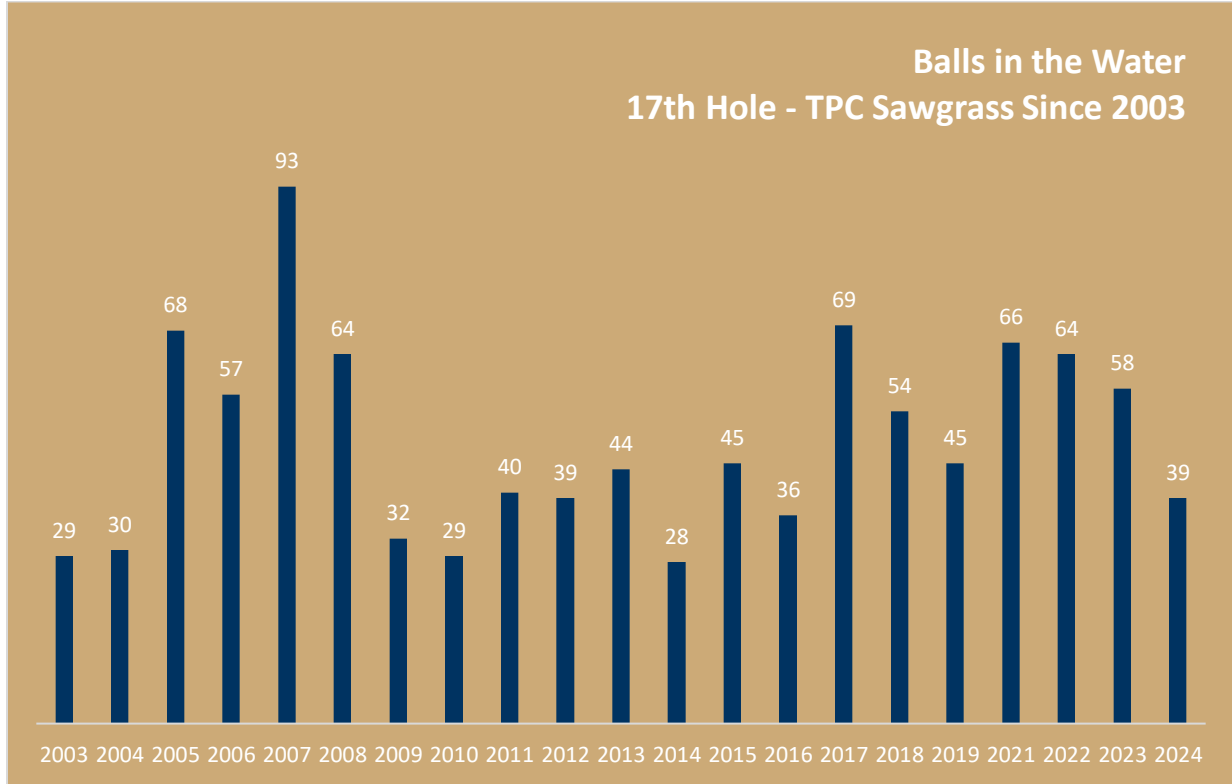

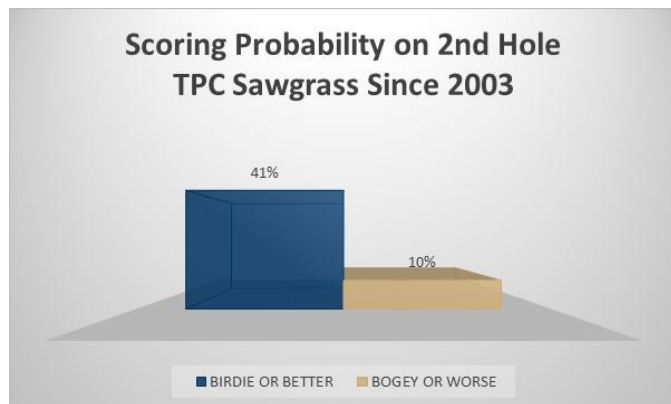
