ANNC: How's his Presidents Cup going? Well I can see why they were lining up to play with Cam Young.

## WORLD NUMBER ONE SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER AND PARTNER SAM BURNS CAPITALIZE ON A SLOW START FROM CAM DAVIS AND SI WOO KIM.

ANNC: And that is three wins in the last five holes for Scottie Scheffler and Sam Burns. It's getting away from Cam Davis and Si Woo Kim.

ANNC: Bayou brilliance for Schauffele and Cantlay! Wire-to-wire winners at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans.

PATRICK CANTLAY: Well Xander's a great player. So partnering with somebody as good as he is, I'm not surprised that we've played well together.

DAVIS LOVE III: Cantlay and Schauffele are an incredible team. Just run them out there as many times as they can stand it and they're going to give you great results.

### THAT WAS EVIDENT ON THURSDAY WHEN THE TWO COMBINED FOR FOUR BIRDIES AND ZERO BOGEYS IN 13 HOLES OF ALTERNATE SHOT.

ANNC: Took full advantage of that!

XANDER SCHAUFFELE: We're both very competitive. We have similar mindsets in terms of how to attack a golf course and he's an unreal scrambler of the golf ball and I've tried to learn along the way from him.

ANNC: Boy, Cantlay going for the knockout punch there.

PATRICK CANTLAY: He's very well rounded. He's great on tough, big golf courses because he hits the ball so well. And then he just has a knack for making big putts at the right time.

ANNC: Now 5-0-0 as a pairing in Presidents and Ryder Cup Foursomes.

PATRICK CANTLAY: We play a lot of golf together so there's a level of comfort there that I don't think either of us would have with anyone else.

XANDER SCHAUFFELE: Everything's firing and everything's working really well, so I'm happy to be his partner.

### ...BUT ANOTHER LONG PUTT FROM YOUNG SEALS A THIRD POINT FOR THE AMERICANS.

ANNC: Cameron Young in his first big-time team competition closes it out!

CAMERON YOUNG: It wasn't a putt that I feel like you could really try to make. Every once in a while, those go in.

# WITH THEIR BACKS AGAINST THE WALL, DAVIS AND KIM BREATHE LIFE BACK INTO THE INTERNATIONALS...

ANNC: On a very good line if it's the right number. They're asking for it, talkin' for it, it checks up right behind the hole! What a clutch shot!

#### ...WINNING THE FINAL FOUR HOLES TO SNATCH A MUCH-NEEDED POINT.

CAM DAVIS: I think it took us a little while to get the speed on the greens. And then they eventually started going in the hole, and it was right at the right time as well. It was great to turn the tide from a pretty rough start to a really cool finish.

# TAYLOR PENDRITH AND MITO PEREIRA DRAW EVEN HEADING TO THE FINAL HOLE, BUT WITH A HALF-POINT UP FOR GRABS, PENDRITH'S PUTT IS OFF-LINE.

ANNC: And it's another resounding lead after foursomes play, 4-1.

DAVIS LOVE III: We had some matches where we were rolling and the guys played great, and some matches like this one with Tony and Max where they ground it out so a great start, a lot of heart.

TREVOR IMMELMAN: Americans played some brilliant golf today. I think we're going to have to find a way to make a few putts in the next few days. But we'll hang in there and keep fighting, it's what we do.

### B1\* - Quail Hollow Agronomy and Course

NATS OF AGRONOMY

## PREPPED AND READY TO GO FOR ROUND TWO, QUAIL HOLLOW CLUB IS A THEATER PERFECTLY SUITED FOR GOLF'S BIGGEST STAGE.

JORDAN SPIETH: Quail Hollow is such a great golf course. It will be such a good test. This will be high quality golf. You got to hit some really nice shots on a golf course like this.

COREY CONNERS: It's a very exciting golf course. Very challenging. All very, very demanding.

### BEST KNOWN FOR IT'S FINISHING THREE HOLES, A-K-A "THE GREEN MILE"...

PATRICK CANTLAY: That finish, that 16, 17, 18 is one of the more iconic finishes on TOUR.

### BUT REROUTED FOR THE PRESIDENTS CUP WITH THE HOPES OF THE GREEN MILE FACTORING INTO EVERY MATCH.

TONY FINAU: Now that's the meat of the course and the meat of the matches. Most of the matches are going to reach 13 to 15.

JUSTIN THOMAS: It has opportunities to have some big swings, some big time fireworks.

BILLY HORSCHEL: You can go birdie-birdie and make up a ton of ground and you can easily go double-double and lose a ton of ground.

MITO PEREIRA: If you hit it really long, you can carry the bunker, but if not, you've got to go a little left to the fairway and then it's probably like a six iron, so it's a long hole.

ADAM SCOTT: On the cusp of being a little unfair, especially in the pressure situation when you're hitting a five iron into a green tilting toward the water that's surrounded by water, and there's no real bailout area. It is just one of the most demanding holes you'll ever play.

KEVIN KISNER: You got to hit a heck of a drive. If you get it in the fairway, you can make birdie, but you get it out of position, you're fighting for par the rest of the hole.

ADAM SCOTT: It's just a beautiful hole back up toward the clubhouse and just requires two really good shots and you'll be punished if you don't.

TONY FINAU: That stretch of three holes is some of the best golf we have on the PGA TOUR.

#### B2\* - Round 2 Start

THE PRESIDENTS CUP LIVES UP TO ITS NAME ON FRIDAY MORNING...AS FORMER U.S. PRESIDENTS BILL CLINTON AND GEORGE W. BUSH ARE ON HAND TO WITNESS A SPECTACULAR START TO DAY TWO.

ANNC: Four-ball today, five more matches. Trevor Immelman and the Internationals in full chase mode right now as they have to come back and get it going in a hurry.

THE HOME TEAM ARRIVES AT QUAIL HOLLOW HOLDING A 4-1 EDGE AFTER THE FIRST ROUND, AND THE U.S. LOOKS TO A DYNAMIC DUO TO SET THE TONE ON DAY TWO...

#### SPIETH AND THOMAS STRIKE EARLY AND OFTEN...

ANNC: Spieth and Thomas firing up the crowd, 3 UP now, commanding lead.

JORDAN SPIETH: When we're on, we can dial it up and really get hot. We just did a great job of making a lot of birdies on different holes.

### MEANWHILE, TAKING ON THE PREMIERE PAIRING OF PATRICK CANTLAY AND XANDER SCHAUFFELE...

ANNC: Youngest guy on either team says bring it on!

# IS RISING SUPERSTAR TOM KIM AND HIDEKI MATSUYAMA, BUT THE AMERICANS WIN FOUR-STRAIGHT HOLES EARLY TO TAKE COMMAND...

ANNC: This is getting to be desperation time on day two for the Internationals.

# DOWN BUT CERTAINLY NOT OUT, THE INTERNATIONAL TEAM BATTLES BACK AS SUNGJAE IM AND SEBASTIAN MUNOZ TRADE HAYMAKERS WITH WORLD NUMBER ONE SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER AND SAM BURNS...

ANNC: Looks pretty good, looks real good...REALLY GOOD! Sam Burns with a monster eagle!

### BURNS GIVES THE U.S. A 1 UP LEAD THROUGH SEVEN, BUT MUNOZ RESPONDS.

ANNC: It's a win for the Internationals and boy did they need some momentum going in their direction.

# CHRISTIAAN BEZUIDENHOUT AND MITO PEREIRA ALSO FIND THEMSELVES LOCKED IN A BACK-AND-FORTH BATTLE WITH KEVIN KISNER AND CAMERON YOUNG.

ANNC: Pereira and Bezuidenhout now nudge ahead 1 UP through 10.

## BUT JUST AS THE INTERNATIONAL SIDE STARTS TO GET SOME MOMENTUM, JORDAN SPIETH RESPONDS...

ANNC: Of course! First point on this Friday goes the American way. 2&1 victory.

JUSTIN THOMAS: It is just really, really nice having Jordan as a partner. Anything and everything he does on the golf course does not surprise me.

### FIVE DOWN WITH SEVEN TO PLAY, TOM KIM WINS THREE OF THE NEXT FOUR HOLES...

ANNC: Aggressive fist pump by the 20-year-old.

#### BUT THE VALIANT EFFORT ULTIMATELY FALLS SHORT.

ANNC: 3&2, Cantlay and Schauffele, winners once again.

### NOW TRAILING 6-1, SUNGJAE IM MAKES BACK-TO-BACK BIRDIES ON 14 AND 15...

ANNC: And that is exactly the kind of ignition that the Internationals need.

ANNC: Sungiae Im from 33-feet going down the slope for birdie...He's Mr. Hole Out.

#### BUT ONCE AGAIN, BURNS RESPONDS.

ANNC: These guys are putting on a show.

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: That stretch of 14, 15 was insane. The quality of the shots these guys hit. It was awesome to be part of that.

ANNC: And they've pulled even again with the world number one and Sam Burns.

### HOWEVER, SCHEFFLER HAS A CHANCE FOR THE KNOCKOUT BLOW ON 18.

ANNC: That close to the win but it's not gonna fall.

ANNC: They take it all the way to the 18th and end up with a half point. 6.5 to 1.5 on the big board.

PEREIRA AND BEZUIDENHOUT ALSO SETTLE FOR A HALF POINT AGAINST KISNER AND YOUNG...LEAVING THE SCORE AT 7-2 WITH ONLY ONE MATCH LEFT ON THE COURSE – THE CANADIAN TANDEM OF COREY CONNERS AND TAYLOR PENDRITH AGAINST FELLOW ROOKIES BILLY HORSCHEL AND MAX HOMA.

### B3\* - Max Homa Feature

HOMA ENTERS THE PRESIDENTS CUP WITH SIGNIFICANT MOMENTUM, FRESH OFF A SUCCESSFUL TITLE DEFENSE AT THE SEASON OPENER JUST FIVE DAYS PRIOR...

ANNC: It is Max Homa who ends up holding the Fortinet trophy for the second-straight year.

MAX HOMA: I really just wanted to make sure I was in form. I didn't want to come in here without, some of my best golf going on just because I want to be able to support the team, play well for them, represent my country the best I can.

### IN ADDITION TO HIS RECENT VICTORY, HOMA'S HISTORY AT QUAIL HOLLOW ALSO BODES WELL FOR THE 31-YEAR-OLD...

MAX HOMA: Whenever you go back to a place where you won, the good memories flood your mind a bit.

ANNC: How fantastic! Great place to start your winning career.

MAX HOMA: Getting to do it on a very large golf course, a very difficult golf course. I'm very proud that was my first one. I hadn't ever really been in that position before. I definitely gained a bunch of confidence in myself.

HOMA HAS COME A LONG WAY SINCE HIS FIRST PGA TOUR VICTORY AT QUAIL HOLLOW, WHICH STANDS OUT AS A TRUE TURNING POINT IN HIS CAREER.

IT WAS THE FIRST OF FIVE CAREER WINS – INCLUDING TWO DURING THE 2021-22 SEASON...

ANNC: A champion on the rise!

### ...WHICH PROPELLED HOMA TO HIS FIRST U.S. PRESIDENTS CUP TEAM AS A CAPTAIN'S PICK.

MAX HOMA: It'd be amazing to be part of a winning team with the Presidents Cup. I'm 31, man. I thought I'd be doing this when I was like 24 or 25, so having that kind of extra wait has made me appreciate it even more.

ANNC: He's waited a long time to feel what it's like in this atmosphere.

MAX HOMA: The nerves might be a little different, but my game's in a good spot. It was nice to go out there last week, play great and show myself that my game should be ready for this week. It felt like a match play-type thing.

ANNC: Max definitely thinking he has to make this to have any shot.

MAX HOMA: Just one shot here and there.

ANNC: Can you believe that?! Oh my goodness.

MAX HOMA: Hopefully it's foreshadowing something this week.

### **B4\* - Round 2 Conclusion**

ANNC: And Pendrith just drills it!

...FORCING HOMA TO MAKE HIS BIRDIE TO WIN THE FULL POINT.

ANNC: Just when Max Homa might have thought he did it all at 17, the spotlight grows even bigger on him to put this one away.

ANNC: What a moment for this guy! Boy has he bloomed into a star.

MAX HOMA: I was nervous as could be over that putt, but it was fun. Money cannot buy that feeling. And that was something that I will remember forever, and I will tell anybody who ever wants to hear about it how that felt.

THANKS TO HOMA'S HEROICS, THE AMERICAN TEAM ENDS THE DAY WITH AN 8-2 ADVANTAGE – TIED FOR THE LARGEST LEAD THROUGH TWO ROUNDS IN PRESIDENTS CUP HISTORY.

### C1\* - Captain Immelman gifts Rolex's to Team INTL

TREVOR IMMELMAN: I started thinking about where we're at...North Carolina. This is where the first powered flight happened at Kittyhawk, not that far from here, the Wright brothers. For four years, they failed at keeping this plane in the air, more than a thousand attempts. People telling them that they had no chance, people telling them that they couldn't do it. I mean, it sounds pretty familiar, doesn't it? Maybe we can just find a way to take off and fly this this week. I found this watch that's called an Air King. Every time you look down at this watch and you'll see our shields engraved on the back, you'll remember the Wright brothers. You'll remember this week. You'll remember the fact that you made it to this team and how special that is.

### **C2\* - Round 3**

ANNC: The dawn of a new day has Team USA thinking of stretching out its lead. The International side hoping to apply some pressure to forge a massive comeback. So far, it's been almost all red, white, and blue.

ENTERING DAY 3 FACING A SIX-POINT DEFICIT, THE INTERNATIONAL TEAM NEEDS A FAST START TO KEEP THEIR PRESIDENTS CUP HOPES ALIVE...

ANNC: Great technique there! Great shot! Great execution!

WHICH THEY GET FROM K.H. LEE AND TOM KIM, WHO TAKE A 1 UP LEAD THRU FIVE HOLES...

BUT SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER AND SAM BURNS BOUNCE BACK AND WIN THE NEXT TWO...TAKING A 1 UP LEAD INTO THE TURN.

THE RED, WHITE & BLUE TRAIN KEEPS ROLLING AS THE AMERICANS TAKE 2 UP LEADS IN ALL THREE REMAINING MATCHES...

ANNC: Jordan Spieth from the bunker. Look at that velvet touch. What a gorgeous shot there from Spieth.

ANNC: Max Homa from short of the green. There it is! That's two hole outs this morning for the Americans.

### TRAILING IN ALL FOUR MATCHES, THE INTERNATIONALS' CHANCES LOOK BLEAK BARRING A SHIFT IN ENERGY...

### BUT THE PILLARS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TEAM IGNITE THAT SPARK, WINNING HOLES 9 AND 10 TO TIE THEIR MATCH...

ANNC: Beautiful shot there for the Internationals! A little bounce in their step.

# WHILE K.H. LEE AND TOM KIM CONTINUE THE MOMENTUM WITH WINS AT THE $10^{\mathrm{TH}}$ AND $11^{\mathrm{TH}}$ ...

ANNC: Now, this for eagle to win the hole. Looks good. Boy, is he embracing the moment, the stage that he is on!

ANNC: Homa and Finau beat the International side 4 & 3. Another point on the board for the U.S.

ANNC: Now K.H. Lee...and he's got the perfect pace!

ANNC: Job well done there. That's exactly what he had to do and there it is! There you go. Hats off. So the International team wins 2 & 1.

### WITH ONE POINT IN THE BAG, CAPTAIN IMMELMAN NEEDS HIS TEAM LEADERS TO SECURE THE FINAL POINT IN ROUND 3...

ANNC: You count on him to make putts...finally gets one to go here at 11!

### SCOTT & MATSUYAMA WIN THE FIRST FOUR HOLES ON THE BACK NINE AND NEVER LOOK BACK, TALLYING ANOTHER POINT FOR THE INTERNATIONALS.

ANNC: After losing 4-1 on day one, 4-1 on day two, they split the day three third session 2-2 and the International Team is fired up.

ADAM SCOTT: Any victory against the U.S. Team has to be really hard fought so this feels good.

### C3\* - Adam Scott's 10th Presidents Cup

ADAM SCOTT: Over the years I've given a lot to the Presidents Cup teams.

ANNC: Yes! There's Adam Scott!

ADAM SCOTT: I guess I'm the old guy on the team every year. And I remember I really looked up to the elder statesman.

ANNC: Youngest player in the competition at 23.

ADAM SCOTT: I really believe we're on the right path now. There's a whole bunch of kids from all around the world wanting to play on the International team.

TREVOR IMMELMAN: Hey Scottie! Man, 10 Presidents Cups? That is quite something. The longevity that you've had in your career, the dedication that you've shown to get to this point, it really is amazing.

HIDEKI MATSUYAMA: I've always found the comfort in having you on the team with me. I feel very inspired to follow in your footstep and continue to build on my Presidents Cup career.

CAM DAVIS: I can't imagine what it's been like going through none of these and coming into the 10th one, all the excitement and the memories it's going to be. It's going to be awesome to share it with you, mate.

TAYLOR PENDRITH: What a run you've had and still going strong. This is my first one, but it's an honor to be on the team with you at your 10th.

ADAM SCOTT: In some ways I don't feel like it's 10. I still feel pretty young and certainly hanging around this team, I have to feel young and that's a really good thing.

TREVOR IMMELMAN: You've been bought in from the minute go. You've been an unbelievable pillar for me to lean on and a rock for our team. So enjoy this week. You've earned it. You deserve it. You are an absolute legend, man.

COMING OFF HIS FOURSOMES VICTORY EARLIER IN THE DAY, SCOTT RETURNS TO THE COURSE SATURDAY AFTERNOON FOR THE FOURTH ROUND. THE INTERNATIONALS TRAIL 10-4 AND LOOK TO STAGE A COMEBACK DURING FOUR-BALL...

ANNC: This is their format, the one that they have shined in through the years.

PAIRED WITH FELLOW COUNTRYMAN CAM DAVIS, SCOTT CATCHES FIRE WITH THE FLATSTICK TO STAY TIED AT THE TURN AGAINST SAM BURNS AND BILLY HORSCHEL...

ANNC: That is three birdies in a row now for Adam Scott.

WITH THE AUSSIES LEADING THE WAY, SUNGJAE IM AND SEBASTIAN MUNOZ DO THEIR PART TO KEEP THE INTERNATIONALS' MOMENTUM GOING...RACING OUT TO A 3 UP LEAD.

ANNC: Im and Munoz in clear command!

THEY NEVER TRAIL EN ROUTE TO A 3 & 2 VICTORY OVER TONY FINAU AND KEVIN KISNER...

BUT JORDAN SPIETH AND JUSTIN THOMAS RESPOND WITH A DOMINANT PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OWN AGAINST HIDEKI MATSUYAMA AND TAYLOR PENDRITH.

ANNC: Jordan Spieth doing what Jordan Spieth does! Three consecutive holes won.

SPIETH FINISHES OFF THE DUO'S FOURTH VICTORY OF THE WEEK AT THE  $15^{TH}$ , AS ONLY HE CAN.

ANNC: Come on! He did it again! Now it's gotten ridiculous! He is something else.

### C5\* - Jordan Spieth & Justin Thomas Feature

SPIETH AND THOMAS ARE NOW JUST THE THIRD AMERICAN DUO TO EVER GO 4-0 AT A SINGLE PRESIDENTS CUP – AND THE FIRST SINCE TIGER WOODS AND STEVE STRICKER IN 2009.

JORDAN SPIETH: I had a lot of fun with Justin. Seemed like when we needed something to go in, we found a way to do it.

ANNC: He just seems to have that knack for that moment!

JORDAN SPIETH: There's a lot of talk about whose games mesh with each other's, but I think first and foremost, you want somebody who you're going to mesh with, that you're really going to enjoy spending that time with because you're feeling that kind of back-nine-Sunday-at-a-major pressure. You can feed off each other.

ANNC: Spieth and Thomas firing up the crowd, commanding lead. Another great day for the US at Quail Hollow.

JUSTIN THOMAS: It's fun. Just even last night, getting all together in the team room and catching up. It feels great to be back together.

## WHILE THOMAS AND SPIETH FORM A DOMINANT DUO, THOMAS IS MAKING PLENTY OF HISTORY ON HIS OWN.

ANNC: This guy has been money, absolute money for the American side!

# HE'S THE FIRST PLAYER EVER TO WIN 10 MATCHES IN HIS FIRST THREE PRESIDENTS CUP APPEARANCES...BUT IT'S MORE THAN JUST THE RESULTS – IT'S HIS TRADEMARK TENACITY THAT TRULY SETS HIM APART.

ANNC: How about that emotion!

TIGER WOODS: JT is one of the most talented guys that we have. Everybody loves him. And he's got that little fire personality that you want.

ANNC: Yep, that's a drop the putter moment for Justin Thomas and Tiger Woods!

JUSTIN THOMAS: It was a very surreal moment. And to be able to make that putt and just kind of go unconscious and celebrate was really, really cool.

DAVIS LOVE: When there's a putt to be made on the last hole, he's the guy that wants to make it and then he's ready to celebrate it because he knows it's going in.

ANNC: Look at that reaction! He knew just how important that putt was!

JUSTIN THOMAS: When it's mano a mano or the team versus the team, I have to do whatever is possible to beat that person. Sometimes you have to dig deep. But whatever it takes to get your team a point, you got to do it.

# PLAYING WITH SI WOO KIM, THE SOUTH KOREAN PAIRING BATTLES WITH THE JUGGERNAUT TANDEM OF XANDER SCHAUFFELE AND PATRICK CANTLAY...

ANNC: Back and forth they go...

### THE AMERICANS START TO TAKE COMMAND, BUILDING A 2 UP LEAD ON THE BACK NINE...

ANNC: Time and again, these two tend to come up with big shots and big putts!

### BUT TOM KIM ANSWERS BACK, CUTTING THE DEFICIT IN HALF WITH HIS SECOND EAGLE OF THE DAY AT THE DRIVABLE PAR-4, 11<sup>TH</sup>.

TOM KIM: We were two down, and we just came off a bogey on 10. I tried to really bring some energy and we got some momentum there.

### THEN, ON 16, A CLUTCH BIRDIE TIES THE MATCH...

ANNC: Si Woo Kim rolling it in! Tom Kim loves it! That match all tied with two holes left to play.

### MEANWHILE, THE AUSSIES ALSO DRAW EVEN AT 16...

ANNC: Cam Davis coming through alongside his idol.

CAM DAVIS: To play with him is a dream come true. To play great golf alongside him is even better.

TOM KIM: If people start to recognize me, I would appreciate that. But I'm just trying to play good golf and put points for the team.

WHILE HE'S A ROOKIE ON THE NEWLY MINTED INTERNATIONAL TEAM – TOM KIM STOLE THE HEARTS OF THE U.S. CROWD WITH HIS ENTHUSIASM AND INTENSITY FROM THE START.

NATS: Come on, let's go! Woo!

TOM KIM: In tournaments, I would never, ever shout this loud or go this crazy. But I'm just trying to bring some good energy to the team.

# ALTHOUGH KIM'S STAR POWER HAS BEEN BUILDING AT A RAPID PACE – HIS PERSONAL EXPECTATIONS TO MAKE THE TEAM SEEMED FAR FROM REALITY EARLIER IN THE YEAR.

TOM KIM: To get my Korn Ferry Tour card was probably the only goal I had. It's been an extremely short cut, and it saved me a couple of years in my life. Starting from Scottish Open finishing third there.

ANNC: 20-year-old nerves...just barreled it in there.

### THE NEXT WEEK IT WAS APPARENT CAPTAIN TREVOR IMMELMAN TOOK NOTICE OF KIM'S CONTINUING CLIMB UP THE RANKS.

TOM KIM: The first time I met him at The Open, and just him kind of watching a couple of holes or seeing me hitting on the range. From that point on, it was all about me trying to make this team.

TOM KIM: I was like, ya know what, a few good weeks here, maybe I can get my TOUR card right away.

NATS: (cheering from hole out)

TOM KIM: And I secured it in Detroit. It was an unbelievable feeling.

ANNC: A 63 today for Kim today and that ties the tournament record.

## WITH A 7<sup>TH</sup> PLACE FINISH AT THE ROCKET MORTGAGE CLASSIC, KIM LOCKED IN HIS PGA TOUR CARD FOR THE 2022-23 SEASON...

BUT AS HIS HOPES OF A BERTH IN THE FEDEXCUP PLAYOFFS AND PRESIDENTS CUP WERE ON THE LINE – THE PRESSURE WAS ON – AS THE ONLY OUTLET OF DOING SO WAS TO WIN THE FINAL REGULAR SEASON EVENT.

TOM KIM: The best way for me to prove myself onto the team was just kind of pulling through. And it doesn't get tougher than winning on the PGA TOUR. I told myself if you want to make the Presidents Cup, you've got to do well this back nine.

ANNC: Tom Kim is the champion at the Wyndham Championship!

TOM KIM: And for me to do that was it was definitely rewarding.

ANNC: He was born in Seoul, South Korea and now he is a star in America!

# IT WAS A PERFORMANCE BEFITTING OF WHAT IT TAKES TO COME UP CLUTCH – AS HE ALREADY HAS IN A MEMORABLE WEEK AT QUAIL HOLLOW.

ANNC: Tom Kim has dreamt of getting himself in a position like this. Well, he's got it now.

TOM KIM: It would be a dream if we win it and I've realized why guys always want to make these teams. It's very inspiring. But job's not done. We've got a great group of guys, and we believe. No one really believed in us, but we believe in ourselves.

### D2\* - Round 5 Start

ANNC: The final day of what has already been a wild week at Quail Hollow Club and the 14th Presidents Cup.

ANNC: The Internationals came through big time yesterday in the afternoon and made this interesting.

### IN THE FIRST MATCH OUT, JUSTIN THOMAS TAKES A 2 UP LEAD OVER SI WOO KIM THRU 9 HOLES...

ANNC: Hohoho yes!

WHILE JORDAN SPIETH KEEPS THINGS LITE ON THE FIRST TEE...

LOOKING FOR THE FIRST SINGLES WIN OF HIS CAREER, HE STARTS SLOW AND TRAILS CAM DAVIS EARLY...BUT FIGHTS BACK IN TYPICAL SPIETH FASHION TO TIE THE MATCH...

ANNC: Are you kidding!? Why should we even be remotely surprised! The magic is back!

## AND A TRIO OF AMERICANS BEHIND ALL TAKE EARLY LEADS IN THEIR MATCHES.

ANNC: Right in the middle! Patrick Cantlay takes a 2 UP lead.

ANNC: Schauffele now has a 3 UP commanding lead.

ANNC: Scheffler comes out of it with a win. Only one World Number One in a Presidents Cup has failed to win a match.

#### WHO WINS FOUR HOLES IN A ROW ON THE BACK NINE...

ANNC: Spieth has Cam Davis on the run! What a comeback!

AND ON THE VERGE OF WHAT WOULD BE AN EXTRA SWEET VICTORY IN HIS PRESIDENTS CUP RETURN.

#### D3\* - Jordan Spieth Feature

AS SPIETH CONTINUES HIS VINTAGE PERFORMANCE, HE IS ACUTELY AWARE OF JUST HOW DIFFICULT IT IS TO EARN YOUR WAY BACK TO THIS MARQUEE STAGE YEAR AFTER YEAR...

JORDAN SPIETH: I had a hard time. I remember turning it on and just being like, I don't know if I can continue to watch this, I feel like I should be there. It fueled me. I mean, it frustrated me because those were all teammates of mine and I wasn't there. And it was tough. I never want to miss it again and it was a huge goal of mine to make the 2022 team.

ANNC: There's another highlight for Jordan.

#### ...HE WRAPS UP HIS WEEK WITH A NOTABLE FIRST.

## WINNING FIVE OF THE FINAL SEVEN HOLES TO CLOSE THE MATCH, SPIETH PUTS THE FIRST POINT ON THE BOARD FOR TEAM USA...

### AND FLIP THE SCRIPT IN TWO OTHER MATCHES...

ANNC: Now he's got the lead for the first time!

ANNC: He has a knack for making these longs ones...you can add another one to Burns' list!

# SAM BURNS AND HIDEKI MATSUYAMA HEAD TO THE $18^{\mathrm{TH}}$ HOLE TIED...BOTH WITH A CHANCE TO WIN A CRUCIAL POINT...

ANNC: Easy...oh! What a shot!

### WITH THE FIRST FIVE MATCHES AN EVEN SPLIT, THE INTERNATIONALS NEED SIX POINTS FROM THE FINAL SEVEN MATCHES TO WIN THE CUP.

ANNC: Sungjae Im with a 1 UP lead over Cam Young.

ANNC: K.H. Lee with a win.

ANNC: Tom Kim 3 UP over Homa who is really struggling.

ANNC: Bezuidenhout grabs a 1 UP lead!

### AND ONCE 3 UP, XANDER SCHAUFFELE LOSES THREE-CONSECUTIVE HOLES...

ANNC: Uh oh! That's one's heading left for Xander. It's gone. Conners is going to win three holes in a row here to tie the match.
